
(Vehicle & Transmitter)

Push battery doors open in direction of arrow.

- Vehicle requires 2 AA alkaline batteries. Install with polarity (+/-) as shown inside battery compartment.
- Transmitter requires 1 9V alkaline battery. Install with polarity (+/-) as shown inside battery compartment.

Close battery doors.

- Your vehicle starts with a key, just like a real carl Just insert the key and turn it clockwise to the ON position. Remove the key - your vehicle will run backward and to the left.
- Your transmitter is the "remote" on your keychain. It has an automatic ON feature. Just press the button to steer straight ahead.
- Release the button to back up and turn. Press it again to go forward when the vehicle is facing the direction you want.
- Insert the key and turn it counterclockwise to the OFF position after use. Remove the key for storage.

- Insure that battery polarity is correct.
- Use only batteries of the type recommended (or equivalent).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Remove used-up batteries immediately. Remove batteries if vehicle will not be used for a long period.
- For best performance use alkaline batteries (where disposable batteries are called for). Battery life may vary depending on battery brand.
- Do not recharge nonrechargeable batteries.
- Do not short-circuit terminals.
- Remove rechargeable batteries before recharging.
 Recharge batteries only under adult supervision.
- Dispose of batteries safely.

- When your vehicle starts to lose power, it may lose functions or performance. It's time for fresh batteries. Your vehicle's running time may change. depending on your driving style.
- Radio interference can make your vehicle run badly. Interference can be caused by other R/C vehicles running on the same frequency; electrical

- wires; large buildings; or CB radios. Try to stay away from thesel
- Point your transmitter up - not down toward your vehicle. If your vehicle gets too far away, it won't work properly.
- Don't drive your vehicle in sand or through water or snow. If your vehicle does get wet, wipe with a towel and allow to dry completely.
- Don't store your vehicle near heat or in direct sunlight. Always turn switches OFF and remove all batteries for storage.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Adults, this toy is recommended for children 3 years of age and older. To ensure that the child's play is both safe and fun, please review the operating instructions and these general safety rules with the child.

- DO NOT pick up vehicle while in motion.

EXCLUSIVE SOUND FEATURE


Your vehicle features an exclusive sound feature for extra driving fun! Turn the sound switch to the ON position: your *remote* will make cool driving sounds as you operate your vehicle.


Your 'remote' operates on two different kinds of batteries: 1 9-volt battery for the transmitter function (not included), and 3 button cell batteries (included and pre-installed) for the sound feature. You can drive your vehicle with the sound feature turned off: just leave the sound switch in the OFF position and drive your vehicle normally.

If the sound feature stops working, you'll need to replace these batteries as follows:

- Open upper battery door, using a Philips screwdriver (not included). Remove battery door.
- Remove old batteries, Install 3 fresh AG13/LR44 button cell batteries, with polarity (+/-) as shown.
- 3. Replace battery door and tighten screw.









Please discard used-up batteries immediately, being careful to keep them away from young children at all times.
