# Safety Information

#### CAUTION

- Do not lend your phone to other person.
- Follow appropriate cell phone etiquette in public places.
- If any problem occurs with your phone, contact designated service center.
- If your phone is lost or stolen, report your mobile service provider immediately.
- Do not use unauthorized devices with your phone.
- Unauthorized battery charger, stereo earphone, USB data cable, batteries or any other unauthorized devices may decrease your product's performance and may result in product malfunction.
- Do not use your earphone for extended hours.
- If you are exposed to loud sound for extended period of time, it may damage your hearing.
- Make sure to save important data separately.
- Saved phone numbers or other data can get lost due to user's carelessness or other unexpected problems.
- Make sure to keep your phone in dry places (with relatively low humidity) at all time.
- If either mobile phone or battery is immersed in 'liquid', the color of immersion-checking label attached on your mobile phone or battery will be changed. In this case, you will loose the privilege of receiving free service by Motorola.
- For normal operation of the touchscreen, do not attach any protection film, Also, be careful with the moisture and use the touchscreen with clean and dry hands.

#### **CAUTION FOR USING BATTERY**



A Please keep the following directions to avoid of heating, fire and explosion.

- Contact the manufacturer or retail store immediately when you find swollen battery which can be dangerous.
- Use authentic charger only.
- Do not place the battery near heating apparatus. (Do not put the battery in microwave.)

### To use the mobile phone safely for a long time



#### Use authentic products only.

Using unauthorized products (battery, charger etc.) may shorten product's life or decrease its performance.



#### Be careful not to cause damages to the glass of mobile phone display.

External LCD of your mobile device is made out of tempered. This glass could break if the product is dropped on a hard surface or receives a substantial impact. If glass breaks, do not touch or attempt to remove. Stop using your mobile device until the glass is replaced by a qualified service center.



#### Do not dry your mobile phone with a heating apparatus.

If you dry wet mobile phone or battery with a heating apparatus, it may cause explosion or damage to your phone. In this case, do not turn on the power, separate a battery from the phone and contact a service center designated by Motorola.



#### Keep the mobile phone clean at all time.

- If there are foreign substances on a metal part of a charger or battery, the phone may not be charged properly.
- Use smooth cloth to clean the mobile phone and do not use flammable chemicals (such as alcohol, benzene, thinner, etc.) for cleaning.



#### Do not give strong impact to the mobile phone, disassemble or modify it

Giving a strong impact or dropping the mobile phone or battery may cause malfunction or explosion. In case of disassembling or modifying the mobile phone on your own discretion, you will lose privilege to receive free service



#### Do not use the phone while charging.

If you use the mobile phone while charging it with a charger or USB data cable, there is a risk of electric shock or fire. Make sure that you use the phone after disconnecting it from USB data cable or charger.



#### Be cautious when you use an USB data cable.

If you connect the phone with PC via USB data cable, there is a risk of electric shock depending on the grounding status of the PC's power supply.



#### Do not place your phone near items containing magnetic components.

Placing the phone near magnetic components may cause product malfunction or cause battery discharge which can lead to performance decrease.

### To use the mobile phone safely for a long time



#### Make sure to back-up all the data stored in your mobile phone.

- Saved data (such as phone number or pictures etc.) can be deleted unexpectedly due to user's carelessness, software upgrade or product repair etc.

#### Use and keep the phone at room temperature.

If a mobile phone or battery is placed in a hot or cold place, it may shorten product's life or decrease its performance.



#### Keep the phone out of animal or children's reach.

If children or animals suck or bite the mobile phone or battery, they may run into a risk of having an electric shock or exposure to electromagnetic wave.



#### Be careful when you use a necklace or cord for the mobile phone.

Be careful that using a necklace or cord for the mobile phone may cause you to run into dangerous accidents like being caught in train, electric railway or car doors.



#### Do not paint or put sticker on your mobile phone.

- Such action may damage your phone's joints and your phone may not open or close properly.

#### Do not use the mobile phone in a place with risk of explosion.

In a construction sites and military areas, explosives can be controlled with RF devices. Turn off your phone and follow the proper instructions and signals



#### Do not use the mobile phone near inflammable materials.

Do not use your phone or attach accessories on it in a potentially explosive atmosphere including gas station, gas leaking areas, and deck on boats



#### Do not use the mobile phone in a prohibited area such as air plane and hospitals.

Radio frequency emitted from your phone may affect some of the devices used in an air plane or hospitals and cause accidents



#### Do not use the mobile phone near pacemakers.

- • Electromagnetic waves from your mobile phone may affect pacemaker when it is used within 15cm (6 inches) from it.
- If it is necessary, person with pacemaker should always use the phone in the opposite side of the pacemaker and keep the distance over 15cm.



