







(Kid Account).




8 Setup the control settings on MEEP!




3 How to charge MEEP!

Plug the adaptor to the MEEP!



2 Ask a grown-up to plug the other end of the adaptor to a wall outlet.

3 The red light on the top of the MEEP! indicates that the MEEP! is charging. It will be turned off after it is fully charged.



4 If you charge the MEEP! when it is ON, you should see a battery icon on the screen.




If you charge the MEEP! when it is OFF, a charging icon will promptly be shown on the screen.




### **How to connect monitors**

1 Ask a grown-up to plug the TV cable (not included) to the MEEP! before connecting it to a monitor / TV that supports HDMI functions.




## How to Use the Headphone





### How to Plug In the Memory Card

1) The memory card (not included) has already been plugged into the memory card slot under the cover of the MEEP!



2) The memory card is exchangeable with any other memory card up to 32 GB. Ask a grown-up to press the card to release it and replace it.



• CAUTIONS: Children 8 years old and below should not be permitted to access the battery charger. Before allowing a child to use the battery charger, always ensure that they receive thorough explanations on how to handle the device in the safest manner. Please explain that the battery charger is not a toy and must only be used for its intended


- Instruct the child not to recharge nonrechargeable batteries because of the danger of eruption;
