






### 1. Warning and Safety Instructions

Follow these safety precautions to prevent fire, injury or damage to the product. Read and keep instructions: it is very important that you read all the safety and operating

#### Warnings:





STRANGULATION HAZARD: Children can become entangled in cords. Make sure the monitor, camera and mains adapter cables are kept out of reach of you baby and other young children at all times, at least 6 feet away.

CHOKING HAZARD: This product contains small parts which may cause choking. Exercise care when unpacking and assembling the product and keep the small parts away from children.

RISK OF SUFFOCATION: Keep all packaging materials and protective foils out of reach of children.

**DANGER FROM POWER CORDS:** To avoid possible danger from power cords, the cords should be secured and never be hung on or near the crib. Never place the camera or monitor inside your baby'crib, bed or playpen.

DO NOT DROP OR THROW ROUGHLY: Baby monitor is a high-quality electronic device which must be handled with care.

**AVOID MOISTURE:** The product should not be exposed to rain, moisture, or splashing. Never use or place the product in or near moisture or water.

DO NOT TRY TO OPEN AND REPAIR THE PRODUCT: If you have any problems with the product, please contact the authorized distributor. In case of unusual noises or smells originating from the device, immediately disconnect the product from the power outlet and contact authorized. If the product becomes dirty, use a lightly damp soft cloth to wipe surfaces, taking care to not allow water into any openings.

#### 1.2 Safty Instructions for AC Power Adapter

The adapter should not be exposed to direct heat sources such as a candle, stove, radiator, heat register or other appliance that emit heat.

During continual use, the power adapters may become warm to the touch. This is normal and should not be a cause of concern.

Examine intactness of the power cord and its plug.

The adapter must be handled with care: Do not handle roughly, drop or throw.

When removing the power adapter from the wall outlet, hold and pull from the receptacle.

Do not pull on the cable itself or bend the cable as that will put additional stress on the cable and could lead to damages.

Do not touch the power adapter with wet hands or allow liquids to spill on it.





#### 2.2 Monitor



- Power/Charging indicator LED:
  - \*The LED shows red when charging under the display is turn off state. \*The LED shows orange when charging under the turn on state.
- \*The LED shows green after the battery is fully charged.
- Volume LED:

When the baby unit detects the voice, the indicator light will be on, the louder the detected sound, the more lights will light up

- Power on/off:
  - Long press to turn on/off the monitor; short press to screen on/off.
- Pan/Tilt:
- Press the key PAN/TILT to enter into the Pan/Tilt mode.
- Volume /up:

Press Volume+ to increase the volume/Tilt up the camera in the Pan/Tilt mode.

6 Brightness \*/Left:

Press the Brightness- to decrease the brightness/Tilt up the camera in the Pan/Tilt mode.

7 Brightness∗/Right:

Press the Brightness+ to increase the brightness/Tiltup the camera in the Pan/Tilt mode.

8 OK/Swift:

Press the ok key to confirm or view/swift camera.

Press Volume- to decrease the volume/Tilt up the camera in the Pan/Tilt mode.

Menu:

Short Press the Menu key the menu will pop up, and press again to Exit.
Press and hold the Menu key around 2 seconds to operate Zoo in/out.

11 Talk to baby:

To talk, press and hold the talk key on the front of the monitor.

MIC:

When talk to baby, it collects the voices of parents.

Stand:



## 3.Getting Started



**Step1** Connect the AC power adapter with camera. Plug the AC power adapter into power socket.



Step4 Press the PAIR button for two seconds until there is a ★ before ❷. (the monitor has already been paired with the camera in factory settings.No repeated operation is needed.)



Step2 Press POWER for two seconds to turn on the monitor.



Step3 Set the monitor to prepare for connecting

## 4. Function operation

#### Lullaby setting

- Press menu button MENU to access menu. choose 

   ■ and press (3)
- 2. Select the lullaby you want to play
- 3. Navigate with to select the duration and music volume
- 4.In order to stop the lullaby playback, select
- 5. Press MENU to exit the menu.

NOTE: The lullaby default setting is off.

#### Digital zoom

- 1.Press menu button MENU to access menu. choose and press
- 2. Navigate with to select the desire options
- 3.Press MENU to exit the menu

#### Pair the monitor with the camera

- 1.Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose 🚇 and press 🚳
- 2. Navigate with to select the camera you want to pair.
- 3.Press MENU to exit menu.

NOTE:Before you begin pairing, make sure to have the monitor and camera side by side and turned on.

#### Vox mode

- 1.Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose 🔝 and press 🚳
- 2. Navigate with to select the desire options
- 3.Press MENU to exit the menu

NOTE: To resume the video and audio signal manually on your camera when Vox function is on, briefly press any key on your camera.

#### Split screen set

- 1.Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose 📼 and press 🚳
- 2.Navigate with to select the desire options
- 3.Press MENU to exit the menu

NOTE: This function is only available when two or more cameras are paired

#### Delete the monitor

- 1. Press menu button MENU to access menu.
  - choose 🛭 and press
- 2. Navigate with to select the camera you want to delete.
- 3. Press MENU to exit menu.

## 5.Baby monitor setting

#### Temperature scale setting

- 1.Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose and press
- 2.Select ♂c/r and press €
- 3. Navigate with to select the desire scale.
- 4. Press MENU to exit menu.

NOTE:Make sure the temperature sensor is not positioned too close to the camera body as it may affect the correct temperature reading. It is recommended to stretch out the sensor, so it is as far away from the camera body as possible. Also, it is recommended to place the camera in an area where there is good air circulation and not in a closed area where the temperature tend to be higher.

#### Time and time format setting

- 1. Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose 🖸 and press 🚳
- 2.Select 🗑 clock and press 🚳
- 3. Navigate with to select the desire format, and set the time.
- 4. Press MENU to exit menu.

#### Timer setting

- 1. Press menu button MENU to access menu.
- choose 😨 and press 🚯
- 2.Select Timer and press
- 3. Navigate with to select the desire time.
- 4. Press MENU to exit menu.

#### Temperature alert setting



## 6. Trouble shooting

Problem	Possible cause/solution
No reception on the camera	The power adapters may not be properly connected. Ensure that the monitor and camera are on. Make sure the monitor and camera are not far away from each other. Monitor and camera may not be properly paired.Follow pairing instructions.
Interference or poor reception	Move the manifor closer to carners.  Use of other 2.4GHz product, such as wireless networks(Wi-Fi routers), Blueetooth systems, or microwave ovens, may cause interference with this product, so keep the baby monitor at least 5ft (1.5m) away from these types of products or turn them off if they appear to cause interference.  The monitor or carners may be too close to metal objects.  The battery power may be too low.
lmage frozen on the camera	Restart the monifor (unplug the power adapter from the wall outlet, wait for approx 5 seconds and plug it back into the wall outlet). Reset the camera by pressing the Reset button(16), located at the back of the camera, under the stand.
A high-pitched is heard from the unit (feedback,static)	The monitor and camera may be too close to each other. Move them further apart.  THE volume on the camera may be set too high. Lower the volume.
Cannot hear the monitor sounds on the camera	Volume setting on the camera may be too low.Increase the volume.     Battery power may be too low.Recharge the battery.
Background noises	In a quiet environment, surrounding the camera, decrease the volume on your parent unit to level 3 and below In a loud environment, surrounding the camera, increase the volume to the maximum level.
