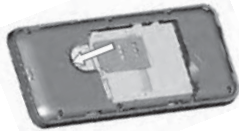

## Preparing your phone

### Install SIM card

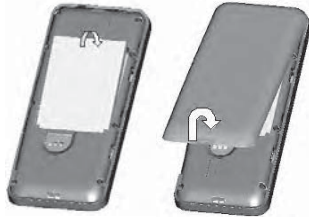
- ❖ Keep SIM card out of children's touch.
- ❖ Any abrasion or folding could easily damage SIM card, so please be extremely careful when you insert, remove and preserve it.
- ❖ Please make sure that you have cut off the power supply and have taken out battery before you remove SIM card.

Find SIM card's groove in the back of phone and slide it completely there. During installation, please make sure that the chip is facing downwards and pay attention to slot direction.



### Install Battery

1. Align the battery chip with the metallic salient point in battery jar, insert the battery and press top of the battery downwards as per the arrow direction until it is inserted into the battery jar.
2. Slide battery cover into back of the phone until it is locked. (Refer to the figure)

### Remove Battery

First switch off the phone and make it face downwards, Slide the back cover toward the bottom of the phone until it can be removed, then push toward the top of the phone and lift the battery at the center of the bottom side to remove.



- ❖ All settings or information stored in SIM card and the phone may be lost when the battery is removed.
- ❖ Please remove the battery when the phone is switched off, because it may suffer from abnormality if you remove the battery when it is switched on.

### Charge Battery

Unclose dustproof soft gum of attachment mode on right side of the phone, insert one end of the charger, i.e., the charging plug into attachment mode and the other end into electrical outlet. If the phone is switched on and the battery power icon stripes in right hand of the screen are rolling, then it is charging. If the stripes are full and have stopped rolling, it is fully charged. If the phone is switched off when charging, the information of the charging will display in screen. After charging is finished, just pull out the plug.

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- ❖ Do not directly remove the battery panel when charging.
- ❖ The phone must be put in a ventilated place with the ambient temperature of 0°C ~ 45°C when charging.

### Security codes

#### -PIN code

This is the private identity code of your SIM card, and PIN is usually provided by the Operation Company together with SIM card. If you enter the wrong PIN for successive three times, the SIM card will be locked and you need to enter PUK code to unlock. For further information please contact the operation company to unlock it.

#### -PIN2 code

PIN2 code is provided together with some SIM cards. This number provided by Operation Company is for inputting some functions (such as charge unit, FDN and etc). If you enter the wrong PIN2 for successive three times, you also need to enter PUK2

- ❖ When the battery current is low, the phone will give warning alert, and when it is too low, the phone will automatically switch off. Do not keep the battery current low for a long time, otherwise the battery quality and life could be damaged.
- ❖ A pre-charge will occur when the battery voltage is too low, so it is normal that the phone may not give charging alert.
- ❖ To guarantee the phone's normal work, please use the designated charger.

#### -PUK code

Change of locked PIN needs PUK, the private unlocking code. PUK and SIM card are provided together. Otherwise, please contact your service provider to obtain the code. If you lose this code, you should also contact your service provider.




#### -Phone lock code

Phone lock code can prevent others to use your phone without authorization (original phone lock code is 1234). To protect the safety of your personal information, please timely modify the original phone lock code.

## Using your phone



### Switching On

1. Long press the  key to switch on your phone, the backlight will be turned on and a switch-on animation will be displayed in screen.
2. The screen will display a warning interface if SIM card has not been installed or has bad contact. Long press the  key to switch off, please install SIM card again and make sure it is correctly installed.
3. If SIM card is being protected by PIN, you have to enter the correct PIN, then press the  key to confirm it.
4. If SIM card is locked, you need to enter PUK.
5. If the phone lock code has been set, you have to enter the code to unlock your phone.
6. After switched on, the phone will automatically search the network.

◇ Network name and signal level will display in screen if the phone has searched the authorized network. Otherwise the phone could only use some non-communication function like emergency calls.


