

#### **ASSEMBLE & CHARGE**



Caution: Please read "BATTERY USE & SAFETY" on page 48.

**Note:** This smartphone supports apps and services that use a lot of data, so make sure your data plan meets your needs. Contact your service provider for details.

#### WI-FI CONNECT

To use a Wi-Fi network for even faster Internet access, touch the status bar at the top of the home screen and drag it down. Touch the **Wi-Fi networks available** notification to select a preferred network.

You can also touch Menu => Settings > Menu => Settings > Wireless & networks to search for and connect to wireless networks. There's more in "WI-FI NETWORKS" on page 40.

## **TOUCHSCREEN & KEYS**

a few essentials

## **TOUCHSCREEN ON/OFF**

Your touchscreen is on when you need it and off when you don't.

- When you hold the smartphone to your ear during calls, your touchscreen sleeps to prevent accidental touches.
- To make your touchscreen sleep or wake up, just press Power ().
- To unlock the screen, press Power (1) then touch and flick to 1.

Note: Your touchscreen might stay dark if the sensor just above it is covered. Don't use



covers or screen protectors (even clear ones) that cover this sensor.

#### **TOUCH TIPS**

It's all in the touch:

- Touch: Choose an icon or option.
- Touch & Hold: Show options.
- Drag: Scroll or move slowly.
- Flick: Scroll or move quickly.
- Zoom: Slide fingers apart or together to zoom in or out on web pages, or photos.



#### **KEY TIPS**

#### MENU, HOME, BACK, & SEARCH

Touch Home (a) to close any menu or app and return to the home screen. In the home screen, touch and hold Home (c) to show the most recent apps used, then touch an app to open it.



Touch Menu (=) to open menu options.

Touch Back 🗩 to go back.

Touch Search for text search, or touch and hold for voice search.

#### **POWER KEY MENU**

Press and hold Power () to open the power key menu, where you can turn off your smartphone (**Power off**), turn **Airplane mode** or **Silent mode** on and off, or **Restart** your smartphone.

## **HOME SCREEN**

quick access to the things you need most

### **QUICK START: HOME SCREEN**

The *home screen* gives you all your latest information in one place. It's what you see when you turn on the smartphone or touch Home from a menu. It's basically like this:



Note: Your home screen might look a little different.

The home screen extends left and right to give you more room for adding shortcuts, widgets, and more. Flick the

home screen left and right to see more *panels* or to add widgets or shortcuts.

Tip: From the home screen, touch Home (a) to see thumbnails of the seven home screen panels. Touch a thumbnail to go to the panel.



## **USE & CHANGE YOUR HOME SCREEN**

On your home screen, *shortcuts* are icons that open your favorite apps, web bookmarks, contacts, mail labels, or music playlists. *Widgets* show you news, weather, messages, and other updates.

To see other panels of shortcuts and widgets, flick the home screen left or right. Or, touch Home and touch a thumbnail to go to the panel.

• To **open** something, touch it. Touch Home to return to the home screen.

**Tip:** When you open a widget, touch Menu (=) to see any options or settings.

- To **resize** widgets, touch and hold a corner until you feel a vibration, then drag.
- To add something or change your wallpaper, touch and hold an empty spot until you see the Add to Home screen menu.



You can add a folder to organize your shortcuts.

To move or delete something, touch and hold it until you feel a vibration, then drag it to another spot, another panel, or the trash at the top of the screen.

Shortcuts in the *dock* at the bottom of the home screen appear in all panel views. You can change these (except the app shortcut **O**). Touch and hold a shortcut, then select the shortcut you want to replace it.

#### **SMARTPHONE STATUS & NOTIFICATIONS**

Icons at the top of the screen notify you about messages and smartphone status. To see your notifications, touch the status bar and drag it down. Touch a notification to select it.



To dismiss a single notification, touch  $\bigcirc$ . To dismiss all notifications, touch **Clear**.

**Tip:** To see today's date, touch the status bar at the top of the screen.

## **APPS & UPDATES**

get the app you want

#### **QUICK START: APPS & UPDATES**

You can find all of your apps in one place. Touch of to open the app menu. To see all of your apps, flick up and down.

To group your apps, touch **apps**, then choose **All apps**, **Recent**, or **Downloaded**.



To close, touch Home 🖾 or Back 🖘

## **RECENT APPS**

Your smartphone remembers the apps that you used most recently. From the home screen, touch and hold Home (a) to show the most recent apps used, or touch (a) > Recent.

## **QUICK START: CALLS**

#### DIALING OPTIONS

From the home screen, touch 🕵 Phone.



**Tip:** Search for contacts right from the dialpad. For example, to find **Jeff** in your contacts list, touch **5-3-3-3**. Matching contacts appear above the dialpad.

#### **IN-CALL OPTIONS**



To use a Bluetooth<sup>™</sup> device, touch **Bluetooth**. (The device must be turned on and previously paired—see "**CONNECT NEW DEVICES**" on page 41.)

**Note:** Using a mobile device or accessory while driving may cause distraction and may be illegal. Always obey the laws and drive safely.

#### **MAKE & ANSWER CALLS**

To make a call, touch **I** Phone, enter a number, then touch **C**.

To **answer** a call, touch **()** and flick to **()**.

To **ignore** an incoming call, touch **()** and flick to **(**).

