User Guide



1. How to Unlock your Ranger
 - a. First Press Unlock
 - b. Now Press Star (*)
2. Dialing a number
 - a. Input number (Example: +1-999-999-9999)
 - b. Press Center button on keypad to dial out
 - i. Options
 1. Hold – place call on hold
 2. End Single call – Ends call
 3. New Call – Creates new call
 4. Phonebook – See 3.b
 5. Call History – See 4.d.I
 6. Messaging – See 3.e
 7. Sound recorder – See 3.f.iv
 8. Background Sound – See 3.d.ii.5
 - ii. Press Ok button to turn on speaker
 - iii. Mute – mutes call
3. Menu Options
 - a. **File Manager** - Allows you to review all your files in the Phone or SD Card
 - b. **Phonebook** – All your Contacts as in here
 - i. Add new contact
 1. Name
 2. Number
 3. Caller Picture
 4. Caller Ringtone
 - ii. Options
 1. View – Opens the Contacts Info
 2. Send Message – Creates New SMS to send to contact
 3. Edit – Allows you to Edit contact
 4. Delete – Deletes contact
 5. Copy – Creates a Copy of the contact
 6. Send business card – Allows you to send the Contact via BT/MMS
 7. Mark Several – Allows you select more than one Contact at a time
 8. Phonebook settings – you can change the on the phonebook
 - iii. Search Bar – Allows you to search through your contacts
 - c. **Fun**
 - i. Games – Embedded into the OS
 - d. **Call Center**
 - i. Call history – You can see all History of calls
 1. Missed calls – see missed call history
 2. Dialed calls – see Dialed call history
 3. Received calls – see Received call history
 4. Delete call logs – Allows you to delete history of calls
 5. Call Timers – Allows you to see total time of calls incoming/outgoing
 6. Call cost – Calculates the cost of the call
 7. Test msg. counter – counts the amount of SMS sent/Received

8. GPRS counter – counts total Data used
- ii. Call Settings
 1. Blacklist – Blocks Calls/SMS
 - a. Reject unknown – Blocks the unknown numbers
 - b. Reject number in Blacklist – Can set on/off of number blacklist
 - c. Blacklist number – Allows you input 1-20 numbers to be blacklisted
 2. Whitelist – Gives Priority over other number
 3. Auto redial – Auto redials the number
 4. IP dial
 5. Background sound – Music that plays while call is being connected
 6. Call Time Reminder – When there is missed call, it will remind you
 7. Auto quick end – When a call is coming in, you can set the time for it to stop ringing from 1-9999 seconds
 8. Reject by SMS – Can Reject calls by send SMS
 9. Connect Notice – Notifies you when you have connected to the call
 10. Answer mode – Allows you to set different keys to answer calls

e. Messaging

- i. Write Message – Creates Blank SMS
 1. Options
 - a. Sent to – Select who SMS/MMS will be sent
 - i. Enter recipient – Manually insert number
 - ii. Add from Phonebook – Can select number from contact list
 - b. Insert symbol – Gives you options of different symbol to insert to message
 - c. Input method – Allows you to change the Language and style of input
 - d. Input method option
 - e. Add Picture – you can select an image to send via MMS
 - f. Add Sound – you can add a sound to send via MMS
 - g. Add Video – you can add a video to send via MMS
 - h. Add subject – you can change the subject title
 - i. Slide Option – Allows you select if you would like the slide to appear before or after text
 - j. Switch to MMS – Switches from SMS to MMS
 - k. Advanced – Allows you insert attachments
 - l. Save – Saves as Draft
 - m. Details – Give you Details of Message
 2. Sending Message – Select the Center Button to send
 3. Exit button – Exits the Messaging section
- ii. Inbox – Opens your Messages inbox
- iii. Draft – Opens your Draft
- iv. Outbox – Opens your Outbox
- v. Sent messages – Opens your Sent Messages
- vi. Archive -Opens your Archived messages
- vii. Templates – Opens all SMS/MMS templates by user/default

