-View last calls

Displays list of dialed, received, missed calls. Press the key (Options) to Create Contact (save to memory); Add to Contact (save to current memory); Delete; Delete All; or Send Message.

-Counters

Shows and sets counters for calls and GPRS.

· Cost

Counter: Show the count of the last call/

Delete costs: Needing PIN2 code support. Clear data costs.

Duration

Last and total: Show the duration of the last call / Total.

Delete durations: Delete the duration of the last call / Total.

Display of duration: Activate/Deactivate the call time display.

GPRS counters

Security

-Key pad locking