### Making a call

#### -Making a domestic call

In the idle interface, press the numeric keys corresponding to enter the phone number that you want to dial, including the necessary district number, press the  key to delete wrong enter; press the  key to make a call, then a dialing animation will display in screen, when the other side answers call status information will display in the screen.


**-Making a call to a fixed extension set**  
some fixed extension sets can not be directly dialed through, you have to dial the

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switchboard first, long press the  key until "P" displays in screen, then you can dial the extension number.

Dial the fixed extension set on the following sequence:  
District number - Switchboard number - P - extension number - Dial key


#### -Making an international call

To make an international call, long press the  key until the prefix symbol "+" of international call display in screen, which enables you to call the phone number from any country when you do not know the local prefix symbol (for example, it is 00 in china). Make an international call on the following sequence:



+ - country code - whole telephone number - Dial key

After entering the prefix number, you need to enter the district number and whole telephone number. Status district number are in accordance with conventional ones. Just like the dialing of international call, "0" before the city district number should be deleted.

### Calling a number in the Phonebook

Directly press the down navigator in the idle interface, or select Phonebook in the main menu to enter the phonebook contacts list interface, press the up/down navigator to find the contact that you want to dial, then directly press the  key to make a call.



### Calling a number in the Call Records

All dialed calls, answered calls and missed calls are saved in each menu under the phone's call records according to their different type. When the records is full, former records will be automatically deleted. Press the  key in the idle interface then you can directly view recent call records. For the records display in the call record list, you can press the  key to directly dial.



### Receiving a call

When there is an incoming call, the phone will give corresponding alert (such as vibration, ring and so on). If the network supports, the phone screen can even

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display the caller's name or number (depending on whether there is information about the caller in your phonebook), you can press the  key or the  key to answer the call.





### Rejecting a call

If you do not want to answer an incoming call, press the  key or the  key to reject it.


### Adjust volume

You can adjust the volume by the settings function, and also you can press the up/down navigator to adjust volume during calling.

### End a call

You can press the  key or the  key to end a call. If you want to cancel a dialed call you can also press the  key or the  key.



### Lock the keypads


In the idle interface, and the backlight is turn on, long press the  key can lock or unlock the keypads.

### Emergency service

You can directly dial the emergency service number without SIM card. Different networks use different urgency service number, so for details please inquire the network operation company.

### Call options

During call, long press the  key to select H-Free can activate the sound amplification and long press the  key again to close.

Press the  [Option] key to enter call option which can be only seen during call.

Functions like call waiting, call hold, multilateral conference need network support, and for details please contact the network operation company.


In call options you can make the following operations:

- **Hold/Unhold**: To hold the active call or resume a held call.
- **Hands-free**: to activate or deactivate the loudspeaker for hands-free function.
- **Mute/Mute OFF**: Mute local voice can not be sent when activate the mute function.
- **Build MPTY**: Enter the multilateral conference call status.
- **Release All**: End all calls.

### Switch Off

Long press the  key to switch off your phone.

◇ During the multilateral conference call status, press the  [Switch] key could swap between the held call and the active call.

◇ Menu options labeled with \* could display only under specific circumstances, such as "Release All" will display only in the coexistence of call and call suspension.

◇ As for activation of the conference function, you need to apply to corresponding network operator.



Message service is a network dependent function, which allows you to send, receive and edit all kinds of messages. Please contact the network operator for more details.


### New Message

**Note:** to send SMS, you need to set the correct SMS service center number which can be obtained from network provider.



In standby mode, press the  [Menu] key to access the main menu. Select [SMS/New Message] to access the editing interface.

Press the  [Options] key to select options when editing:

- **Send:** directly send the created message.
- **Insert:** insert the below text to message.
- **Template:** select the templates pre-stored or customized in the phone. Press the Up/Down navigator key to select the templates and confirm to insert.
- **Contact:** Select the phone number from the

phone book that you want to insert, then press the  key to confirm, the selected contact name and number will be inserted in SMS.

