




#### Remote Control

  direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.





#### Skateboard

- Remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the bottom of the Skateboard.
- Install three (3) AAA alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.



 To remove the Skateboard keychain from the top of the package,ask an ADULT to use scissors(not included) to clip the ties attaching it to the package. (Figs. 1 & 2)



To send your Bratz™ off on a Skateboarding adventure: a.Press both joysticks forward to move the Board forward. b.Press both joysticks backward to move the Board backward. c.Press one joystick forward and one backward to make the Board spin. d.Reverse the direction of the joysticks to spin the Board in the opposite direction.
