



Tap Turn Wi-Fi On or Off, wait a moment as Cruz Tablet detects networks in range, then select a network. If necessary, enter a password and tap Join. (Networks that require a password appear with a lock icon.)

Tap the screen, tap Settings icon shown in the menu. Cruz Tablet uses local Wi-Fi

Once you join a Wi-Fi network, Cruz Tablet automatically joins it whenever the network is in range. If more than one previous network is in range, Cruz Tablet joins the one most recently used. When Cruz Tablet joins a Wi-Fi network, the Wi-Fi icon in the screen shows at the top of the screen.

Create a new network

Choose Wi-Fi, then tap Turn Networks On or Off. Cruz Tablet displays a list of all the available Wi-Fi networks that you can choose from.

Turn Wi-Fi off to save power

If you know you're not going to be using Wi-Fi, you can turn it off to save battery. Go to Settings, tap Turn Wi-Fi On or Off.

Email



Double-click the Email icon shown in the menu. Type in your email address and password and follow the email setup intructions.

Sending Email



- 3 Tap Cc/Bcc/From if you want to copy the message to others, or change the account you send the message from. If you have more than one email account, you can tap the From field to change the account you're sending to.
- 4 Enter a subject, then your message.
- 5 Tap Send.

Adding photos	Choose a photo from the Gallery then tap Email Photo. You can also copy and paste photos. The photo is sent using you default email account.
Save a draft of a message	Tap Save. The message is saved in the drafts mailbox.
Reply to a message	Open a message and tap reply to the sender , type your message, then tap Send. Files or images attached to the initial message aren't sent back.
Forward a message	Open a message and tap Forward. Add one or more email addresses, type your message, and then tap Send. When you forward a message, you can include the files or images attached to the original message.
Unread messages	Tap a mailbox to see its messages. Unread messages are shown in red. When you open a mailbox, Mail loads the number of most recent messages specified in your Mail settings, if the messages haven't already been loaded automatically.
Read a message	Tap a mailbox, then tap a message. Within a message, tap or to see the next or previous message. Double-tap the area to zoom in or zoom out.
Follow a link	Tap the link in blue, it can take you to a webpage, open a map, or photos. To return to Mail, press the Home button and tap Mail.
Save an attached photo to Gallery	Tap the photo, then tap Save Image.

Carrying and Handling Cruz Tablet

Cruz Tablet contains sensitive components. Do not drop, disassemble, open, crush, bend, puncture, shred, paint, or insert foreign objects into Cruz Tablet.

Glass Parts Handling

The outside cover of the Cruz Tablet screen is made of glass. This glass could break if Cruz Tablet is dropped on a hard surface or receives a substantial impact. If the glass chips or cracks, do not touch or attempt to remove the broken glass, contact Velocity Micro customer care. If the Cruz Tablet cracks due to misuse or abuse - it is not covered under the warranty.

Avoiding Water and Wetness

Do not use in rain, or near an open water source. If the Cruz Tablet gets wet, unplug all cables, and turn off before cleaning, and allow to dry before turning on again. Do not attempt to dry with external heat, such as microwave, oven, or hair dryer.

Repairing or Modifying Cruz Tablet

Never attempt to repair or modify Cruz Tablet yourself. Disassembling Cruz Tablet may cause damage that is not covered under the warranty.

Choking Hazards

Keeping Cruz Tablet Within Acceptable Temperatures

Operate Cruz Tablet in a place where the temperature is between 0° and 35°C (32° to 95°F). Low or high temperature conditions might temporarily shorten battery life or cause Cruz Tablet to temporarily stop working properly.
