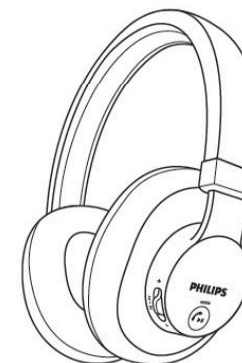

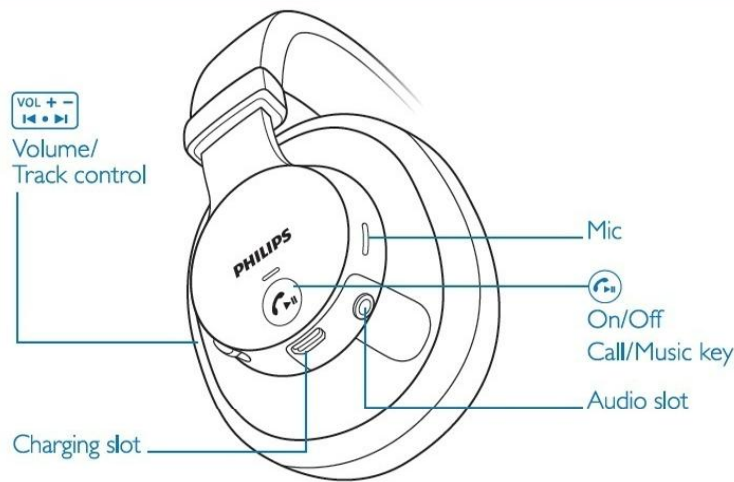

Turn headset on	Press for 1 sec

Play/Pause/Pick up call/Hang up	1 press
Reject incoming call	Long press for 1 sec until "BI" sound
Redial	2 press
Switch caller while in a call	Long press
In pairing mode	White and blue LED flashing alternatively
Paired and connected mode	Blue LED flashing at every 6 sec
Fully charged	White LED goes out once it is fully charged when cable is connected
Low battery	White LED flashing
