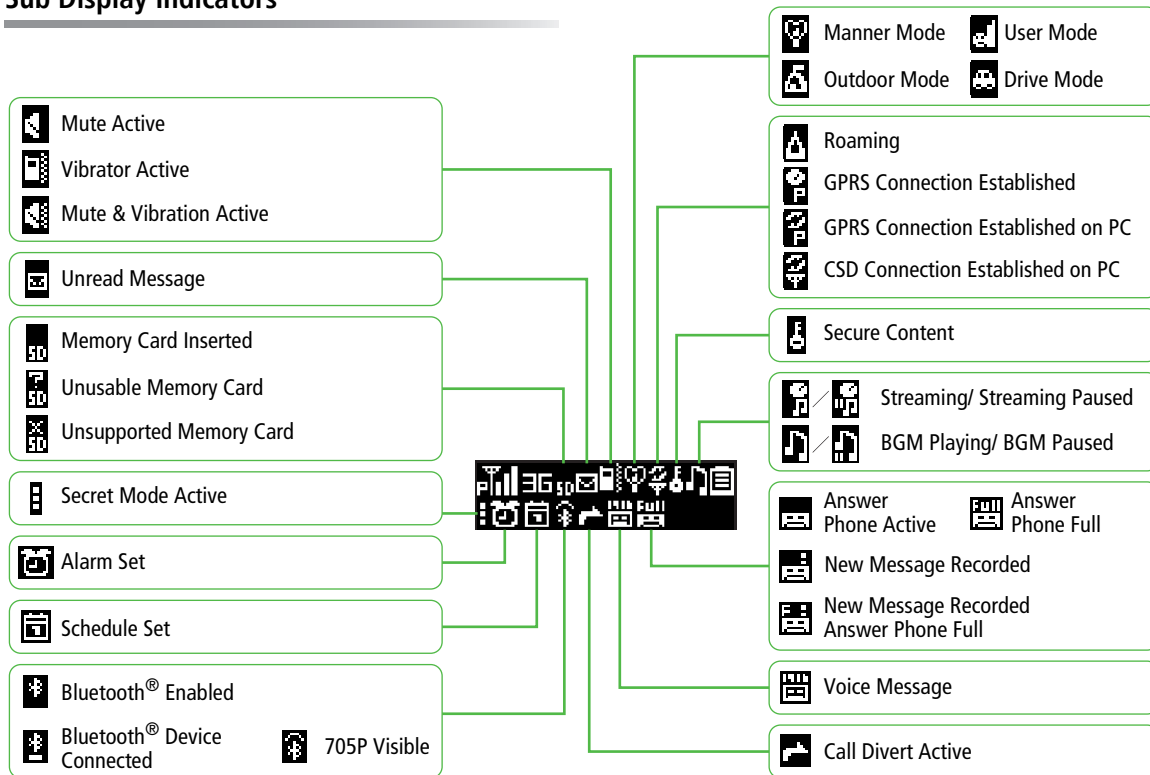


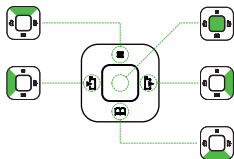

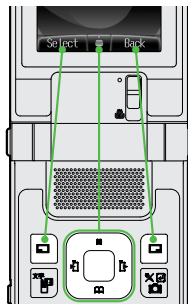
Manual Symbols

Multi Selector & Softkeys

Use Multi Selector to select items, navigate menus, etc.



Softkeys correspond to functions/commands appearing at the bottom of Display.




Menu Navigation

In this manual, handset operations before steps are described as shown below.

Main menu ► 設定 ► 一般設定 ► Language

Enter Main menu, then move through sub menus. " ► " means "scroll through the menu and select the menu item, then press ".

Security Codes

USIM PINs

PIN1&PIN2

PIN1	Prevent unauthorised use of handset.
PIN2	Required to clear Total Call Cost and to set Cost Limit.

- PIN1 & PIN2 are 9999 by default.
- PIN1 & PIN2 can be changed.
- When PIN Entry is **Enable**, PIN1 (4-8 digits) is required every time handset is turned on (with USIM Card inserted).

PIN Lock & Cancellation (PUK)

PIN1 Lock or PIN 2 Lock is activated if PIN1 or PIN2 is incorrectly entered 3 times. Cancel PIN Lock by entering the Personal Unblocking Key (PUK).

- For information on PUK, contact SoftBank Customer Centre, General Information (☎ P.18-50).



- If PUK is incorrectly entered 10 times, USIM Card is locked and handset is disabled. Write down PUK.
- For procedures required to unlock USIM Card, contact SoftBank Customer Centre, General Information (☎ P.18-50).
- When PIN Entry is **enabled**, emergency calls are not available.

Codes

Handset Code

9999 or the 4-digit number selected at initial subscription. Handset Code is required to use/change some handset functions.