- **Save to Draft:** save the created message in the draft box.
- **Save to Template:** save the created message as customized template.
- **Exit:** exit the edit interface.

Select [Send] option and confirm, enter the recipient editing interface. You can directly input phone number or press the  key to search in phonebook when the recipient list is empty. You can also press the  [Options] key to send the message by following mode:

- **Contact:** search the contacts in phonebook and then confirm, the selected contact will display in recipients screen.
- **Custom:** select one number or several contacts from the phone book as recipients. Enter selecting interface of the number list, press the Up/Down navigator key to move to



- If [Settings/Store Sent SMS] is [On] or [Query], but select [Yes] when sending, the sent successfully SMS will be saved to Sent; otherwise the SMS will not be saved. Sent unsuccessfully SMS will be saved to draft, you can edit and send again.





When you have received a message, after tones or vibration (as defined in the menu [Ringtone Settings/Incoming Message Alert]) can alert you with the indication of "New message, read?", and message mark will also be shown on the screen. Press the  [View] key to read the new message.

Press the  [Cancel] key to return, and you can access the inbox to read the new message.

**Note:** If the message sender is in encrypted list, and encrypted message function is activated, you must enter [Encrypted Message] to read the SMS.

If the message memory is full, the indication "Memory full" and the blinking message icon (message memory full) will be shown on the screen. Before you can receive new messages, delete some of your old messages in the inbox folder. If the capacity of new messages is beyond the capacity of the inbox,

the information will be lost and incomplete.

Press the [Options] key in message list to make the following menu:

- **Read:** read the current selected message.
- **Reply SMS:** directly reply SMS to the message sender. You can send a SMS as empty screen or with original message attached. The edit procedure as same as in [New Message].

- **Search:** search required SMS by name, by number, by content or by date.

- **Delete:** delete the messages.

- **Current:** delete current selected message.

**Read:** delete all the read messages.

**Custom:** list all messages in the inbox for you to choose. Press the Up/Down navigator key to select one message and press the [Enter] key to select or cancel this message ("v" displays in the box before selected message). You can also press the [Options] key to select [Select/Cancel, Select All, Reverse] or [Cancel All], if you select [Done], the selected message will be delete.

**All:** delete all messages in inbox.

In message list interface, press the [Enter] key to directly read the selected message, and then press the [Options] key to do following operations after reading the SMS:

- **Reply SMS:** directly reply SMS to the message sender.

- **Return Call:** directly dial the number of SMS sender.

- **Forward:** forward the message to someone else. The phone will display this information when "forward" function is selected.

Subscribers can revise or add something and then send to someone else. The operation is the same as editing short messages.

- **Delete:** delete the current SMS.

- **Extract Number:** save sender's number or the number in the message. You can choose to save the number in the phone or the SIM card.

- **Filter Contact:** Add this message sender's phone number to Contacts Filtered for reject this number's calls or messages.

Press the [Enter] key to select or cancel, then press the [Options] key and select

SMS 21 

[Done] to confirm.

- **View Next:** view the next SMS.

#### Encrypted Messages

When encrypted message function is activated, the message whose sender is in encrypted list will be saved in this option, and you must read the message in this option.

To enter this option, you must enter the correct code. The default code is 1234. If you input wrong code, phone will display the alert "Empty" and return to encrypted message menu, but no any messages display and encrypted list is also empty; if you input correct code, you will view the encrypted messages list if this function is activated.

Press the [Enter] key to read selected message; press the [Options] key to make [Read, Reply SMS, Search, Delete] operations, which refer to [Inbox]. Besides you can also make the following operations:

- **Change Encrypted Code:** used to update code for encrypted messages. You have to correctly enter the old password before

entering the new one. For protection of your safety, the new password must be entered and confirmed for 2 times.

