### Getting started with Surface Laptop

- 1. Plug the power cable into your Surface Laptop and then into the wall.
- 2. Press the power button.
- 3. Windows will guide you through the setup process, help you sign on to Wi-Fi, and choose your language preference.
- 4. If you already have a Microsoft account, use it to sign in and you'll be able to sync your settings and content across multiple devices.
- 5. If you need to set up a Microsoft account, remember that you can use any email address.

#### Windows Hello

Configure Windows Hello using the integrated camera in Microsoft Surface Laptop

- Swipe in from the right and go to All settings.
- 2. Open Accounts and select Sign-in Options
- 3. Create a pin
- 4. Click on Windows Hello and configure your Microsoft Surface Laptop for Face Authentication

## Caring for your keyboard

Clean your keyboard frequently to keep it looking great. To keep it clean just use a screen cleaning wipe and gently wipe the fabric and keys.

For more persistent spots wipe it with a damp lint-free cloth using mild soap and water.

NOTE: Do not apply liquids to your keyboard.

## Caring for your screen

To avoid scratches, use a screen cleaning wipe to gently wipe the screen. You don't need to rub hard to remove finger prints or oily spots.
