1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the **Bluetooth Keypad**. This User's Manual contains information that will help to operate the keypad as well as answer questions about certain special keys and buttons. Please keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.

2. System Requirements

- Microsoft Windows® XP / Vista/Windows 7/8

3. Device pairing

- Turn on the Bluetooth connection on the notebook computer
- Turn on the keypad power and press the "CONN." button. (Please make sure the blue LED is flashing)
- The notebook computer will search automatically. When "Bluetooth Keypad" shows, choose "Connect".
- Enter the pin code that display on the notebook computer and press "Enter".
- Start using the Bluetooth keypad.

Note:

1. After 30 minutes non-operation, the keypad will go to low-power mode. Please press any key to wake up.
2. Power ON/OFF also need to press any key to reconnect and wait the blue LED turn on before using.

4. Power Switch

There is a power switch at back of the keypad. When not in use, please turn to OFF to save battery power.
