

QUICK START

STEP 1: BATTERY INSTALLATION


Radio Control Handset

- 1. Switch the ON/OFF switch to "OFF"
- 2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the bottom of the Handset. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Install one (1) 9V alkaline battery (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 1)
- 4. Replace the battery cover a tighten the screw.



Snowmobile

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included) remove the screw and battery compartment cover from the
- bottom of the Snowmobile.(Fig. 2)
 2. Insert three (3) AAA (1.5V) Alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 2)
- 3. Replace the battery cover & tighten the screw.




STEP 2: GIVE DANA™ A RIDE

To get ready to roll:

- 1. Place the helmet on Dana's head and secure it with the Velcro™ fastener. (Fig. 3)
- Sit Danath on the seat, place her feet in the openings on the floor of the Snowmobile and fasten her with the Velcroth seat belt. (Fig. 4)






STEP 3: RACING YOUR SNOWMOBILE

- 1. Move the Remote Control Handset to the "ON" position. An indicator light will light.

 2. Turn the Snowmobile "ON" by pressing the button on the
- Center Console. The red, heart-shape taillight will light.
- 3. Straighten the Antenna (Fig. 5)
 4. Push the FORWARD, BACKWARD, LEFT and RIGHT buttons to race your vehicle in any direction! (Figs. 6 & 7). The "skis" will turn in the direction while you are steering the Snowmobile.









TROUBLE SHOOTING

IF THERE IS NO FUNCTION BETWEEN THE REMOTE CONTROL HANDSET AND THE SNOWMOBILE:

- Make sure the Remote Control Handset and the Snowmobile switches are in the ON position.
- · Make sure the batteries are inserted properly.
- Replace the old batteries with new alkaline batteries.
- Move the Remote Control Handset closer to the Snowmobile to determine the best communication between the two.
- When not in use, turn both the Remote and Snowmabile switches to OFF to save battery
- ·If the snowmobile is not running straight, please fine tune the Steering Adjuster to keep your snowmobile running straight. (Fig. 8)



CAUTION: DO NOT operate units during thunderstorms. DO NOT operate the Snowmobile on the street or in traffic. CAUTION: Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires, wheel hubs and motors while the Snowmobile is switched on.

- · Avoid water when racing your Snowmobile. In addition, do not submerge your Snowmobile Handset in water.
- When your Snowmobile starts to lose power and/or experiences a loss of performance ability, replace the batteries.
- Your Snowmobile is operated by radio waves. It is possible the unit may not perform properly due to interference from nearby devices such as a cordless phones, hair dryers, radios, walkie-talkies or other radio-controlled toys.
- · Avoid operating the Snowmobile in sand and snow.
- · Always select a safe place to play. Never operate your Snowmobile on populated streets.
- · Do not over torque the steering of the Snowmobile. It may cause permanent damage on the product.

SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- 1. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged:
- 2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged;
- 3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision; 4. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be
- 5. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used:
- 6. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity;
- 7 Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy;
- 8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited;
- 9. Do not dispose of the batteries in fire, batteries may leak or explode.
- 10. Batteries should be replaced by adult.
- 11. Use alkaline batteries for better performance
- 12. When not in use for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
