

1. Power On/Off



Power on

Press and hold the button for 3 seconds while your phone is off.

Power off

Press and hold the button for 3 seconds while your phone is on.

Note

You can change the 'Power On/Off' graphic from Menu Display Main Display. (Setting Wallpaper, see p.74)

2. Voice Call



Making a call

Tap this button to connect to NATE.

After entering a phone number, you can enter menu.

Make a phone call.

Tap: Delete the last digit.
Tap and hold: Delete the whole number.

View phonebook.

View recent call history.




Making a call (Cont'd)

1 Using numeric pad




- When you enter a number, the easy calling function will run. When the list of numbers appear, tap , select the number then tap button to make a call.
- # Easy Calling: When the number is entered, phone automatically searches the matching number from recent list of outgoing calls.

2 Using the phonebook



- You can search and select the contact from your phonebook to make a call. (Search Number, see p.126)
- If you select the contact and tap _____, your phone will make a phone call to the 'Primary number'.

3 Using speed dial



 You can easily make a call by press and hold the speed dial number saved on your phone. (Adding speed dial p.129)

Using electronic dial



- You can pre-enter the several different numbers when you use the ARS.
- Tap to cancel the electronic dial during the call.

Example

P The numbers enterd after 'P' will be transmitted when you press T The numbers enterd after 'T' will be transmitted automatically after few seconds.



Answering a call

When call is incoming, open the clear cover or tap



- When the call is incoming you can press and hold the volume button down, to mute
- ringtone or disable the vibration.

 Tap 'End' to ignore the call.
- If you have registered 'Caller ID' service, caller's number will be shown on the screen.

Note

- You can change the 'Incoming Call' graphic from Menu ▶ Display ► Main Display.
- Depending on the size of the file, it may take some time loading up the wallpaper. (Setting Wallpaper, see p.74)

2. Voice Call (Cont'd)



Functions during a call During a call, you can unlock the switch to use other functions during a call. You can write/send the message during a call. You can access numeric pad. • You can mute your voice over the phone during a call. You can disable the function by tapping the button • Function will be disabled automatically when the call ends. Turn on the speaker to use the speakerphone.

Eliminates surrounding noise for better quality calling.

3. Text Entry



Text entry mode

■ When entering a text, tap ■ button to change the text mode.
■ Tap ■ to delete the last letter or tap and hold ■ to delete the whole sentences.

Entering Korean

Entering consonants

- To enter the first consonant on the button, tap once to enter the basic consonant.

 Tap the button twice to enter the double consonant.
- To enter the second consonant, enter the first consonant then tap button.

3. Text Entry (Cont'd)

Entering Korean (Cont'd)

Entering vowel

- You can enter and initial consonant, medial vowel and the final consonant. If the final consonant does not meet Korean orthography, your phone will automatically enter the next character.
- Initial consonant: 'ㅎ' is initial consonant in '홍'.
- Medial vowel: 'L' is medial vowel in '홍'.
- Final consonant: 'O' is final consonant in '홍'.
- To enter a second vowel on the button, tap the button twice. (For 1 ' is a second vowel.)
- To enter a diphthong, tap the buttons in order of strokes, or enter the basic vowel and tap
- Tap again to change to basic vowel from diphthong.

Entering alphabet and numbers

 Tap the button once, twice or three times in order to enter first, second or third alphabet on the button.

- From other text entry mode, tap and hold the button to enter the number.





1. Roaming

You can use your mobile phone outside of the country without subscribing extra services.



Select system

Menu ►T Service ► Roaming ► OK ► Input Password ► Select System

- You can select the roaming service provider in other countries.
- Default password is '0000'.

Korea (SKTelecom): Set as default, select when used within Korea.

Automatic: If you are in neither A nor B area, phone will automatically search for available service in the area.

A area (China, etc.): Select when you are using your phone in China, Thailand, Hong Kong, Guam. Saipan, Taiwan, Israel or some parts of the U.S.A.

B area (U.S.A., etc.): Select when you are using your phone in major part of the U.S.A,
Australia or Canada

CAUTION

- If you have changed setting on roaming service, contact service center immediately.
- Your phone may not work properly after changing the setting.
- If you can not make a call, try selecting different system.

2. M Service Center

You can connect mobile service center to check all the services available.

