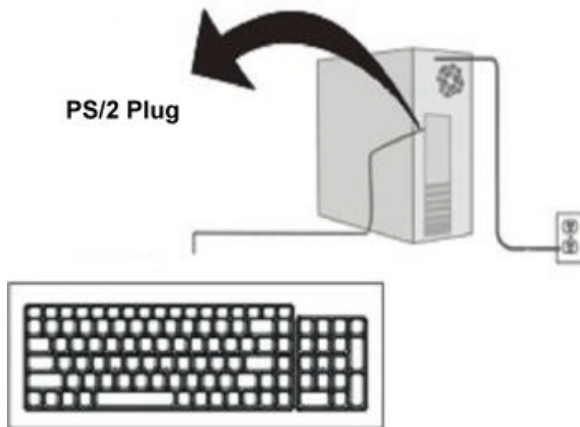


PK-807 User Manual
