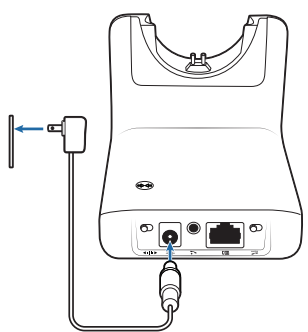

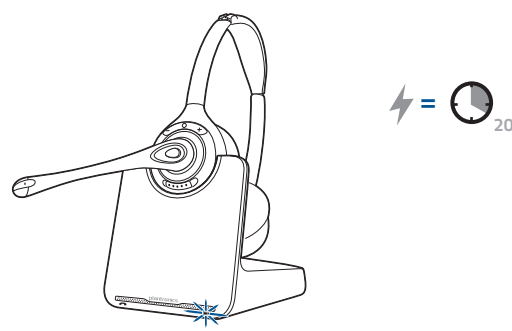

1 Plug one end of power supply into power jack on back of the base and other end into working power outlet.

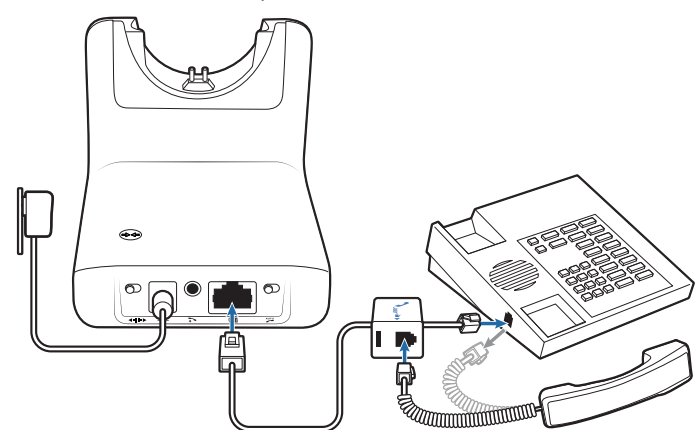


2 To charge, dock headset in base for minimum of 20 minutes.



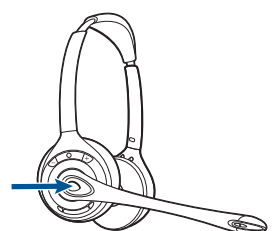
2 Connect Desk Phone

3 Dial test call from desk phone.

NOTE You may also call the automated sound test at 800-317-8308. It's the quickest way to test and optimize your system.

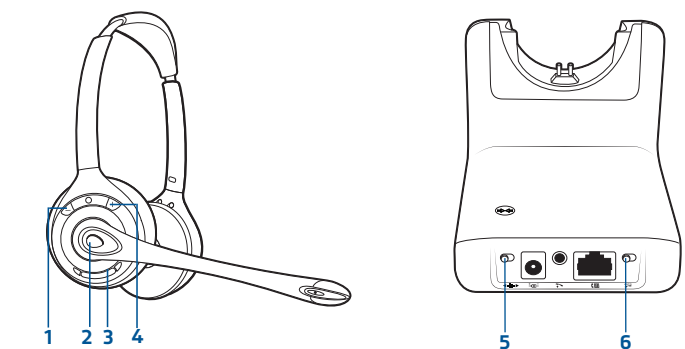
4 End call by pressing headset call control button and hang up the handset.

Troubleshooting Tip: If you do not hear a dial tone, adjust the slide switch (A–G) until you do. Default setting **A** works for majority of desk phones.

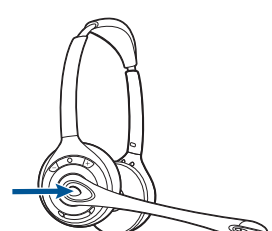

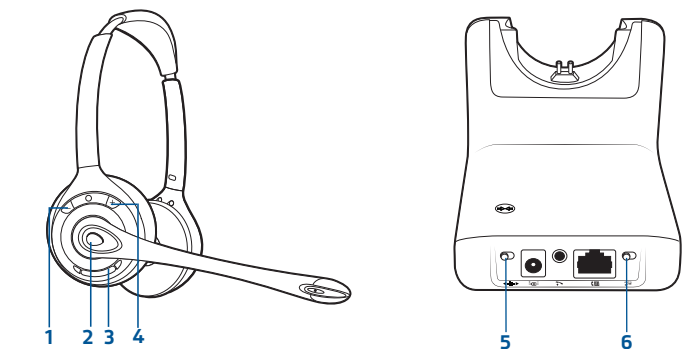
4 Para finalizar la llamada, presione el botón de control de llamadas de los auriculares y cuelgue el tubo.

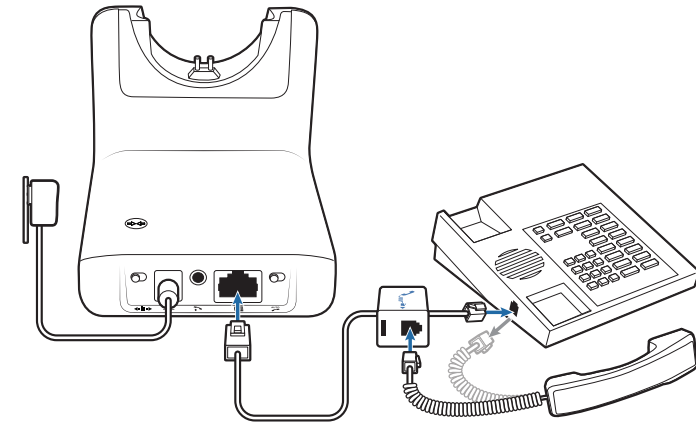

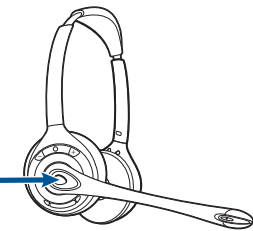
