About SKT Melon Player?

Melon player is the free exclusive PC software operating in PC. You can download, save, play, send or manage MP4 files (DCF files).

1 Downloading Melon Player

- 1) Access Motorola (<http://www.mymotorola.co.kr>), subscribe, and log in.
- 2) Select the Download Center in 'MOTOPRODUCT Product Information', and click Melon MP3 Player.
- 3) If there is no USB driver program installed in the PC, click 'USB Driver Download' on the MP3 Player installation Guide. (Make sure to connect the phone with PC before installing the USB driver.)

Click **DOWNLOAD** of the model ▶ Click **Save** on the file downloading message box ▶ Select a folder and click **Save** ▶ Execute the file in the folder and click install ▶ Click OK on the installation complete window

※ An error may occur when installing a USB driver depending on the environment of PC. Click **Error in Driver Installation** on the installation guide window and check the description.

- 4) Connect the phone with PC with the 5PIN USB data cable.

※ The PC will automatically recognize the phone and install the program. If an error occurs in recognizing the phone, click **Error in Driver Installation** on the installation guide window and check the description.

- 5) Contact the Melon homepage (<http://www.melon.com>), download a Melon player program, and install it on PC.

※ Click 'DOWNLOAD start' in Melon MP3 Player on the Motorola homepage.

Click **DOWNLOAD Start** ▶ Click **Save** on the file downloading message box ▶ Select a folder and click **Save** ▶ Click the file in the saved folder ▶ Click **Execute** on the file open window ▶ Install Melon Player ▶ Finish installation

2 Downloading MP3 files

- 1) Access the Melon homepage (www.melon.com) and subscribe to it as a member.
 - 2) In case of saving an MP3 file in the mobile phone, make sure to turn on the mobile phone, and connect it to PC via a 5PIN USB data cable before executing the Melon Player.
 - 3) After executing the Melon Player, try log-in.
 - 4) After selecting a desired song, you can enjoy music with an MP3 player or send this MP3 file to the mobile phone.
- ※ To send file to the phone, SKT integrated USB driver is required. (See Melon homepage Customer Center for further information.)
- ※ When sending an MP3 file to the phone via PC, do not remove the 5PIN USB data cable by force. Such act may cause malfunction of the phone.
- ※ Service fee is charged for downloading MP3 files to PC or saving MP3 files to the phone. The fee will be charged based on SKT's Melon.

3 Playing MP3 files


- You can check the MP3 file downloaded to the phone via 'Melon box'. (Melon Contents, see p70)
- Only MP3 files with extension 'DOF' can be played in the phone.
- ※ This service is available for the customers who have an integrated ID issued from SKT membership site T-World (<http://www.tworld.co.kr>)
- ※ In case of downloading or listening MP3 files on PC, it is not necessary to connect the phone.
- ※ It is possible to send PC-downloaded MP3 files to the phone again. However, it is impossible to send files from the phone to PC again.
- ※ To send MP3 files to the phone, make sure that you have an MP3-only phone and have the mobile phone authorized. (Contact the service provider or see Melon homepage Customer Center for further information.)

9. T MAP

With the satellite-based GPS function, you can use various navigations services including traffic information, location and route guide, and other driver convenience services.

Before Using T MAP

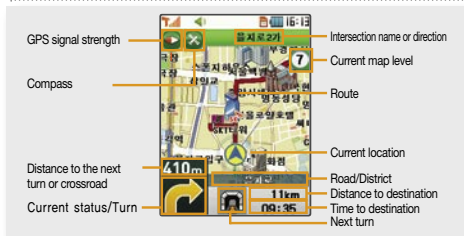
Press ► Select T MAP

- You can move to T MAP by pressing and holding  button on standby screen.
- You can use the T MAP service on the electronic map.
- The phone may fail to detect the accurate location in the underground or thnel where GPS signal is blocked.
- If the vehicle vibrates severely, there can be a vibration on the screen.










Note

- It is dangerous to use the phone while driving a car. Make sure to check the navigation information before driving a car.
- If the information from T MAP service is different from that on the road, make sure to follow the traffic regulations and actual road situation.
- A service fee is charged when you use the T MAP service. Contact the service provider or visit T MAP homepage (<http://tmap.tworld.co.kr>) for service and other further information.