- viii. Messaging settings – Allows you to change the Settings of SMS/MMS sending procedure. **(Note: changing these settings may affect device performance. Recommended not to change)**

f. Multimedia

- i. Camcorder -Opens Camera Recorder (must insert MicroSD Card for it work)
- ii. Image Viewer – Can view All Images on device
- iii. Media Player – Allows you to play All Video and Audio files in device
- iv. Sound recorder – Records Audio
- v. FM radio – You can hear FM Radio by plugging Earphones (they act as the antenna)

g. Organizer

- i. Calendar – Allows you see dates and schedule meetings
- ii. Tasks – Allows you to create a list of tasks
- iii. Alarms – Allows you to create up to 5 different alarms
- iv. World Clock – give you the time in different parts of the world
- v. Notes – Allows you to make a list of notes

h. Settings

- i. Dual SIM Switch – Allows you to Switch Primary SIM (holding 3G connectivity) from SIM 1 and SIM 2. Recommended to leave as Automatic
- ii. Dual SIM settings
- iii. Phone Settings
 - 1. Time and Date – Can change Time and date settings
 - a. Set Home City – Allows you to pick default home city
 - b. Set time/date – Allows you to change format of time and date
 - i. HH:MM – can manually change the time to your preference (not recommended to change)
 - ii. YYYY/MM/DD – can change the date to your preference (not recommended)
 - iii. Daylight Saving- recommended to on
 - c. Set format
 - i. Time – Can select to 12-hour format or 24-hour format
 - ii. Date – Can change Date format to your preference
 - iii. Date Separator – Allows you to select Symbol separating date
 - d. Update with time zone – recommended to keep on
 - 2. Schedule Power on/off – can schedule device to automatically turn off/on
 - 3. Language – can change language settings to English, French Spanish, Portuguese, or Chinese
 - 4. Preferred Input method – Allows you to change the input method when you type
 - 5. Display
 - a. Wallpaper – Allows you to change wallpaper from default image or user defined
 - b. Screen Saver – Allows you to keep screen on in one image will in sleep mode
 - c. Themes – Allows you to change the icons and theme of OS

6. Dedicated keys – From home screen the up/down/right/left buttons can be modified for quick access to different parts of the phone
 7. Flight mode – Activate this when boarding Airplane. Will Disable all communication from device
 8. Misc. Setting – Allows you to change brightness level and screen time out time
- iv. Security Settings
 1. Phone Security – Allows you to Create a lock on your device
 - a. Phone lock – select on/off
 - b. Change Password – Insert old/new password
 2. Auto Keypad lock – Allows you to keep or disable to lock on device
 - v. Connectivity
 1. Bluetooth
 - a. Power – Allows you to turn on/off
 - b. Visibility – allows you to be visible or not to nearby devices
 - c. My device – allows you to search for nearby devices
 - d. Search Audio device – Searches for Audio BT devices
 - e. My Name- You can rename device name in BT
 2. Connections
 3. Data Accounts – Recommended not to change, will affect usage of device
 4. Internet Tethering – Allows you to share Data connection to PC by connecting Via USB
 5. Data Service – Allows you to turn Data on/off
 - vi. Restore factory settings – will Reset all device settings and wipe all info from device. Code is 1122
 - vii. Sound effects – Allows you to play with audio settings of device

 1. Options
 - a. Customize
 - i. Alert Type
 1. Ring only
 2. Vibrate only
 3. Vibrate and Ring
 4. Vibrate then ring

 1. Repeat

 - iii. Sim 1 incoming – can select from Preloading Ringtones or from saved audio file from device
 - iv. Sim 2 incoming – can select from Preloading Ringtones or from saved audio file from device

- v. Ringtone Volume – set volume of ringtone
- vi. SIM 1 message – can select from Preloaded Ringtones or from saved audio file from device
- vii. SIM 2 message – can select from Preloaded Ringtones or from saved audio file from device
- viii. Message Volume – allows you to change volume settings for Message notification