- * appears when Handset Code is entered.

Centre Access Code

The 4-digit number in the contract; required to access optional service via landlines or subscribe to fee-based information.

Network Password

The 4-digit number selected at initial subscription, required to restrict handset services. If Network Password is incorrectly entered 3 times, Call Barring settings are locked. To resolve, Network Password and Centre Access Code must be changed. For details, contact SoftBank Customer Centre, General Information (☎ P.18-50).





Note

- Write down Handset Code, Centre Access Code and Network Password. If lost, contact SoftBank Customer Centre, General Information (☎ P.18-50).
- Do not reveal Handset Code, Centre Access Code and Network Password. SoftBank is not liable for misuse or damages.



- Answer Phone is not available for incoming Video Calls.

Memory Card

Save captured images, recorded clips or downloaded files.

- A low battery may cause file read/write errors.
- While in use, do not remove Memory Card or battery.
- Memory Card files may be damaged or lost due to misuse, accidents or malfunctions. Always back up important files.

Formatting Memory Card

- Memory Cards formatted on other devices may not work properly with 705P. Format Memory Card on 705P.
- Formatting Memory Card deletes all saved files/data.

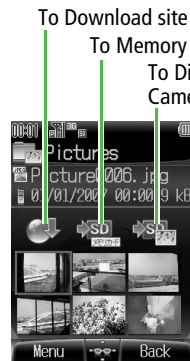

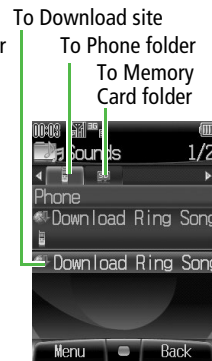
Opening Data Folder

Main menu ► Data Folder

Connectivity

Transfer Phone Book entries, Schedules, or image/sound files, etc. to compatible devices wirelessly via infrared or Bluetooth®, or connect 705P to PCs via USB Cable.



- Some downloaded files may be protected under copyright laws. These files should not be sent.




Infrared

- Place handset and other device within the effective range of 20 cm, and align the infrared ports.









- Though invisible, do not point infrared beam at eyes.

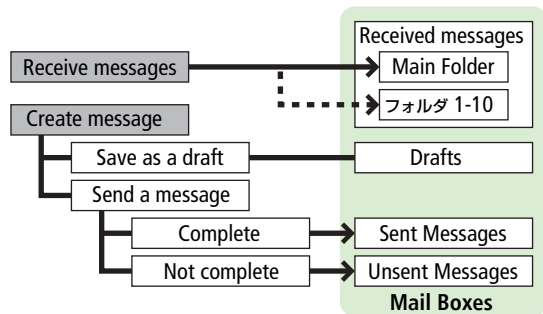
Call Divert	Divert calls to a preset phone number.
Voice Mail	Callers may leave voice messages at Voice Mail Centre when 705P is off, out-of-range or engaged. Unavailable when Call Waiting is active.
Call Waiting*	Place a call on hold to receive another incoming call.
Multiparty Call*	Call another party during a call or talk to multiple parties simultaneously.
Call Barring*	Stop all outgoing/incoming calls including international calls.
Caller ID*	Show or hide your phone number when you make a call or confirm the phone number of a caller.

Messaging

SoftBank messaging services are available in Japan and overseas.

Mail	Exchange longer text messages of up to 5000 characters with SoftBank or e-mail compatible handsets, PCs, etc; attach image/sound files.
SMS	Exchange short text messages of up to 70 alphanumeric characters with SoftBank handsets.






- Separate subscription required to use Mail and to receive e-mail.
- The Centre resends undeliverable messages at regular intervals until delivered. Messages not delivered by specified expiry are deleted.

Software Update

Check for 705P software updates and download as required.

- Connection fees do not apply to updates (including checking for updates, downloading and rewriting).
- Fully charge battery before starting the update.
- Select a place where signal is strong and stable.
- Do not remove battery during the update.
- Other functions are not available during Software Update.
- 705P is disabled until the update is complete. The update may take some time.

When the update is complete, 705P will turn off, then restart automatically. Information window appears.

To check update result

Scheduled Update


Follow onscreen instructions for setup.

Confirmation appears at scheduled update time.

Press  or wait 10 seconds for update to start.

- Software Update will not start while 705P is in use. Continuing handset usage for 10 minutes or more after confirmation appears cancels Scheduled Update.



- Software Update failure may disable 705P. Contact SoftBank Customer Centre, Customer Assistance ( P.18-50).
- Software Update does not affect 705P Phone Book entries, files saved in Data Folder or other content, but it is recommended that you create a backup, as appropriate, of any important information and data (note that some files cannot be copied).
- SoftBank is not liable for damages resulting from loss of data, information, etc.
- Update automatically cancels Keypad Lock.