#### A chargeable battery is consumable.

The repetition of charging/discharging will shorten its operation time gradually



#### When the phone is not being charged properly, lamp on the charger will blink.

Check the charger to avoid the trouble that may occur to each device.



#### Mobile phone and battery cover need to be combined at all time.

If not, it may cause malfunction



#### In case of separating a battery from the mobile phone, please turn off the power.

If not, it may cause malfunction

### To use the mobile phone safely for a long time



Make sure to charge the battery with the TTA authorized battery charger.

Using unauthorized charger may cause damage to your phone.



Keep your phone at room temperature of 0°C~40°C, avoid direct sunlight or place with high temperature and humidity.

If not, it may damage the phone and cause the phone to explode



Do not place the phone in areas that may get very hot, such as microwave or near heating apparatus.

There is a risk of explosion or fire.



Ensure that charging terminal of the battery does not make contact with other metallic objects such as necklace, coins and keys.

There is a risk of explosion or fire



#### Do not use the mobile phone while driving.

- Using the mobile phone while driving a car is dangerous and such action can cause car accidents.
- Check the local laws and regulations on using the mobile phones while driving.



#### Do not install a hands-free device near air bag.

An air bag inflates with great force in a moment. Do not leave your phone or set up the hands-free kit near to the air bag. You may be seriously injured when the air bag is activated.

If you use wireless data service, DMB, camera, camcorder, play media or voice call for long time, your phone may get over heated. If your phone gets over heated, end the program and use it again after cooling down.

Your phone checks battery temperature on its own for your safety. When the temperature of the battery raises over 60°C, phone will automatically stop all the functions and notify you to place the phone in cooler area with a pop-up message. Pop-up message will appear every 3 minutes when the temperature of the battery is between 60°C to 65°C. When the temperature pass over 65°C, your phone will automatically turns in to cool down mode.

\* What is cool down mode?

It is a state where you can only make emergency calls and your phone will stop all the functions until the temperature of the battery becomes lower than 55°C. When the temperature becomes lower than 55°C, your phone will notify you in a pop-up message that your phone is back to normal.





### Using the Battery

Battery in the package is not fully charged, make sure to fully charge the battery.

#### Installing the battery




 Battery charge terminal and the phone charge terminal should be engaged as shown in the figure.

3 Place the battery cover to the battery cover groove and then push and slide it until it is properly fitted.

### Removing the battery



Slide the battery cover down in the direction of the arrow as shown in the figure.



2 Lift up the battery cover as shown in the picture.



3 Remove the battery from the phone.

Make sure the power is off when you remove the battery.

- If you remove the battery while the phone is on, it may damage your phone.



#### Charging the battery

Charging the battery with a USB data cable



- 1. Remove the external connection port cover and connect the USB data cable on the external connection port.
- . To use USB data cable to charge your phone, you must install exclusive USB driver fro XT800W in your PC.

You can download USB driver from Motorola website.

- If you connect your phone and PC by using USB data cable, you can transfer files and charge your phone.
- 2. Connect the USB data cable on the USB port of your PC.



. Some data cables, other than Motorola's authorized USB data cable. do not support battery charging function depending on their type.

#### Charging the battery with a battery charger



- 1. Insert the battery on the battery charger.
- . Check and make sure that the battery is in proper position.
- 2. Connect the travel charger to the battery charger.
- 3. Connect the power cord of the travel charger to an electrical outlet.
- · Red: Charging, Green: Charging completed

#### Charging the battery with a travel charger



- 1. Remove the external connection port cover and connect the multi adapter on the external connection port.
- 2. Connect the travel charger to the multi adapter.
- 3. Connect the power cord of the travel charger to an electrical outlet.
- · Red: Charging, Green: Charging completed



- Use TTA certified charger uncertified chargers may cause incidents or damage to your phone.
- Travel chargers are not included in the package for conservation of resources. You can purchase them separately from the retail shop or a service center.

