
## **Connections and Operations**

Plug in the soundbar and subwoofer, release ST-BY mode, subwoofer blinks blue and pairs to soundbar. After successfully connected, blue light illuminates. Select any input mode to play.



Short press to select input modes; long press to enter remote control learning status.

- A. Long press up to 5 seconds
- B. Indicative LED blinks, enter learning status.
- C. Press any button on soundbar to start learning.
- D. Indicative LED turns off.
- E. Press the button on the remote control you want it to learn.
- F. Indicative LED blinks 3 times, it's learned successfully.
- G. Repeat A-F to learn other buttons

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Questions	Solutions
Power LED won't light up	Check if the system is powered on Check that the power plug is well connected
No Sound	Check that the audio source is working well Check that the audio and speaker cables are well connected Check if the volume is at right level
One or more satellite no sound	Check if the satellite cable is well connected, and ensure source connection is correctly inserted
Static sound heard when volume knob is turned	Turn off the playback source first, then turn the speaker volume knob several times. Playback again and monitor. The static noise is usually due to dust, so simply turning the volume will remove it easily.
What are the products supported?	Any playback devices such as smartphone, tablet, PC, notebook, CD/DVD player, media players with 3.5mm stereo plug.
Sound is distorted	Check that the source file is not corrupted, play a different song to test. Ensure music file is of 192 kbps bitrate or higher.