Roaming auto dial



- Drag and set 'Roaming Auto Dial' switch on/off to activate/ deactivate the function.
- This function will allow you to make call to domestic number from outside of the country without international access number or national code.
 - You can make a call using the number directly from the phonebook or call history.
- Roaming auto dial icon will be on the display when the function is on.

- TSM(Memory Manager) is a service that allows you to delete the old contents and download new content when the memory is full.
- If you download content from wireless internet (NATE, june, me) Playon, Game Box etc.), when you have no sufficient free space in the memory, TSM (memory manager) is started. You can download the content by executing the memory manager and deleting the content stored in the phone. - You can receive a call while playing the music content.
 The phone returns to the music play mode after the call.

 The phone continues playing music even if you close the slide while the phone is playing music content.
- You can select a section to be repeated by pressing & & . If you press & again, the selected section is repeated.
- If you press ___ (Left)[Menu], you can use the multi-tasking function to change settings, to access wireless internet, or to manage text messages while playing music content.
- If you press (Left)[End] while you are connected to wireless internet, the previous screen is displayed.



Downloading Melon Player

- 1) Access Motorola (http://www.mymotorola.co.kr), subscribe, and log in.
- 2) Select the Download Center in 'MOTOPRODUCT Product Information', and click Melon MP3 Player.
- If there is no USB driver program installed in the PC, click 'USB Driver Download' on the MP3 Player installation Guide. (Make sure to connect the phone with PC before installing the USB driver.)

Click DOWNLOAD of the model ▶ Click Save on the file downloading message box ▶ Select a folder and click Save ▶ Execute the file in the folder and click install ▶ Click OK on the installation complete window

- ** An error may occur when installing a USB driver depending on the environment of PC. Click Error in Driver Installation on the installation guide window and check the description.

- ** The PC with automatically recognize the phone and install the program. If an error occurs in recognizing the phone, click <u>Error in Driver Installation</u> on the installation guide window and check the description.

2 Downloading MP3 files

- Access the Melon website (www.melon.com) and subscribe to it as a member.
- In case of saving an MP3 file in the mobile phone, make sure to turn on the mobile phone, and connect it to PC via a 5PIN USB data cable before executing the Melon Player.
- 3) After executing the Melon Player, try log-in.
- 4) After selecting a desired song, you can enjoy music with an MP3 player or send this MP3 file to the mobile phone.
- ** To send file to the phone, SKT integrated USB driver is required. (See Melon website Customer Center for further information.)
- When sending an MP3 file to the phone via PC, do not remove the 5PIN USB data cable by force. Such act may cause malfunction of the phone.
- Service fee is charged for downloading MP3 files to PC or saving MP3 files to the phone. The fee will be charged based on SKT's Melon.

Playing MP3 files

- You can check the MP3 file downloaded to the phone via 'Melon box'. (Melon Contents, see p.70)
- Only MP3 files with extension 'DOF' can be played in the phone.
- ** This service is available for the customers who have an integrated ID issued from SKT membership site T-World (http://www.tworld.co.kr)
- ** In case of downloading or listening MP3 files on PC, it is not necessary to connect the phone.
- It is possible to send PC-downloaded MP3 files to the phone again. However, it is impossible to send files from the phone to PC again.
- ** To send MP3 files to the phone, make sure that you have an MP3-only phone and have the mobile phone authorized. (Contact the service provider or see Melon website Customer Center for further information.)

Before use

■ What is satellite DMB (Digital Multimedia Broadcasting)?

Satellite DMB refers to new media broadcasting service to allow the mobile phones to directly receive broadcasting radio waves from satellite DMB broadcasting center therefore you will be able to watch high-quality broadcasting contents anywhere, anytime.

■ What is TU?

TU is a mobile broadcasting service provider, allowing users to watch satellite DMB through their mobile phones. Visit TU website at http://www.tu4u.com for further information on TU services.

■ When watching DMB broadcasting

- In regions with weak radio waves, video contents may get slower or stopped. Use satellite DMB antenna to receive better radio waves.
- If you watch DMB for extended period of time, it will lead to higher power consumption. If low battery indicator appears, charge the battery before use your phone again.
- Under direct sunlight, you may find it difficult to see the screen.


- When you have connected satellite DMB antenna to your phone, do not hold the antenna and shake or swing the phone. The antenna or your phone may get damaged.






