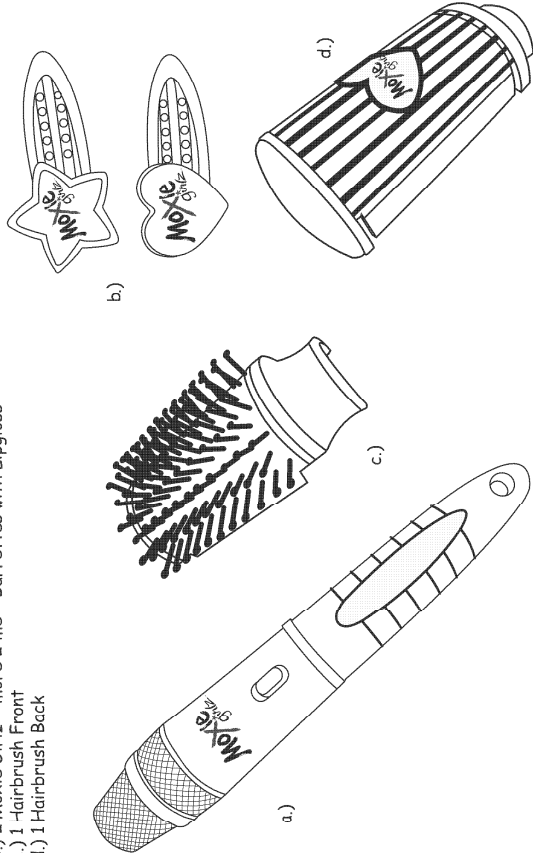

## INTRODUCTION

Turn an ordinary Hairbrush into totally rockin' Wireless Microphone and broadcast your voice over the nearest FM radio! Flip open the Barrette and apply some yummy Lipgloss, then get ready to be a rock star in disguise and ROCK OUT!

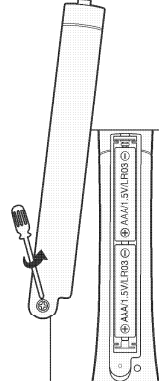

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN

An adult must install fresh, alkaline batteries. Here's how:

1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover.
2. Install two (2) AAA alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw.



## CAUTION

1. Your FM Microphone has been fully tested and adjusted prior to shipment. Do not attempt to touch, replace or service any of components inside.
2. After use, turn your microphone OFF to save the batteries.
3. If you do not plan to use your microphones for several days, remove the batteries.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

1. If the microphone's transmission begins to weaken, replace the batteries.
2. Under an environment with electrostatic discharge, (static electricity) this product may malfunction and require user to reset the unit by removing and replacing the batteries.

## SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- Use alkaline batteries for best performance and longer life.
  - Use only the type battery recommended for the unit.
  - Batteries should be replaced only by an adult.
  - Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
  - Do not mix old and new batteries.
  - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
  - Do not short-circuit batteries.
  - When not used for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
  - Do not mix rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries.
  - Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before charging.
  - Rechargeable batteries are to be recharged only under adult supervision.
  - Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
  - Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
  - Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.
- NOTE: The voltage of a fully-charged, rechargeable battery is often lower than that of a fresh alkaline battery. Therefore, it is recommended that alkaline batteries be used instead of rechargeable batteries for best performance and for longest play time.

**ASSEMBLING THE HAIRBRUSH HEAD**

Assemble the head of the Hairbrush by snapping the ends of the hinge on the Bristle (front) Side in between the Tabs on the Back Side. (Fig. 1)

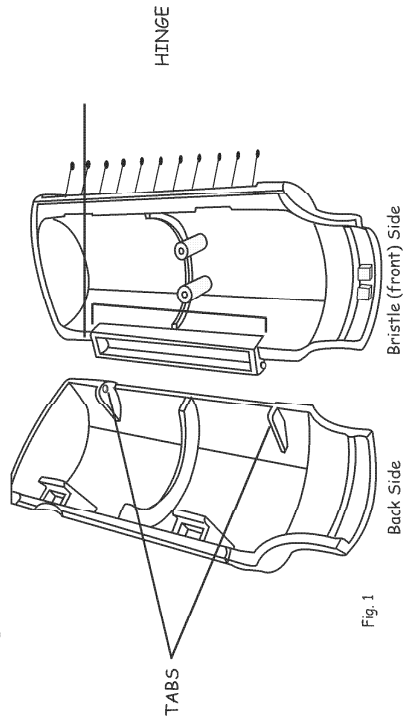

**INSERTING THE MICROPHONE INTO THE BRUSH HEAD**

1. Place the Microphone into the Brush Side of the Hairbrush Head. (Fig. 2)
2. Rotate the Microphone until the slot on the back of the Mic (Fig. 3) fits into the tab inside the Back Side of the Hairbrush Head. (Fig. 4)
3. Close the Hairbrush Head (Fig. 5) and snap it shut. (Fig. 6)

NOTE: The Slot on the Mic must fit securely in the Tab on the Brush to keep the Brush from rotating when using it to brush hair.