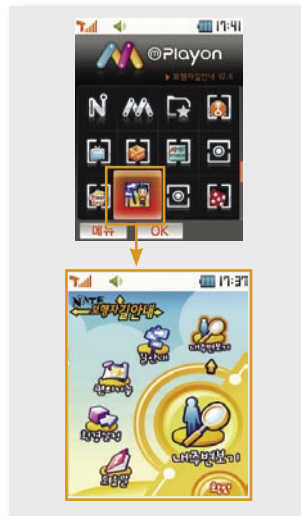
Find route	The phone searches the routes to the destination.
Recent route	The phone shows the recently used routes.
Safe driving	The phone provides supplementary information for safe driving.
Find friend	The phone shows the current location of a friend or family member.
T MAP life	The phone provides real time traffic information on highway/national road/metropolitan area
Traffic information	You can receive real time information on the traffic status of expressways/national roads/metropolitan area.
Safety	The phone provides the location of users for safety.
Travel & Location WAP	The phone provides variety of information on travel and navigation service. You can receive information from the navigation service internet sites.

Note

- The map data takes approx. 63MB of memory, and is subject to change according to upgrade.
- If you delete the map data, you can use as much as memory space. You can enter in the password and delete the map data by pressing  (Left)[Menu] ►  (Preference) ►  (Reset) ►  (T MAP reset). (Reset, see p.183)
- Navigation program can be deleted in @Playon. You can re-download the map by pressing  on the standby screen. A data service fee is charged for downloading the map.

NATE Pedestrian Navigation

Press **More** on the standby screen ► **Playon** ► Select navigation for pedestrian

- The service provides the route to the destination on the map in the phone.
 - The service is not available if you are in the building or underground.
- ※ See HELP for a service fee and further information.

My location : Your current location is displayed on the electronic map.

Emergency Call

If an emergency occurs, a notice is sent to the designated number.

Press and hold **More** on the standby screen ► The mobile security screen is displayed after a vibration ► Connect to the designated number

 - You cannot delete the default mobile security number.

12. T Interactive

1. Ringtone Style

You can set a ringtone for incoming calls.

Press (Left) ▶ Press ▶ Press



- You can connect to NATE and download a ringtone.
- If you press , the ringtone types are displayed.
- If you press (Right)[Connect] in 'Live ringtone' or 'My ringtone', you can download ringtones from NATE.
- When the etiquette mode is released, you can use (Volume key) to adjust the volume.
- You can manage live ringtones in 'Live Box' menu of 'Contents'. (Live Box, see p.108)



Note

- In addition to the default ringtones stored in your phone, you can download various ringtones from the melody downloading service of your service provider.

2. Download Ringtone

- Depending on the type of the ringtone downloaded, it saved in 'My ringtone' or 'Live ringtone'

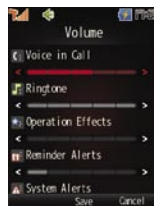

5. Volume

8. System Alerts

The phone notifies you of any error on the system or any incident set by the user.

- Disconnect tone :** When the call is disconnected
- 1min timer :** At every minute since the call is connected
- Out of SVC alert :** When the phone is out of the service coverage
- Low battery alert :** When the battery is low

9. Time Alert

The phone alarms when you press the volume key, open the folder or at every hour.

Press **[Left]** ▶ Press **[Z]** ▶ Press **[9]**



- You cannot set time alert when the start time is the same with the end time.
- If you have set the alert option as volume key, you can press and hold **[Volume Key]** (Volume key) to check the time even the folder is closed.

10. My Etiquette

Regardless of ring setting in the phone, the ring switches into the Etiquette mode (depending on cycle and ring/vibrate setting) at the designated time. (The Etiquette mode has the priority over the My Etiquette mode)

Press **[Left]** ▶ Press **[Z]** ▶ Press **[0]**



- **[0]** is displayed on the standby screen during the selected time for My Etiquette mode.
- If the stereo earset is connected, you can hear the ring through the earset.
- You cannot set My Etiquette mode if the start time is the same with content.
- My Etiquette mode may not be applied to some of the supplementary content.
- My Etiquette mode is not applied to morning call emergency message alert and photo/video shutter tone.

