

Important Battery Information

When the product does not respond, slows down, or loses range, replace the batteries. If the vehicle malfunctions, check for proper battery installation.

- ✓ Insure that battery polarity is correct.
- ✓ Use only batteries of the type recommended (or equivalent).
- ✓ Do not mix old and new batteries.
- ✓ Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- ✓ Remove used-up batteries immediately. Remove batteries if vehicle will not be used for a long period.
- ✓ For best results and for longer life, use only alkaline batteries. Battery life may vary depending on battery brand.
- ✓ Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- ✓ Do not short-circuit terminals.
- ✓ Remove rechargeable batteries before recharging.
- ✓ Recharge batteries only under adult supervision.
- ✓ Dispose of batteries safely.

VI. TIPS & HINTS

- Operate your car in a dry, open area; avoid sand, loose dirt, wet, and snow. These can damage electronic assemblies.
- Hold the transmitter antenna up for best performance. The maximum range for operation should be 35 feet (10 meters).
- Do not store the car or transmitter near heat or in direct sunlight. To avoid deepness, do not leave the car or transmitter outside overnight. If moisture does get inside your car or transmitter, remove the batteries and thoroughly dry the connectors. Allow the car or transmitter to dry for several hours, or overnight, and install new batteries before operating.
- When you are through playing, turn the vehicle OFF. If you do not intend to play again, remove the batteries from the car and the transmitter. When the batteries start to weaken, the car may not function properly. The vehicle will NOT be defective, but it will be time to change the batteries.
- When your vehicle runs erratically, the problem is usually the result of interference caused by high-tension wires, large buildings, CB radios, or nearby R/C vehicles which are running on the same frequency as yours. When interference occurs, you may need to move to another location. DO NOT HAVE VEHICLES WHICH OPERATE ON YOUR FREQUENCY (45MHz).
- Anyone can learn to drive the Rescue Net™ police car well, but you will need a little practice.

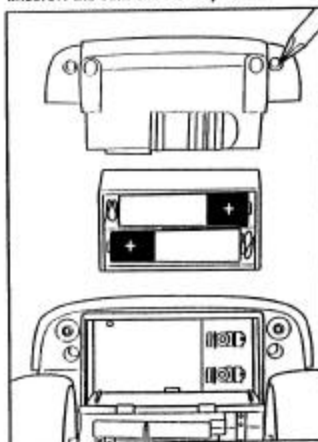

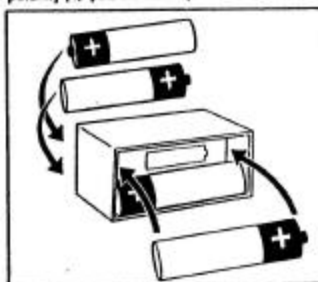
II. VEHICLE

Battery Installation

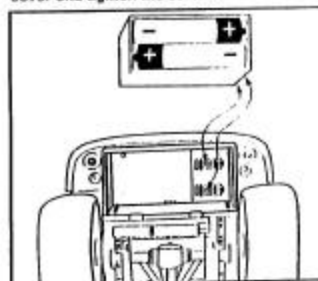
- Use a Philips screwdriver (not included) to unscrew the vehicle's battery cover.



- Lift out the battery case. Install 4 AA-size (LR6) alkaline batteries inside the case (with polarity (+/-) as indicated).



- Re-insert the battery case. Make sure the contacts on the case touch the contacts in the battery compartment. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screws.

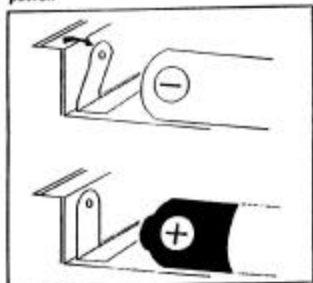

Battery Contacts

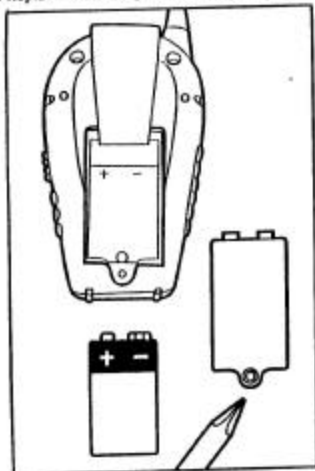
- Bent or dirty contacts may result in loss of power.



III. TRANSMITTER

Battery Installation

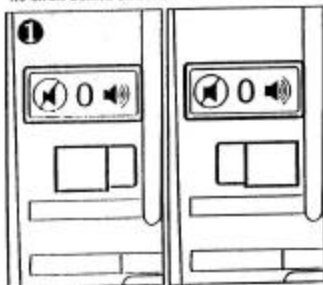
- Remove the screw and the battery door.
- Install one 9-volt (6F61) battery with polarity (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment.
- Replace the battery cover and the screw.



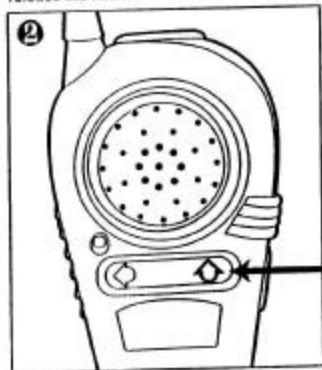
The transmitter turns itself on and off automatically. It has no ON/OFF switch.

IV. VEHICLE OPERATION

- Switch the vehicle ON. You may choose to operate the vehicle with or without its siren sound effects.



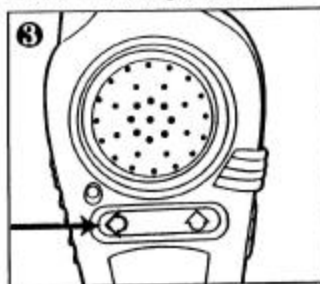
- Push the button on the transmitter to drive the car forward. The siren will sound for five seconds (if turned on), and the light bar will flash for ten seconds. To stop the car, release the button.



- Push the button to make the car spin.

To steer, release the button when the car is facing the desired direction.

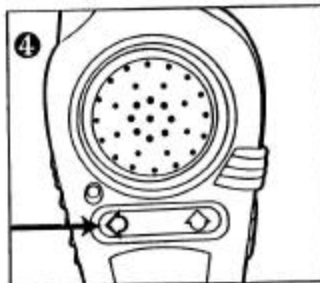
Push the button again to go forward.



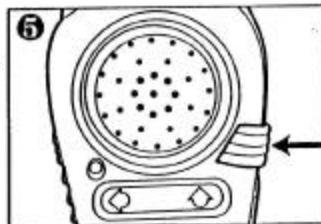
- You can make the top of the car pop up by

holding down the button until the car has spun around approximately three times.

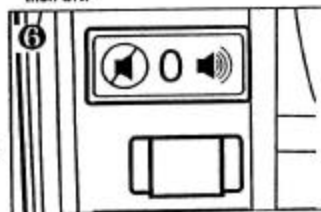
To close the roof, push it down with your fingers until it clicks.



- To transmit your voice, push the button and speak into the microphone. When you release the button, both the light bar and the siren (if turned on) will operate for a few seconds.



- Turn the vehicle OFF when you are finished playing. If you forget, the car will turn itself off after 30 minutes; however, to play again, you will have to move the switch to OFF and then ON.



V. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adults, this toy is recommended for children 3 years of age and older. To ensure that the child's play is both safe and fun, please review the operating instructions and these general safety rules with the child.

CAUTION: To prevent entanglement, keep hair away from wheels.

- DO NOT pick up the vehicle while it is in motion.

- To avoid accidental operation, remove the batteries when not in use.
