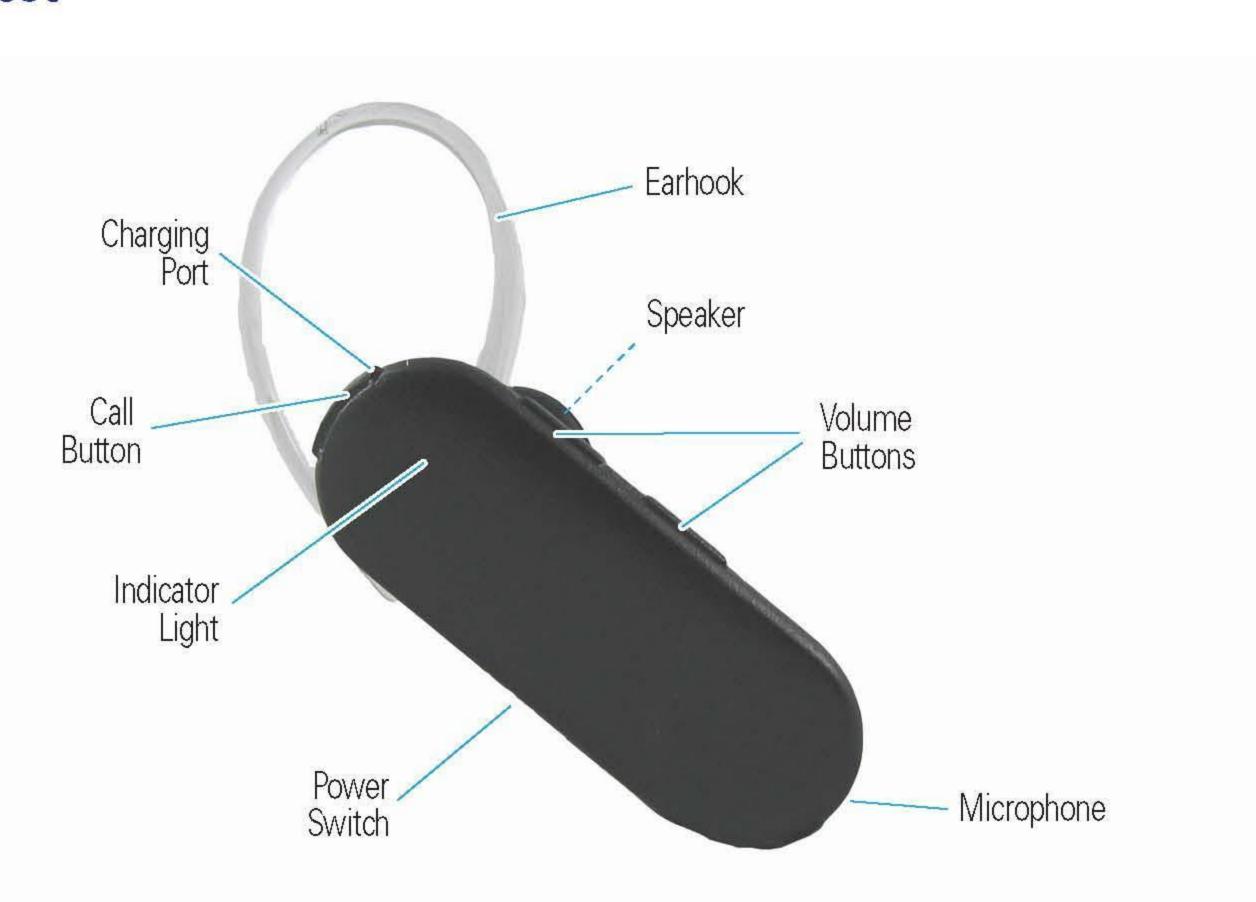

To confirm connection to your phones:

- Place the headset over your ear (see "put it on") for help). One phone at a time, dial the number you want
- to call and press **SEND** key on your phone. If your phone and headset are successfully paired, you will hear ringing on the headset.

will I need to do this every time?

No. After initially connecting your phone(s) and headset, you don't need to do this again.

For daily use, just ensure that your headset is turned ON and that your phone's Bluetooth feature is ON. Your headset and phone will connect automatically

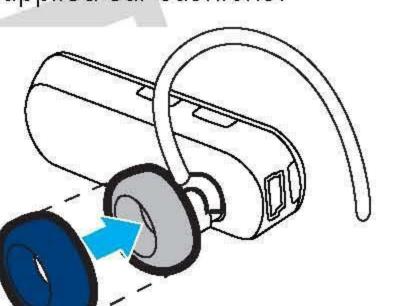

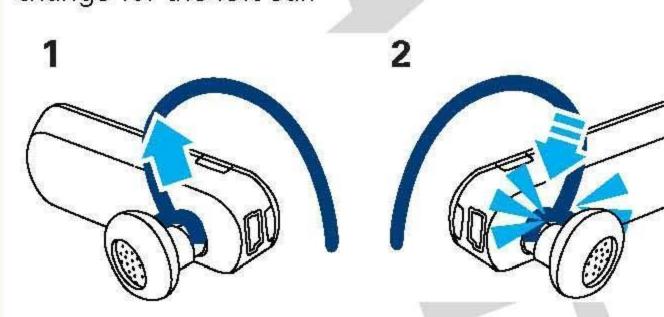
pick an ear cushion

Your headset's performance is greatly dependent upon achieving a good fit on your ear, so be sure to try all the supplied ear cushions.



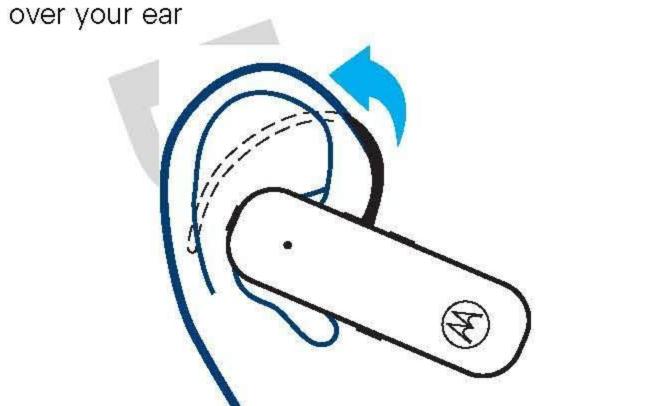
which ear do you want to use?

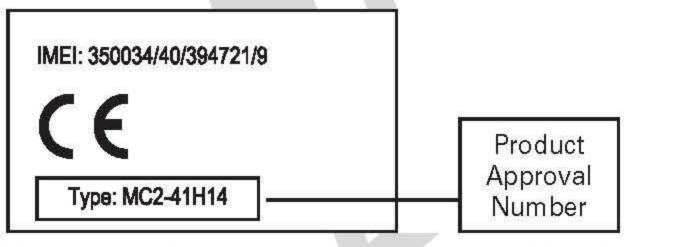
