

Rear View of NextD Player




Infrared (IR) Remote Control

Short Press: Display ON/OFF

Long Press: Power OFF

Used for initial set up and basic navigation

Easy Setup




Insert two AAA batteries into IR remote control.






Turn on TV then select the HDMI input connected to NextD.






Connect the NextD Player to your TV via an HDMI cable then plug in power.






Follow the on-screen wizard to complete the setup.

Install the NextD Remote app on your smartphone to enable full control of the NextD Player.






Remote App Tutorial 1/3



This mode works like a touchpad but enhanced with multi-touch and motion-sensing capabilities.

General purpose navigation




Mirror Touch Mode

This mode mirrors the exact touch input and location from remote to TV.

BEST SUITED FOR:

Games with multiple static on-screen controls



The TV screen snapshot helps users locate the on-screen game controls. It only updates after the snapshot button is clicked.

Media Control Mode

This mode provides shortcuts for music and video selection, playback, and volume control.

BEST SUITED FOR:
Movie and music apps

Some media apps do not work with Media Control Mode. Use other input modes instead.