- **Encrypted List:** the list saves encrypted messages' phone number, and messages from the numbers are directly saved as encrypted ones to prevent others from viewing. You can select options to add, edit and delete encrypted numbers.

- **Open Encrypted Message:** encrypted message are valid only when the function is opened; otherwise all messages are treated as common ones.

- **Close Encrypted Message:** close encrypted message function and all messages are treated as common ones.

If encrypted message is deactivated, you only can make [Change Encrypted Code, Encrypted List, Open Encrypted Message] operations.

#### Sent

Save the message that has been selected to save and successfully sent.

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In sent message list, press the [Options] key to make operations of [Read, Forward, Search, Delete].

Press the [Enter] key to read the selected message and then press the [Options] key to do the following operations:

- **Forward:** forward the message to the others.
- **Delete:** delete this message.

#### Drafts

Saves the messages that have been edited or unsuccessfully sent.

Press the [Options] key in Draft message list to spring the menu. See inbox for specific operations.

Press the [Enter] key to read the selected message and then press the [Options] key to do the following operations:

- **Send:** send the message again. The recipient can be edited.

- **Edit:** edit this message, and the operation is the same as forwarding message of the inbox.

- **Delete:** delete this message.

#### Template

Display 15 templates, among which 1 to 10 cannot be edited, while 11 to 15 can be edited by users themselves. Scroll by the up/down navigator key. Press the [Options] key to access the following menu: [Read, Send, and Edit] (Only be available for No.11-15 templates).

#### Settings

##### - Store Sent SMS

You can set whether store sent SMS.

- **On:** the sent SMS will be saved always.

- **Query:** you must choose whether save the SMS when sending, if you select "Yes", the SMS will be saved, otherwise the SMS will not be saved.

- **Off:** the sent SMS will not be saved always.

##### - Acknowledgement

Switch On or Off. When it is on, system will send confirmation message after address has received SMS.

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#### - Validity

Set storage and sending time of the short message in service center. You can choose 1 hour, 12 hours, 24 hours, 1 week, 1month, 3 months or maximum which is determined by MMS centre.

#### - Message Center Number

Set the service center number of the short message. This number can be obtained from the network operator. Please contact the network operator for more details.

#### - Default Save

You can set the default SMS storage location as SIM card or phone. If you select SIM card, new incoming message will be saved to SIM card automatically. SMS will be saved to phone until the SIM card memory is full.

#### Cell Broadcast

Cell broadcast message is public information offered by the network operator, which needs to be supported by the network operator company. For more details, please contact the network operator company. You can get

all kinds of information from the network operator company, such as weather forecast, traffic news or local taxi information. For more information, please consult the local network provider.

You can receive cell broadcast information only in standby interface.

Enter the sub-menu of cell broadcast, and you can see three menu options:

#### - Info Desk

Switch on or off the function.

#### - Channels

You can add new cell broadcast channel and set up the name and number of the channels; or switch on or off the cell broadcast to be chosen from so as not to receive unnecessary cell broadcast; select to reset the present channel; select to delete chosen channels.

#### - Language

You can select the language of the cell broadcast, with 10 at most and one at least. Or you can select all languages.

### Voice Mail

When you cannot answer calls, the incoming call will be diverted to the service number of voice mailbox, which allows you to listen to the caller's message saved in the voice mailbox system of service network. You will receive a voice mail. And you can visit the voice mailbox to access the message.

The voice mailbox is available only if it is supported by the network operator. You may need to apply for opening this service.

For more details, please contact the network operator.

### Memory Status


View the memory status of the short message in the SIM card and phone.

The SIM capacity depends on different SIM card.

### Phone Book

You can save names and phone numbers in the phone's memory and in the SIM card's memory. The phone's memory can save up to 250 numbers. The capacity depends on different SIM card.

Press the Down navigator key to access the phone book in standby mode. Or press  to access the [Phone Book] menu. Enter the phone book menu to access all lists of phone book, including all records saved in the phone and the SIM card.