**Tip:** To silence an incoming call alert, press Power **O** or the volume keys.

**Note:** When you hold your smartphone to your ear, the display goes dark to prevent accidental touches. When you move it away from your ear, the display lights up again.

#### **EMERGENCY CALLS**

**Note:** Your service provider programs one or more emergency phone numbers that you can call under any circumstances, even when your smartphone is locked. Emergency numbers vary by country. Your pre-programmed emergency number(s) may not work in all locations, and sometimes an emergency call cannot be placed due to network, environmental, or interference issues.

1 Touch **[1] Phone** (if your smartphone is locked, touch **Emergency Call**).

- 2 Enter the emergency number.
- **3** Touch **(** to call the emergency number.

#### **COOL DOWN**


In very limited circumstances, such as where your smartphone has been exposed to extreme heat, you may see "Cool Down" messages. To avoid possible damage to your battery and smartphone, you should follow these instructions until the smartphone is within its recommended temperature range. When your smartphone is in "Cool Down" mode, only emergency calls can be made.

#### EDIT OR DELETE CONTACTS Find it: 🖸 > 💶 Contacts

Touch and hold the contact, then touch **Edit contact** or **Delete contact**.

## PERSONALIZE CONTACTS

#### Find it: 🖸 > 🚺 Contacts

Add a photo: Touch and hold the contact, then touch Edit contact > 🔯.

**Set a ringtone**: Touch the contact, then touch Menu = > **Options** > **Ringtone**.

## MESSAGING

sometimes it's best to text or email...

#### **QUICK START: TEXT MESSAGING**

From the home screen, touch 🔀 Messaging.



Tip: To see more messages, flick or drag up.

 To create a text message, touch Messaging > Compose new message. To attach a file, insert a photo, or other options, touch Menu . • To open text messages, touch **Messaging**, then touch the sender's name.

When you see in the status bar at the top of your screen, flick down the status bar and touch the new message to open it.

- To **respond** to a text message, just open it and enter your response in the text box at the bottom.
- To forward, copy, and more, touch Messaging, touch the sender's name, then touch and hold the message.

#### EMAIL

To set up up an email account, touch for Email and follow the wizard. To add more standard accounts, open 
 Email and touch Menu > Accounts > Menu > Add account. For details, contact your account provider.

 To open an email, touch O > Email. Touch a message to open it.

Tip: Touch Menu 🔳 for options, like Refresh or Search.

To create an email, touch > @ Email, then touch Menu > Compose.

Tip: Touch Menu effor options, like Attach or Add Cc/Bcc.

#### VOICEMAIL

When you have a new voicemail,  $\infty$  appears at the top of the screen. Drag down the status bar and touch the **New voicemail** notification to listen to your voicemail message.



#### **TOUCHSCREEN KEYPAD**

You can open a keypad on your screen by touching a text box. To close the keypad, touch Back (=).



#### **INPUT METHODS**

To select an input method, touch and hold a text entry area to open the **Edit text** menu. Touch **Input method**, then touch the method you want.

Enter <b>one capital</b> letter	Touch Shift 🚱.
Enter <b>only capital</b> letters, until you touch Shift 😧 again	Touch Shift 😭 twice. Touch again to revert to lowercase.
Move the text entry cursor	Touch the text where you want the cursor to go.
Select text	Touch and hold text, then touch <b>Select word</b> or <b>Select all</b> .
Cut or Copy selected text	Touch and hold text, then touch <b>Cut</b> or <b>Copy</b> .
Paste cut or copied text at cursor location	Touch and hold location to paste, then touch <b>Paste</b> .
Delete character to left of cursor	Touch Delete 🕲 (hold to delete more).



#### PHOTOS

#### **TAKE & SHARE PHOTOS**

Take that family photo, and post it online for everyone to see.

#### Find it: 🖸 > 🚺 Camera



To **take** the photo, touch 🛞 in the viewfinder screen.

Your smartphone stores the photo, and shows a thumbnail image in the corner of the screen. To see the photo you just took, touch the thumbnail. Then:

- To set the photo as a wallpaper or contact photo, touch Menu > More > Set as > Wallpaper.
- To send the photo in a message or post it online, touch Y.
- To delete the photo, touch Delete.

#### VIDEOS

#### **RECORD & SHARE VIDEOS**

Find it: O > Camera, then touch or drag the camera switch up to select the camcorder



To **record** a video, touch **(**) in the viewfinder screen. To **stop** the video recording, touch **(**) again.

Your phone stores the video, and shows a thumbnail image of the video in the corner of the screen. To see the video you just took, touch the thumbnail. Then:

To play the video, touch **O**.

- To send the video in a message or post it online, touch <sup>3</sup>. For more info on sharing your video, see "RECORD & SHARE VIDEOS" on page 29.
- To delete the video, touch Delete.

#### SHARE PHOTOS & VIDEOS

Find it: 🖸 > 🛄 Gallery > photo or video

Touch 🍟, then choose how you want to share—like Bluetooth, Email, Messaging, or an online album.

#### MANAGE PHOTOS & VIDEOS

Find it: O > Gallery > photo or video

Touch Menu 🔳 > More > Delete, Crop, Set as (photo), or Rotate.



**Tip:** When a song is playing, you can add it to a playlist by touching Menu => **Add to playlist**.

**Tip:** To listen to music during a flight, turn off all your network and wireless connections: Press and hold Power () then touch **Airplane mode**.
