An application for a printed Veteran ID Card that helps Veterans receive discounts at retailers.

Who can access it?

Technically, anyone who visits Vets.gov can access this tool. But it's meant to be used only by Veterans. Ideally a Veteran logs in and finishes the identify verification before using the tool, but they can also use the tool without logging in. Both scenarios are described in detail in the sections below.

How do users navigate to it on Vets.gov?

Page 5 - Photo Upload & Cropping

What makes a good photo?

To meet the requirements for a Veteran ID Card, your photo should follow the guidance listed below. It must:

- Show a full front view of your face and neck, (with no hat, head covering, or headphones covering or casting shadows on your hairline or face), and
- Be cropped from your shoulders up (much like a passport photo), and
- Show you with your eyes open and a neutral expression, and
- Be a square size and have a white or plain-color background (with no scenery or other people in the photo)
- Be uploaded as a .jpeg, .png, .bmp, or .tiff file

Other warnings with Photo Cropper

1. User reached the edge of the photo

You have reached the edge of your photo and can't move it any farther down. To continue to edit your photo, click on the other arrows to move it or to make it larger.

2. User zoomed in too much

If you zoom in this close, your ID photo will be less clear.

Users can go back and change their photo or edit the photo they've already uploaded by clicking on those two links underneath the cropped photo.

Page 6 - Discharge Document Upload

*Necessary if the user:

- Can't be found in MVI
- Is in MVI, but VA can't find their discharge status
- Is not logged with identity verification in Vets.gov

What happens after I apply?

We'll review your application to verify your eligibility. If you're eligible for a Veteran ID Card, you should receive your card by mail in about 60 days.

We'll send you emails updating you on the status of your application. You can also print this page for your records.

To be eligible for a Veteran ID Card, you must have separated under honorable conditions. If you have an other than honorable discharge, you can apply for an upgrade or correction. Find out how to apply for a discharge upgrade.

You can use any of these forms of ID to get the same business and restaurant discounts while you wait for your card:

- A Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- A Department of Defense (DoD) Identification Card—either a Common Access Card (CAC) or a Uniformed Services ID Card
- A Veterans Proof of Service Letter or Card