In phone book list interface, you can press the corresponding numeric keys to search, including the name record starting with letters or letter and numerals. For example, if you want to search for the name starts with "L", press the [5] key third to input the character

"L", the phone will automatically find the names starting with "L".

After searching for the name, press the  key to dial the number and press the  key to end dialing. Press the  key to access the name and number details; Press the  [Options] key to access the menu options, including Send Message, Call, Edit, Send Card, Delete, Copy, Change Group, Filter Contact. (The operation of this menu is similar to that of option menu of phone book list.)

In phone book list interface, press the  [Options] key to access the options and do the following operations:

#### - View

Display details of currently recorded.

#### - Send Message

Send short messages to this number.





### - Add New

This menu allow you to add the new record to the SIM card or the Phone.

Enter the phone number directly in standby mode, then press the  or  [Save] key to save the phone number in the SIM card or the Phone.

Enter [Add New] menu, first you need to select storage: To SIM card or To Phone.


• **To SIM** : Select this option, press the  key or press the  [Options] key then select [Edit] to enter Name input interface, then input the corresponding name, press the  [OK] key to confirm.





### - Search

Entering name interface, you have two ways to search for required contactor record:

1. You can search by entering full name or one character or even one letter, press the  [OK] key and a list of all contactors who accord with searching requirements displays.

2. If you are not sure about the name that you want to search, directly press the  [OK] key to enter phonebook list. Press Up/Down navigator key to view contactor records.

After searching required contactor, press the  key to dial the phone number, and press the  [Options] key to enter menu which has similar operations with the option menu of phonebook list.

#### - Edit

Modify the currently selected contactor record.






#### - Change Groups

Please comply with warning signs at petrol station asking you to switch your phone off. You will need to comply with radio equipment

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usage restrictions in places such as chemical plants, fuel depots and at any location where blasting operations are under way.


 **Electronic equipment**  
To avoid the risk of demagnetisation, do not let electronic devices close to your phone for a long time.

 **Electronic medical equipment**  
Your phone is a radio transmitter which may interfere with electronic medical equipment or implants, such as hearing aids, pacemakers, insulin pumps, etc. It is recommended that a minimum separation of 15 cm be maintained between the phone and an implant. Your doctor or the manufacturers of such equipment will be able to give you any advice you may need in this area.

 **Hospitals**  
Always make sure that your phone is switched off in hospitals when so instructed by warning signs or by medical staff.

 **Road safety**  
Do not use your phone when driving. In order

to give your full attention to driving, stop and park safely before making a call. You must comply with any current legislation.

 **Distance of operation**  
This phone model has been tested and meets radiofrequency exposure guidelines when used as follows:


- Against the ear: place or receive a phone call and hold the phone as you would a wireline telephone.
- Body worn: when transmitting, place the phone in a carry accessory that contains no metal and positions the phone a minimum of 2.5 cm from your body. Use of other accessories may not ensure compliance with radiofrequency exposure guidelines. If you do not use a body worn accessory and are not holding the phone at the ear, position the phone a minimum of 2.5 cm from your body.
- Data operation: when using a data feature, position the phone a minimum of 2.5 cm from your body for the whole duration of the data transmission.


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### Caring for Battery

- ⚠ This phone uses a rechargeable battery as power source, when the charge is weak, recharge immediately to protect the battery life. It is best to drain the battery charge first.
  - ⚠ When not using the charger, unplug it from the power source and the phone. Over charging will shorten the battery life. not leave the charger connected to the unit or battery for more than a week.
  - ⚠ Temperature affects battery charge capacity. Your battery may need to be warm up or cool down before charging. If the battery temperature is lower than 0°C and higher than +45°C, it will not recharge.
  - ⚠ Use the battery as it is originally intended. Do not short circuit the battery by connecting the positive and negative terminals with a conductor.
  - ⚠ Do not use a damaged battery.
  - ⚠ The battery will not perform properly and its life will be shortened if exposed to extreme temperatures.
