

II.Instructions for use



1:Mode switch: Insert any of the TF card, USB or 3.5mm audio cable, then Shortly press the button successively to switch between the Bluetooth. USB.TF and AUX modes.

 2.Volume down/Previous song: Long press for volume down, Short press for previous song

3.Power on/off: Long press to turn on /off the speaker. After turn on the speaker, go to your device setting and activate the Bluetooth® feature, then search for devices, Find this speaker which appears as" BB-1000" on the device list and pair, The voice prompt will alert you if the pairing is successful. (If pass-code is requested, enter"0000.")

4.TWS:Turn on two speakers in the same time, then press either of the speaker to set the TWS function .the beep voice will come out after few seconds to show two speakers connected with each other . , go to your device setting and activate the Bluetooth® feature, then search for devices, Find this speaker which appears as "BB-1000" on the device list and pair, The voice prompt will alert you if the pairing is successful.

+ 5.Volume up/Next song: Long press for volume up, short press for next song

6. Play or pause/ hands-free call : In music: short press for play/pause: In calling: short press for answer /hang up phone call , and the double press for redial last phone call .
