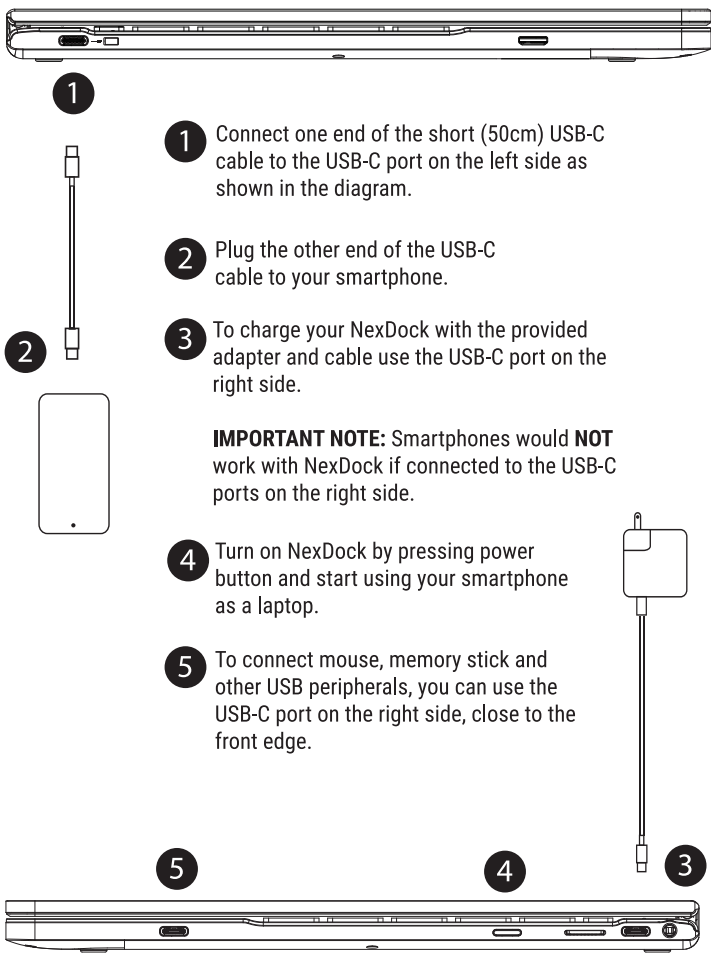

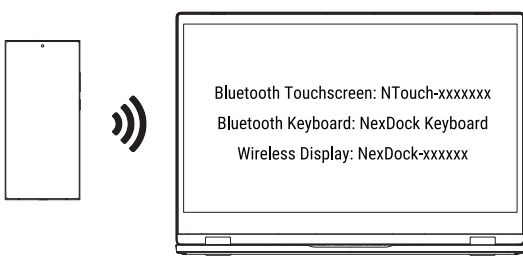

- 1 Turn on your NexDock and wait for "NexDock is ready to connect" screen.
- 2 Open Settings/Connections/Bluetooth on your smartphone.

Click "Scan" and pair to "NexDock Keyboard". For touchscreen connection, pair to "NTouch-xxxxxx" where xxxxxx can be random characters such as NTouch-a1DF168.

- 3 For Samsung phones, pull down the notification bar and tap on DeX in the Quick Settings panel. Alternatively, open "Settings/Advanced Features" and enable "Samsung DeX".

Choose "DeX on TV or Monitor" and "Connect wirelessly". When you see "NexDock-XXXXX" click "Start Now".

NOTE 1: If you are using a non-Samsung phone, search for "Cast" or "Screen Sharing" or "Wireless Display" in Settings and follow the instructions on your phone. For Motorola phones that support "Ready For" go to "Settings/Connected Devices/Ready For" and follow the instructions.

NOTE 2: You can disconnect bluetooth keyboard any time by pressing FN+C keys on NexDock. To disconnect bluetooth touchscreen you need to unpair NTouch-xxxxxx from your smartphone's bluetooth settings.

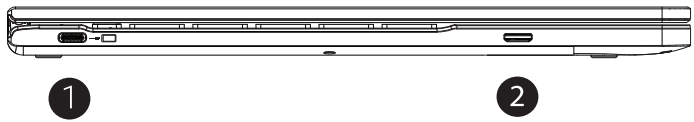

Connecting other devices



1 USB-C Input

Multiple devices can be connected to NexDock's display, keyboard & touchpad via USB-C cable. This cable can power your device (up to 5V1A) and connect to the other ports on the right side. The devices you can use with USB-C input port are:

- USB-C smartphones with video output
- USB-C Macbooks, USB-C iPads
- USB-C Laptops, Chromebooks
- Nintendo Switch, Steam Deck

2 HDMI Input

The devices you can use with HDMI input are:

- PCs, Laptops, Servers
- Game consoles such as Play Station, Xbox
- TV Sticks, Chromecast and any other device with HDMI out

When a device is connected via HDMI, a secondary USB cable is required to connect to keyboard, touchpad and touchscreen. Raspberry Pi 4 can also be connected via USB-C by adding a line of code to config.txt. Please check NexDock.com/support to learn more.

When a device is connected only through HDMI, you can still control volume, brightness and more settings via OSD Control panel on the touch screen (see next page).

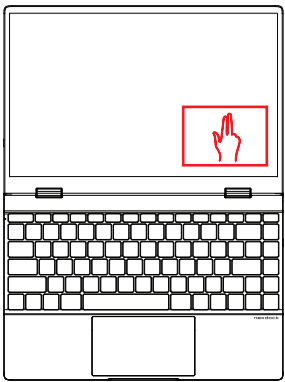
On Screen Display (OSD) Control Panel

OSD control panel lets you adjust the volume, screen brightness, contrast, sharpness, color temperature of the display and more!

To open the OSD control panel swipe down with 2 fingers at lower right corner of the touch screen as shown.

You can also disable smartphone charging, lock screen rotation and check battery charge level of NexDock using OSD control panel.

Keyboard Function Keys

Function keys on the keyboard works only when a device is connected via USB-C input or bluetooth and when NexDock is not working in tablet mode.

To use alternate commands hold down Fn and press the Function key at the same time.

The function keys on NexDock are:

- Fn + F1 Switch between the open apps
- Fn + F2 Check battery charge level of NexDock
- Fn + F3 Mute
- Fn + F4 Volume Down
- Fn + F5 Volume Up
- Fn + F6 Brightness Down
- Fn + F7 Brightness Up
- Fn + F8 Previous Track
- Fn + F9 Play/Pause Media
- Fn + F10 Next Track
- Fn + F11 Turn On/Off Keyboard Backlit
- Fn + F12 Take Screenshot
- Fn + C Disconnect bluetooth keyboard
