



Operation of Your Opener (cont'd):

Install Battery

- -Remove back cover
- -Insert 12V Battery, as shown
- -Replace back cover.
- -When replacing bettery, use 12V of same type.

Teaching/Learning the Code

Your transmitter comes factory programmed with a random code (for 2 and 4 button versions, a different code is stored for each button).

To transfer the code from one transmitter to another:

- -Remove back cover of both transmitters.
- -Connect program cable to both transmitters.
- -Using the transmitter with the correct code, press and hold the button. The transmitter indicator light blinks
- -While keeping the first transmitter button pressed, press the corresponding button on the new transmitter that you want to have the same code.
- -After 1-2 seconds, the indicator light on the new transmitter will illuminate continuously.
- -All buttons can be released. Programming is finished,
- -Cable can be removed and the back cover replaced.

For multi-button transmitters, be sure to carry out this procedure for all the buttons you desire to use.

Connecting the mounting plate and visor clin


The transmitter can be used by itself or can be conveniently mounted inside your car in the following ways:


Mounting plate:


- -Secure the mounting plate to the dash or other area using 3 small screws or velcro (not provided).
- -Snap the transmitter into the mounting plate, which will hold it firmly in place.

Visor Clip:

- -Attach visor clip to mounting plate.
- -Snap transmitter into mounting plate.
- -Affix complete unit to visor.








