USING THE PARROT PARTY FOR THE FIRST TIME

Note : The batteries are neither fully charged nor fitted when you unpack the Parrot PARTY. You have to insert and charge them before using the Parrot PARTY for the first time.

- 1. Remove the cover from the battery compartment underneath the device.
- 2. Insert and connect the batteries into the compartment as shown in the diagram below.



- 3. Replace the cover.
- 4. Connect the power lead supplied to the Parrot PARTY, making sure that it is fully inserted, and then plug the lead into the mains supply.
- 5. Turn on the Parrot PARTY using the ON/OFF switch on the back of the device.
 - > The centre LED on the Parrot PARTY flashes red/blue and then turns violet: this colour means that the device is charging. The LED turns blue when the batteries are fully recharged.