#### Charging the battery with a docking station



- 1. Remove the external connection port cover and connect the phone to the docking station.
- 2. Connect the power on the rear side of the docking station.
- . If you connect the USB data cable to the docking station, LCD will turn off after certain period of time.

#### ▶ When using a USB data cable

- (1) Connect the USB data cable to the port on the rear side of the docking station.
- (2) Connect the USB data cable to the USB port on your PC.

#### ▶ When using a travel charger

- (1) Connect the multi adapter on the rear side of the docking station and connect the travel charger to the multi adapter.
- (2) Connect the power cord of the travel charger to an electrical outlet.

#### Lamp blinks in red

- Status of the charging terminal is poor. Check the connection status of the charger and check if the battery is clean.
- Battery or the other accessories may be damaged. Contact service center.

#### Lamp blinks in orange

- Battery is being charged in a place too hot or cold. When the temperature returns to normal, the lamp turns red and begins charging again.
- If the phone is being charged in a place too hot or too cold, it can stop charging itself. In this case, outline of the battery icon will become red ( ) If the temperature returns to room temperature, battery will start charging again.

#### Battery charging time

- Charging time can be different depending on the status of the battery and charger.
- Charging time may increase if the rated voltage of the charger is low.
- If you use the phone while charging, there is risk of electric shock and charging time may increase.

#### Battery operating time

#### \* Based on a new battery/Bluetooth mode off/no external memory

- Above service time of the battery is measured according to standard set by SKT.
- Using Wi-Fi, bluetooth or email function will increase battery consumption.
- If you have large amount of calling, it will be more convenient to charge a battery everyday.
- Calling or using Internet, MP3 or playing movie consumes more battery than when the phone is in standby. If the calling time becomes longer, standby time will get shorter.
- Receiving call will consume as much battery as making a call.
- Standby time may get shorter in out-of-service area.
- Operating time may vary depending on the charge status, temperature (high/low), wave status in the surrounding and the lighting.

#### Low battery

- If the available capacity of the battery is less than 15%, low battery window will appear on the screen.
- When the battery is low, functions may not be able to operate. Charge the phone immediately.

## Using USIM Card

In order to use the phone, you should insert the USIM (Universal Subscriber Identity Module) card supplied by SKT. Emergency calls can be made without the USIM card.

#### Inserting the USIM card



- 1. Remove the battery cover.
- 2. Lift up and pull out the battery.



- 3. Insert the USIM card as shown in the figure.
- Make sure that USIM card is inserted in proper position with the gold surface facing down.



- Put the battery back and closer the battery cover.
- Push the battery cover until it clicks.

#### Removing the USIM card



- 1. Remove the battery cover and the battery.
- 2. Remove the USIM card as shown in the figure.



- Calling and data usage fees are charged to the person registered to the USIM card. Therefore, be careful not to loose or transfer ownership.
   (We do not take responsibility for the financial damage caused by lost or stolen USIM card.)
- Set the password on your USIM card to prevent other people from using your USIM card when it is stolen or lost.

  (Set up USIM card lock, refer to page 127)
- Data inside of the USIM card can be damaged when the card gets scratched or bent.
- Using the USIM card with Transportation card function, battery usage time may get shorter.
- If you enter the wrong USIM card password for 3 consecutive times, USIM card usage will be restricted. In this case, contact the retail store or SKT.
- For more information on USIM card, contact SKT retail store or service center.



### Using the Memory Card

Memory card (8G), which is supplied upon your purchase, is inserted in your phone.

#### Inserting the memory card



1. Remove the battery cover and the battery.



2. Slightly lift up the card holder, pull it down and then insert the external memory card.

3. Push the card holder up and properly put the battery and the battery cover back.

#### Removing the memory card



- 1. Remove the battery cover.
- Lift up and pull out the battery.
- 3. Slightly lift up the card holder, pull it down and then remove the external memory card.

### Using the Earphone

You can use stereo earphone to listen to music, radio, watch DMB or make a call.



#### Connecting the earphone

1. Connect the 3.5mm stereo earphone on the Earphone connection port.



- . When using the FM radio, stereo earphone works as an antenna. Make sure that your earphone is connected.
- When you make a phone call, you can tap the button on the earphone to receive or hang up the call.
- Your phone does not support Micro USB type earphone.
- If you connect the earphone while playing music, noise may occur.

### Using the Docking Station

You can connect the phone to the docking station and use it.



