
Thank you for purchasing a NAPCO iSecure kit.

The components in the kit have been preconfigured as a complete system to allow a quick and easy installation. The included keypad, motion sensor and door/window sensors have been preconfigured in the cloud and are ready to be downloaded into your Go-Anywhere Hub, with no programming required.

First, activate your new iSecure account on NAPCO ComNet. If you do not have a ComNet account...

- 1. Go to www.NapcoComNet.com
- 2. Enter your iSecure ID # and the select your service plan
- 3. Go to www.iSecureByNapco.com to configure central station communications
- Click Dealer Login and enter your Dealer User ID, Password and Radio Serial Number
- 5. Click Central Station Reporting





- Enter your central station telephone number
- Enter your central station account number

Seller will not be responsible for any dismantling or reinstallation charges.

ADDITIONALLY, THIS WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER OBLIGATIONS OR LIABILITIES ON THE PART OF NAPCO.

Any action for breach of warranty, including but not limited to any implied warranty of merchantability, must be brought within the six months following the end of the warranty period. IN NO CASE SHALL NAPCO BE LIABLE TO ANYONE FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES FOR BREACH OF THIS OR ANY OTHER WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, EVEN IF THE LOSS OR DAMAGE IS CAUSED BY THE SELLER'S OWN NEGLIGENCE OR FAULT.

This warranty contains the entire warranty. It is the sole warranty and any prior agreements or representations, whether oral or written, are either merged herein or are expressly cancelled. NAPCO neither assumes, nor

authorizes any other person purporting to act on its behalf to modify, to change, or to assume for it, any other warranty or liability concerning its products.

In no event shall NAPCO be liable for an amount in excess of NAPCO's original selling price of the product, for any loss or damage, whether direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or otherwise arising out of any failure of the product. Seller's warranty, as hereinabove set forth, shall not be enlarged, diminished or affected by and no obligation or liability shall arise or grow out of Seller's rendering of technical advice or service in connection with Buyer's order of the goods furnished hereunder.
