Ensuring a Good Fit:

To enjoy better sound quality and/or for a more comfortable fit, change the size of the earbuds or adjust the earbud position to fit snugly in your ears – do not force in. When you change the earbuds, turn them to install firmly on your headset and prevent the earbud from detaching and remaining in your ear.

How to place the headset on your ears:

- Hang the neck band over the back of your ears.
- Gently insert the earbuds into your ear ensuring a comfortable fit.

Note there is a small "L" and "R" on the earbuds indicating which ear the buds should go into.

Using your Bluetooth Headphones:
