## Fixed Dialing



You can restrict outgoing calls to phone numbers that begin with the same digit(s) you set on the fixed dialing list.

**Tip:** Enter the PIN2 code to use **Fixed dial number**.

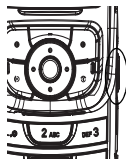

# Voice Dialing

Press the smart key to launch the voice dial application from the idle display. To dial by voice, you can either select **Call name/command** and then say a recorded name (voice tag) into the microphone, or select **Dial number** and then directly say a phone number into the microphone.



**Note:** If you select **Call name/command**, it is available only for the phone numbers saved on phone memory.

**Note:** If you select **Dial number**, you can dial phone numbers simply by speaking the number continuously, without pausing between the digits. The phone recognizes the digits “one,” “two,” “three,” “four,” “five,” “six,” “seven,” “eight,” “nine,” “zero,” and “oh.” The phone cannot recognize numbers such as “1 eight hundred” for “1 800.” Say “one eight zero zero” instead.

The voice dial application allows you pronounce English or Chinese phone numbers into the microphone. Listed below is the table of numbers vs. method of pronunciation:

**Tip:** You can use English only to articulate phone numbers in all marketing areas except for Taiwan, Hong Kong and China. In Taiwan's market, use both English and Mandarin (for Taiwan) to articulate phone numbers. In Hong Kong's market, use all the 5 methods of pronunciation above to



articulate phone numbers. In China's market, use both English and Mandarin (for China) to articulate phone numbers.

## Customizing Number Dialing to Your Voice

# Restoring Factory Settings

You can let the phone use the factory settings after customizing it.

- Ring volume** Select ring tone volume. Maximum is **Volume 5**.
- Ring tone** Select a ring tone and it will play when you receive incoming calls.
- Incoming call alert** Define how a ring tone works with your incoming calls.

**Tip:** Select **Off** to turn **Ring tone** off. If you turn **Ring tone** off and turn **Vibrating** on, the phone vibrates when you receive calls.

- Vibrating** Turn vibrator on or off.
- Message alert tone** Select an alert tone and it will play when you receive messages.
- Tip:** Select **Off** to turn **Message alert tone** off. If you turn **Message alert tone** off and turn **Vibrating** on, the phone vibrates when you receive messages.
- Key tone volume** Select key tone volume. Maximum is **Level 5**.
- Key tone type** Select a key tone.
- Tip:** Select **Off** to turn key tone off.
- Warning tones** Turn **Warning tones** on or off. **Warning tones** is played when battery power is low or there is any operation error.
- Startup music** Turn **Startup music** on or off. **Startup music** is played when you turn the phone on or off.
- Flip music** Turn **Flip music** on or off. **Flip music** is played when you open or close the phone flip.
- Voice dial** Turn **Voice dial** on or off. To edit voice dial entries, see page 114.
- Note:** To turn **Voice dial** on or off is available for **Handsfree/Headset** only.
- Auto answer** Turn **Auto answer** on or off.
- Note:** **Auto answer** is for **Handsfree/Headset** only.

To receive or send fax and data calls, use an optional Motorola Original™ data cable to connect the phone to your personal computer.

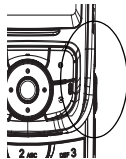
