It offers the Montana version of full-range response combining NHT's (U.S. Patent #5,952,619) 3-tweeter array and the "Big Daddy" — an aluminum cone, 8" hella-long-throw woofer that can jostle innards and boom a base line to a ridiculous 40Hz. Yowza.
