



- Rhythm Slider Move the Rhythm Slider to one of four positions: Classic, Country, Hip-Hop or World Beat. You can even move the Slider while a song is playing to change beats instantly
- Mode Slider Switch This slider switch has three different modes of play: 1. Complete Song Mode - This mode plays entire songs. When a song is complete, the next song in the list will play. You can also press any key on the Keyboard to skip to the next song. If you would like to hear all of the lullabies, you must press hold the button down for 3 sec.
- 2. Stanzas Mode This mode plays part of a song (stanza). Press any key on the Keyboard to