- 1. Remove the external connection port cover.
- 2. Match the external connection port and connect it to the terminal on the docking station.
- If you connect your phone on the docking station, screen will change to the multimedia launcher.

### Power On/Off



#### Power on

1. Press and hold the button while the phone is off.

#### Power off

- 1. Press and hold the button while the phone is on.
- 2. Tap [Power off] when the Phone options window pops up.
- 3. Tap [OK] when the message window pops up.



## Unlocking the Touchscreen

If your phone is not being used for certain period of time, your touch screen will be locked. You must unlock the touchscreen before you use the phone.



- 1 Press the ( button when the touch screen is off
- 2. Tap and hold the and drag it to the right (as the arrow directs in the above figure.)
- Method of unlocking touchscreen can be different if you have set the unlock pattern from 'Location & security settings'.

#### If the unlock pattern is set

If the unlock pattern is set for security reason, you may unlock the touchscreen by drawing the preset pattern. (Setting the unlock pattern, refer to page 127)



- 1. Press the button when the touch screen is off.
- Draw the preset pattern.
- If you draw the wrong pattern more than 5 times, you cannot try for certain period of time. However, if you have set the Google account in your phone, you may tap the [Forgotten pattern?] and input your username and password to reset the unlock pattern.

#### Locking the touchscreen

- 1. Press the Dutton while the touchscreen in unlocked.
- If you have set the screen timeout, your phone will lock the screen automatically if you do not use the phone for preset time. (Screen time out, refer to page 126)

### Home Screen

#### Home screen description

If you want to move to Home screen, tap the find button,



Status bar - Status icons, notification icons and current time is displayed. Phone function - Move to phone function screen and you can use Dialer.

Call History, Contacts and Favorites.

Application tab - You can tap or drag it to check and select the applications.

Message function - Move to message function screen and you can write a new message, or check the sent and received

messages.

Checking the status bar

On the status bar, you can check the notification icon (on the left) and status icon (on the right).

Checking the notification window

If the notification icon (such as new message, upcoming schedule, alarm etc.) you can open the notification window to check the detail information.





- 1 Tap the Status bar
  - Tab will appear below the status bar.
- 2. Tap and drag the tab down.
- You can check the various notifications.
- You can tap [Clear] to delete all notifications.



• From the Home screen you can also tap ℍ → [Notifications] to check the notification window.

#### Using the Home screen


There are more than one panels available in the Home screen as extra space for user to add shortcuts and widgets.

You can flick the Home screen left and right to see more panels.









- You can flick the touchscreen left and right to add shortcuts on the Home screen.
- Tap the n button if you want to move to the Home screen directly while you are on the other screen or using other functions.

#### Setting the shortcuts on the Home screen



### Using the Touchscreen

#### Before using the touchscreen

- Do not attach protection film on the touchscreen for the normal operation.

- If you press the touchscreen too hard or give excessive shock, it may damage the sensor.
- Touch the button of the application accurately.
- Subtle touch can select other function
- You cannot touch the desired position when the other part of the body except your touching finger is on the touchscreen.

- Avoid using it in a place with high humidity and if your hands are wet, dry them before using the phone.
- Make sure conductive objects does not contact the touchscreen.
- Conductive objects may cause touchscreen malfunction.
- Be aware that touchscreen can only be used with human body. It cannot be used with stylus or other objects.
- Use the authorized products provided or sold as optional accessories by the manufacturer. Using an unauthorized accessories (Ex. protection tap. etc.) and disjointing and tuning of the phone may cause malfunction and performance decrease and damage.
- If you cannot touch the desired position because of water, dirt or other substances on the touchscreen, press the power button to lock the touchscreen. Then, clean the touchscreen and try again.



Using the phone while charging it with travel charger may cause malfunction on your touchscreen.
 If any problem occurs, disconnect the charger and try using it again.

### Specific Absorption Rate (IEEE)

Your model wireless phone meets the governmental requirements for exposure to radio waves.

Your mobile device is a radio transmitter and receiver. It is designed and manufactured to not exceed limits for exposure to radio frequency (RF) energy set by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) of the U.S. Government and by the Canadian regulatory authorities. These limits are part of comprehensive guidelines and establish permitted levels of RF energy for the general population. The SAR information includes the Motorola testing protocol, assessment procedure, and measurement uncertainty range for this product. While there may be differences between the SAR levels of various mobile devices and at various positions, they meet the governmental requirements for safe exposure.
