

Turning the speaker on

Slide the Power Switch [7] to the ON position

Charging the speaker

Connect the speaker to your computer or other 1Amp USB charger using the supplied USB cable. The indicator Light [1] will flash red whilst charging and turn off when fully charged. Charging time is approximately 6 to 8 hours.

CONNECT

Wireless

- When turned on, the Speaker will automatically start in wireless Bluetooth mode and will either:
- a) Connect to an already paired device
- b) Search for a compatible device by saying "Waiting for connection" and the indicator light will flash rapidly green and blue.
- Access the Bluetooth menu on your audio device and search for the speaker.
 Once selected and connected, the indicator will turn blue and flash slowly.
- 3. Some devices may request a password, enter "0000" and confirm the connection.

Wired

Connect the speaker to any Audio device headphone port using the supplied 3.5mm audio cable.

Note: Bluetooth function is disabled when using the 3.5mm cable and wireless devices will not be connected.

AUDIO & PHONE CONTROLS

Wireless Audio

When connected wirelessly the audio device will automatically begin playing. If the audio is not audible then check or re-establish the Bluetooth connection.

Wired

When connected by the 3.5mm audio cable, the indicator light will alternately flash green and blue. Playback controlled by the audio player.

Music Control [see Operating Instructions]
Hold the + and - keys to adjust volume and
double-touch to skip tracks forward or backward.
Press the Call key once to Play or Pause playback.
In wired mode this will only silence the audio.

Phone Control

Incoming calls will be transferred to the Speaker when connected in Bluetooth mode. The indicator light will flash blue and a voice prompt will announce the call.

Press the Call button to answer or hold down to reject.

Music play is automatically paused during a call.

SUPPORT

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: I can't hear my music.
- A: 1. Check the speaker volume
- 2. Check the speaker is paired correctly or connected by the audio cable to a device playing music.
- Q: I can't answer or end a call.
- A: Some mobile devices do not support hands free calling.

 Check your mobile device manual.
- Q: I can't connect two devices at once.
- A: This speaker does not support multiple connections.
- Q: I can't wirelessly connect to the speaker.
- A: 1. Check your device has Bluetooth enabled and that the device and speaker are paired.
- 2. Disconnect any previously connected device.
- Q: I hear a crackling noise.
- A: Objects can interfere with the wireless Bluetooth signal.

 Ensure that the speaker is within 10 metres of the connect device and no major objects (walls, etc.) are obstructing the signal.

Caring for your speaker

Always store the speaker with the power off and in a clean, dust free environment, and away from children.

Avoid storing at extreme temperatures that may affect battery life and speaker performance.
