

USER GUIDE FOR REMOTE CONTROL TYPE 204 AND 225

This is a multi function remote controlled transmitter intended for the remote operation of a vehicle security system. The function of each button is described fully in the operating manual of the security system in question and the user should consult this manual for the detailed functions controlled by the transmitter.

The transmitter operates using two lithium batteries type CR1220. The life of these batteries is 2 – 3 years with typical usage. When the batteries are nearing the end of their life the LED light on the remote will begin to flash when pushed and the user will begin to notice the range deteriorating. When this occurs the battery should be replaced within a few weeks to avoid any inconvenience.