Ring/Vibrate Setting

- All vibrate :** Same as the Etiquette mode (Setting Etiquette mode, see p.86)
- Alarm & Alert only :** The ring/vibrate setting is applied to alarm bell, anniversary, D-day, Meeting Planner alarm only. (Call Alert Style, see p.85)
- All ring/vibrate off :** Silent Mode (no ring & no vibrate)

5. MMS Contents Box

The content available for attachment to messages are stored.

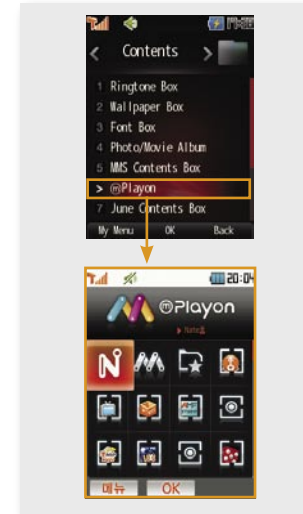
Press **Left** ▶ Press **5** (J.H) ▶ Press **4** (C.B) (GH)



- You can check photos, pictures, music, and video content in the attachment file box, or download new content from NATE content shop. (Contents Box, see p.165)

6. @Playon

You can use the downloaded content without reconnecting NATE.



Press **Left** ▶ Press **4** (C.B) (GH) ▶ Press **6** (L.T) (MNO)

- If the phone is set to mute in preferences of @Playon, the phone makes no sound when you move between the @Playon folder menu.
- If you have no sufficient free space in the memory, you can download the content by deleting the content stored in the phone.
- You can answer a call while you use the content, and return to the content after the call.

- If you downloaded @Playon content when you have no sufficient free space in the memory, TSM (memory manager) is started. You can download the content by deleting the content stored in the phone (excluding protected jun contents, live bell, and live screen content).

- If you delete all content from @Playon, the content stored in Game box are also deleted.

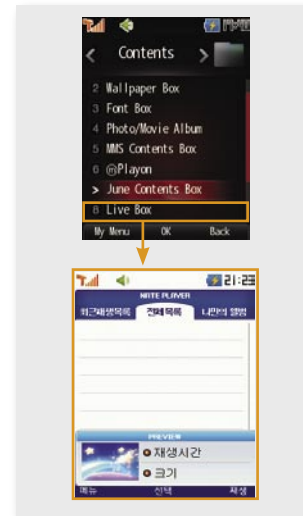

Delete	You can delete the selected content.
Add folder	You can create a folder to manage the content.
Delete all	You can delete all the downloaded content. (If you select Delete all, all the content in Game Box content are also deleted.)
Preferences	You can check the memory and set the volume and auto sorting order of the downloaded content.

7. june Contents Box

You can save, manage, and play the music content downloaded or received through internet.



Press **Left** ▶ Press **4** ▶ Press **7**

- You can select the content you want to play by pressing **Nice on**.
- You can download the music content as long as the memory capacity allows.
- You cannot play the content which is not completely downloaded. You can resume downloading by pressing **Right**.
- You can receive a call while playing the music content. The phone returns to the music play mode after the call.
- You can control volume with **Volume key** as the content is being played. The phone continues playing music even if you close the folder.
- You can select a section to be repeated by pressing **Repeat**. If you press **Repeat** again, the selected section is repeated (for vertical play).
- If you press **Left**, you can use the multi-tasking function to change settings, to access wireless internet, or to manage text messages while playing music content.
- You can change the settings for the music content stored in the june contents box with NATE player preferences menu. (june setting, see p.176)



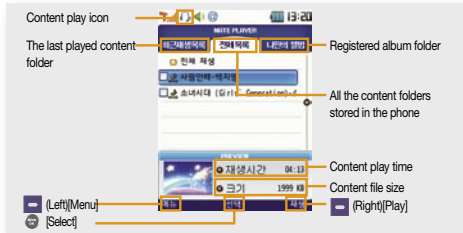
