

When using an electric razor, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all instructions before using this appliance.

# DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- 1. Do not reach for a razor that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Do not use razor while bathing or in a shower.
- 3. Do not place or store razor where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- 4. Always unplug this razor from the electrical outlet immediately after using, except when razor is recharging.

  5. Remove power supply cord from razor before cleaning.

  6. When discarding razor, unplug razor and remove rechargeable

# WARNING

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to

- 1. Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or invalids.

  2. Use this razor for its intended household use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by Philips Electronics North America Corporation.

  3. Never operate this razor if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the razor to an Authorized Norelco Service Location for examination and repair.

- 4. Keep the razor and cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not plug in razor outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being
- administered.

  Do not use this razor with a damaged or broken comb, as facial
- injury may occur.

  Always attach plug to razor first, then to outlet. Be certain that plug is inserted firmly into razor, up to mark indicated on plug. To disconnect, turn razor off then remove plug from outlet.
- 9. To prevent possible damage to the cord, do not wrap cord around the razor.
- 10. Never put razor in direct sunlight or store in a pouch at a temperature above 140°F.



#### Indications



▶ LED Charging Indicator Light
The green Charging Indicator Light will light up to indicate razor is (re)charging.

### Charging

- Battery performance is best if you recharge only when the batteries are (almost) completely empty.
- Charging or recharging at temperatures below 40°F and higher than 95°F adversely affects lifetime of batteries.
- Continuously recharging or continuously using as a corded razor will reduce life of batteries.
- You may also shave using the cord provided. This razor will not recharge while being used corded.
- ▶ If razor has not been used for at least 1 month, razor must be recharged for a full 12 hours.
- Do not recharge razor in a pouch.



Connect cord to razor.
Plug into any 120V to 240V AC outlet. Use only the cord provided. The green Indicator Light lights up to indicate razor is (re)charqing.


An adaptor plug may be necessary for cord usage in some foreign countries. Use an attachment plug adaptor of the proper configuration for power outlet. Your new razor will automatically convert internally to work on 100V to 240V AC systems.

- 2 First time charging and recharging after non-use for 1 month or more requires a full 12 hours.
- ▶ Recharging (after initial 12 hour charge) requires approximately 8 hours.

### Put It To The Test & Shaving Tips

- 21 Day Trial and Conversion Process. It is a fact that your skin and beard need time to adjust to any new shaving system.
- Use your new razor exclusively for 3 weeks to fully enjoy the closeness of a Norelco shave.
- M At first you may not get as close a shave as you expect, or your face may even become slightly irritated. This is normal since your beard and skin will need time to adjust. Invest 3 weeks and you'll soon experience the full joy of your new razor.
- ▶ Stick with it! If you alternate shaving methods during the adjustment period, it may make it more difficult to adapt to the Norelco shaving custom
- If you are not convinced after 21 days, Norelco will refund you the full purchase price, guaranteed.

### How To Shave With An Electric Razor



▶ Shaving with a clean, dry face gives the best




- Turn razor to ON (1) position. Shave against the direction of beard growth using both straight and circular movements.
- Stretch your skin with your free hand so blades can lift and cut whiskers. Gently press razor to skin, so the floating heads can follow the contours of your face. DO NOT press too hard. Too much pressure can pinch the skin into the heads.
- 3 Turn razor to OFF (O) position.
- Put the protective razor head cap on the razor to protect razor heads.

Replace your Norelco Reflex Plus razor heads (model # HQ55 PLUS) once a year for optimal shaving results.









- 2 Push up trimmer slide switch. The trimmer can be activated while the razor is running.
- 3 Hold trimmer as shown and move in downward strokes with gentle pressure. Close trimmer by sliding trimmer switch
- 5 Turn razor to OFF (O) position.

# Cleaning

Once a week: Razor







Always turn razor off, unplug from outlet and remove cord from razor before cleaning.

▶ Regular cleaning guarantees better shaving results.

Press the Razor Head Release Button and remove Razor Head Assembly from the razor unit.





Brush out hairs from the inside of Razor Head Assembly and hair chamber.



4 Replace the Razor Head Assembly back on

Every Two Months: Razor Head



Do not mix up the cutters and combs as the shaving performance may be adversely affected for several weeks before optimal shaving performance is restored.



Turn razor to Off (O) position, remove plug 1 from outlet and disconnect cord razor.



2 Press the Razor Head Release Button and remove Razor Head Assembly from the razor unit.



3 Brush the inside of the razor housing.



Turn Razor Head Assembly over so that underside is exposed.



6 Remove the frame and brush clean.




7 Remove and clean one cutter and comb at

Do not clean more than one cutter and comb at a time, since they are all matching sets. If you accidentally interchange the cutters and combs, it could take several weeks before optimal shaving performance is restored.



8 Separate the cutter from the comb.





10 Brush the slots of the comb.

For optimum performance, razor cutters and combs should be cleaned in a degreasing liquid (e.g. Norelco Razor Head Cleaner, model RC1776 ce.g., Notecto Nazor Fread Cleanier, Inidea RC770 or alcohol) and lubricated with Norelco Razor Lubricant, model AL80, or one drop of mineral oil (in the center of the head). This helps prevent wear of the shaving heads.



11 Replace the cutter and comb into the Razor Head Assembly.



12 Repeat the process for the other two sets of cutters and combs.



14 Turn the wheel clockwise until it locks into place.



15 Replace the Razor Head Assembly back on

16 Put the protective razor head cap on the razor to protect heads.

After Each Use: Trimmer



1 Turn razor to OFF (O) position.

Push trimmer slide switch up to pop up trimmer.



3 Clean trimmer with the brush every time you use it.



Lubricate the trimmer teeth with Norelco Razor Lubricant (model AL80) or with one 4 drop of mineral oil every 6 months.

Close trimmer by sliding trimmer switch

This razor has no other user-serviceable parts. Any other service should be performed by an Authorized Norelco Service Location.

### **Battery Removal**

- ▶ This Norelco Razor contains Nickel-Cadmium batteries, which must be disposed of properly.
- ▶ Batteries should only be removed when Razor is to be discarded.
- ▶ Refer to Battery Removal instruction sheet for directions on removing the rechargeable

#### Storage

- ▶ Be sure Razor is turned off. Remove cord from outlet and Razor before storing in a safe, dry location where it will not be crushed, banged, or subject to damage.
- Do not wrap cord around Razor when storing.
- Store cord in a safe location where it will not be cut or damaged.
- Do not place or store Razor where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink, water or other liquid while plugged in.
- ▶ Put the Protective Razor Head Cap on razor to protect heads.
