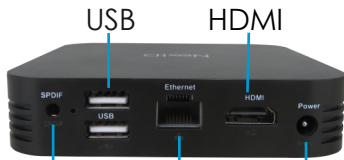

Easy Setup

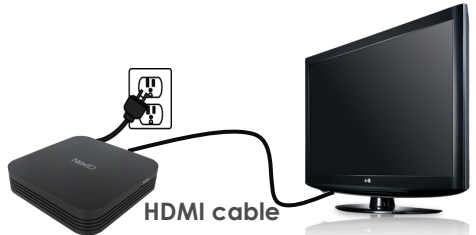

Insert two AAA batteries into IR remote control.



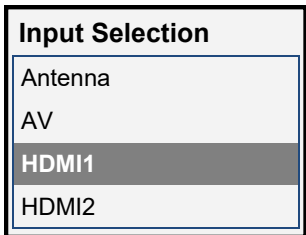

Connect the NextD Player to your TV via an HDMI cable then plug in power.



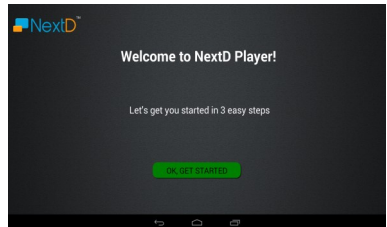

Turn on TV then select the HDMI input connected to NextD.



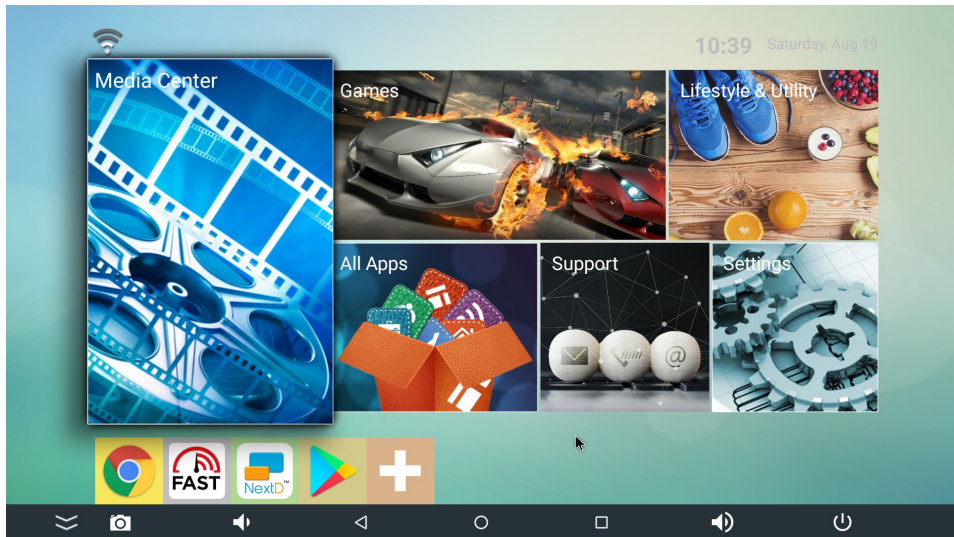

Install the NextD Remote app on your smartphone to enable full control of the NextD Player.



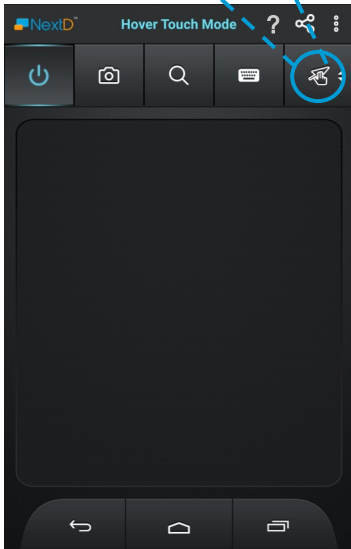
Remote App Tutorial 1/3

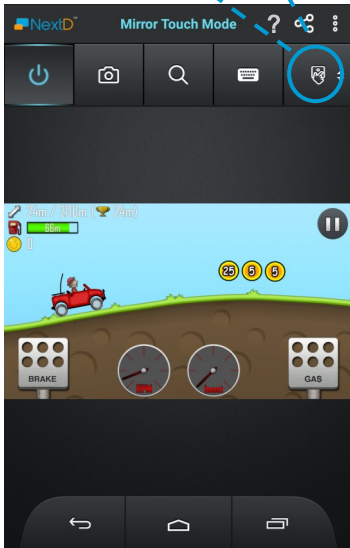
Remote App Tutorial 2/3

Mirror Touch Mode

This mode mirrors the exact touch input and location from remote to TV.

BEST SUITED FOR:

Games with multiple static on-screen controls



Gestures on Mobile

Actions On TV




Tap/Swipe



Pinch/Zoom



The TV screen snapshot helps users locate the on-screen game controls. It only updates after the  snapshot button is clicked.

Remote App Tutorial 3/3

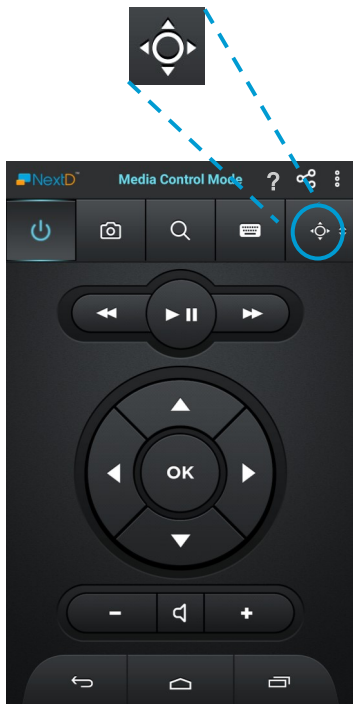
Media Control Mode

Movie and music apps

Some media apps do not work with Media Control Mode. Use other input modes instead.
