


COMPATIBILITY LIST


INTRODUCTION



Recognizing the lights

Lights status	What it means
LED1: blue light blinks	MBT8B is in pairing mode, you can connect it to your device by Bluetooth.
LED1: blue light on	MBT8B is connected with your device, you can use it as remote controller to take photos or record videos.
LED 2: red light on	MBT8B is in charging status. Red light will be off when fully-charged.

QUICK START GUIDE



Charging and monitor the battery

Charge the battery.

Connect MBT8B to an outlet by using the included cable. You can also charge the battery by connecting MBT8B to your computer.

Monitor the battery.

Red light (LED 2) will be on which shows the MBT8B is in charging status, and it will light out when fully-charged.

MBT8B to your device



Long press the shutter for 3 seconds and the blue light blinks (LED1), which means MBT8B is ready to pair with your device.

Connect MBT8B to your device




Turn on Bluetooth of your device in the Bluetooth setting interface, search 'MBT8B 'and connect it. Blue lights stay bright, and the phone shows "Connected" in the interface.

Note: In your next use, please turn on Bluetooth of your device first and MBT8B will reconnect to the device when on.


Basic Operation



Rotate the foldable clamp for 270 degree (or so) to get a good viewing angle and screw the adjustable knob tightly.



Hold the handle and strech out the telescopic stick



Place the phone on the foldable clamp. Make sure the phone holds securely.

Take a photo with MBT8B

Open up your chosen camera app, switch to camera mode, and position the phone on the end of the stick.

Press the shutter release button to take a photo.

Record a video with MBT8B

Open up your chosen camera app, switch to video mode, position the phone on the end of the stick.

Press the shutter release button on the handle to start recording.

When finish, press the shutter release button to end it.

Note: MBT8B will hibernate if you don't use it for 5 minutes. Please press the shutter once to wake it.

Put MBT8B in your pecket when you go out

When you finish using it, take out your phone, draw back the telescopic stick, and rotate the foldable clamp back.

Put it in your pocket and go out, record the precious moments with your family and friends.
