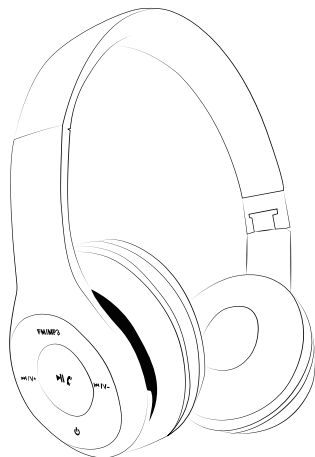


M529-BT Bluetooth headset

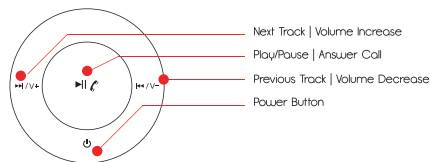
Instruction manual



WARNING:

- Do not expose the Universal Worldwide Travel Adapter to moisture
- Keep device away from children
- This unit does NOT convert voltage. Make sure that the power outlet intended for use has the proper voltage to run devices before using the adapter to avoid possible damage to the mobile device.
- Do not connect more than one plug at a time when using the Universal Worldwide Travel Adapter.

Player Functions [for bluetooth and line-in modes]:
Please read instructions before first use for best results.



Power Button

- To turn on/off the Cadence press and hold down the power button.

Next Track | Volume Increase

- Single press for the next track, press and hold to increase the volume.

Previous Track | Volume Decrease

- Single press for the previous track, press and hold to decrease the volume.

Play | Pause | Answer

- When receiving an incoming call, the Cadence will announce the number.
- Single press to answer an incoming call. Press again to end the call. Press and hold to reject the call. To redial the last number called press and hold the button.

LED Indicator

- When the Cadence is in pairing mode the LED indicator will flash blue.
- Once the Cadence is successfully paired, the LED indicator light will continuously flash.
- When the Cadence is charging, the LED indicator will remain red until fully charged, when complete the indicator will turn off.

Pairing a Bluetooth Device

- Turn on the Cadence and begin the pairing process by pressing and holding the power button for a few seconds.
- An LED indicator will flash blue.
- On you bluetooth enabled device, select the Cadence in the bluetooth settings.
- Once the Cadence has paired successfully, the LED indicator light will continuously flash blue.
- After initial pairing, the Cadence will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to reset of the device.
- If the Cadence becomes unpaired or you find it unable to connect, repeat the above steps.

Line-In

- Connect the provided 35mm audio cable to the Line-input port and the audio output on an audio device.
- Use the music controls on the Cadence Bluetooth Headphones to play selected audio, or receive and make calls.
