





II. BASIC OPERATION

- LEFT UP/RIGHT UP: FORWARD
- LEFT UP/RIGHT RELEASE: TURN RIGHT
- LEFT UP/RIGHT DOWN: SPIN RIGHT
- RIGHT UP/LEFT RELEASE: TURN LEFT
- 9 RIGHT UP/LEFT DOWN: SPIN LEFT
- O LEFT DOWN/RIGHT DOWN: REVERSE
- PRESS LIFT CUT BUTTON

PRESS BUTTON: LIFT CUT/DOWN/STOP/BRAKING

AirbladeTM is a high-performance hovercraft vehicle. Hovercraft are a specialized class of vehicles with unique capabilities. Airblade's unique feature is its ability to both float on air and make contact with the ground in order to produce super fast speed and super tight turns.

Air is drawn into the top grille of the craft, pressurized, and directed out the three bottom air pods. inflatable air cushions fill with air to create a seal with the ground that creates "lift". The hovercraft actually "floats" along the ground on a cushion of air. The two rear air pods tilt, rotate and touch the ground when you move the controls on the transmitter to pilot the craft.




III. FREQUENCIES


Your vehicle and transmitter operate on one of two frequencies: 27MHz or 49MHz (may be 40MHz in some countries). Do not operate two vehicles on the same frequency in the same area, as they will interfere with each other.

ANTENNA ASSEMBLY

Your antenna comes in two pieces – the base unit and the metal scoping antenna. Remove the antenna from the top of the transmitter and screw it into the cylindrical base in a counter clockwise motion until it is firmly in place. Now pull up on the antenna until it is fully extended. You can remove the antenna for storage and place it back into the canal on top of the transmitter once you're done racing your vehicle.









=♥ IV. QUICK TIPS

- When your vehicle starts to lose power, it may lose functions or performance. It's time for a recharge. For best performance, always start with a fully charged battery.
- Your vehicle's running time may change depending on your driving style.
- Radio interference can effect your vehicle's performance. Interference can be caused by other R/C vehicles running on the same frequency, electrical wires, metal fences, large buildings, CB radios or other wireless gear. Try to stay away from these!
- O Point your transmitter antenna up, not toward your vehicle. If your vehicle gets too far away, it won't work properly, If vehicle goes out of range, try raising the transmitter over your head to try to re-establish radio contact.
- When operating on water, always bring the vehicle back to the shore in plenty of time to avoid loss of power that might strand the vehicle out of your reach.
- O Don't store your vehicle near heat or in direct sunlight. Always turn switch OFF and remove all batteries for storage.



Steer clear of potentially damaging terrains like dry riverbeds where large rocks are often found, tall grasslands where reeds can entangle your vehicle and gravel and sand that can put a lot of stress on a motor.



Don't drive your vehicle in loose sand.



If your vehicle gets wet, wipe it with a towel after use and allow it to dry completely.

V. BATTERY INSTALLATION

Vehicle

- 1. Rotate the battery latches, as shown, to unlock the battery door. Swing the battery door up and away from the vehicle.
- Insert the battery pack into the battery compartment as shown.
- 3. Replace the battery door. Rotate the battery door latches to lock the battery door
- 4. To remove the battery pack: First turn the vehicle off, turn the latches on the battery compartment, open the battery door and lift out the battery pack.



CAUTION: Battery pack may be hot after use. Allow to cool before touching,


- To install transmitter battery, open battery door as shown.
- 2. Install one 9V battery in battery compartment as shown. Observe the battery polarity (+ and -),
- 3. Close battery door.


VI. BATTERY CHARGING/CARE


riangle CAUTION: Use only the charger supplied with this toy. Do not use any other charging source.


Use only Tyco® Airblade™ 12V NiMH battery pack. Other batteries may leak or rupture, causing personal injury and damage.

- 1. Plug the wall pack charger into a standard wall outlet.
- 2. Click the battery pack into the charger. Make certain the battery pack is secure in charger.
- 3. To disconnect, slide battery pack out.
- 4. After charging, the battery will feel warm. This condition is normal for fully charged
- 5. New battery packs must be charged for 5 1/2 hours the first two times charged. Subsequent charges will require 4 hours. Charging the battery pack for more than 5 1/2 hours will not give you a longer running time. 5 1/2 hours is all that is required for a fully charged battery pack.
- 6. Unlike alkaline batteries, which lose power gradually, a NIMH battery will run for its normal running time and then lose most of its power at once. That's when you'll know it's time to recharge the battery pack.









- 7. After use, the battery pack will be hot! Wait at least 20 minutes until the battery pack cools before recharging. Recharging a warm or hot battery pack will greatly reduce the number of times your battery pack
- 8. The charger must be disconnected from the electric supply.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERY INFORMATION:

- DO NOT RECHARGE BATTERY PACK IF IT'S HOT, ALLOW IT TO COOL BEFORE RECHARGING.