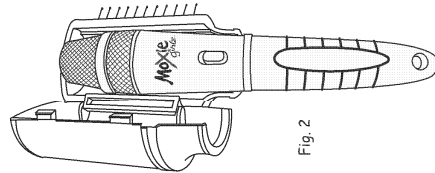

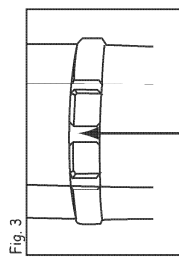

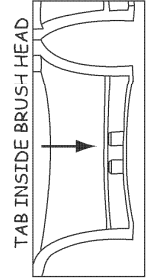

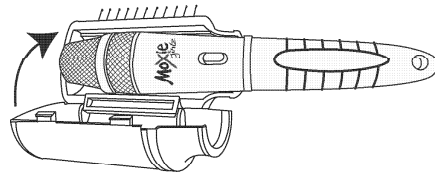

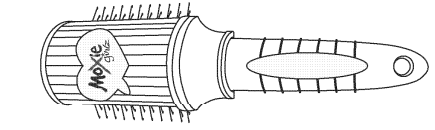

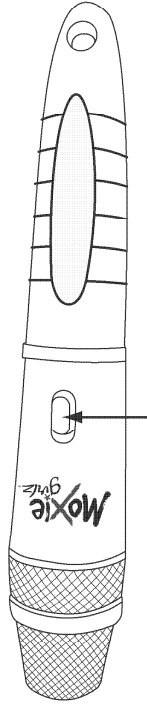

ON / OFF SWITCH

**USING THE BARRETTES IN THE HAIR**

1. Open the tab on the underside of the Barrette by pulling it outward.
2. Slide the tab under a layer of your hair then close the tab and press firmly to snap it shut.

**APPLYING LIPGLOSS**

1. Open the barrette by grasping the edge of the heart (or star) and pulling up on the lid. (Figs. 8 & 9)

NOTE: Peel away and discard the plastic film from the lipgloss before using.

2. With clean hands, apply the lipgloss with your-pinkie finger ONLY to your lips.

3. Close the cover and press firmly until it clicks shut.

NOTE: Make sure the lid is firmly closed before wearing the barrette in your hair!

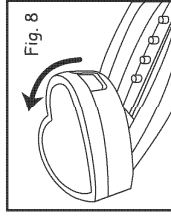

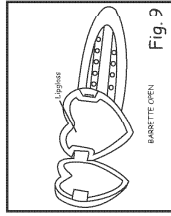

**REMOVING LIPGLOSS:**

1. Remove lipgloss from your lips, by washing with soap and water.

**CAUTION:**

- Adult supervision is required
- Lipgloss is laboratory tested and safe for use as described. As with all cosmetics, some individual skin types may experience minor skin irritation. If this occurs, discontinue use.
- Lipgloss is for external use only.
- **DO NOT** use Lipgloss on broken skin.
- **DO NOT** consume (eat) Lipgloss.
- Stop using the Lipgloss immediately if any allergic reaction occurs.
- Lipgloss is recommended for children 6 years and older.
- Lipgloss may damage or stain certain fabrics, carpeting, wood finishes or other porous and polished surfaces. Protect on cover any play surface before using the cosmetics.
- **DO NOT** use Lipgloss for any other purpose than what is described in this manual.
- Clean your hands thoroughly before and after playing with Lipgloss.
- Please remove the FM mic when cleaning the hair brush.

**USING THE MICROPHONE**

This FM Wireless Microphone operates at approximately 100MHz and will transmit your voice through any FM radio (not included). To do so:

1. Turn ON your Moxie Girlz™ FM wireless mic. (Fig. 7)
2. Turn on your personal radio (not included), and select the FM band.
3. Tune your radio to 100MHz. If there is a radio station at 100MHz with a strong signal, it may overpower your microphone. If you find a commercial station, move the tuner a little to either side of 100MHz.
