Remove the back cover & battery

To insert SIM and memory cards, remove the back cover

Caution: Don't use tools to remove the cover-doing so might damage your phone.

Put in the cards

Your phone supports using two SIM cards

Caution: Make sure you use the correct size SIM card and don't cut the SIM card. Don't Nana SIM use tools to remove the battery-doing so might damage your battery or your phone.



Put on the back cover. Connect your charger to charge your phone fully, then turn on the power. Select your language and follow the screen prompts to get started.



- Add a shortcut: Swipe up ^ tap and hold an app then drag it to your home screen.
- Settings: To change your Wi-Fi, display brightness. and more swipe the status bar down with two fingers. To open more settings, tap 🍳
- Share your phone: To add a quest user, swipe the status bar down with two fingers and tap \mathbf{S}

- Actions: Your phone responds to your gestures instantly. Chop twice to turn on the flashlight, turn over to activate the do not disturb mode and more
- Display: See messages, calls and other notifications, even when you phone is asleep. Touch and hold a notification to see what's new, then swipe to take action.
