USING AUX IN

- Plug one end of the included 3.5mm-to-3.5mm cable into your audio device, just like you would a pair of headphones.
- 2. Plug the other end of the cable into the unit's AUX IN port.
- 3. Use your audio device to control music playback.
- 4. Use your audio device and the speaker to control volume.

Note: If a device is currently paired with Bluetooth[®], the wired device takes precedence over a Bluetooth device connection.

USING Pair2 FOR STEREO OR LEFT/RIGHT SOUND

Two Big Blue Live 2 speakers can be paired for stereo or left/ right sound.

- 1. Pair your device (see page 10) with the first speaker.
- 2. Press and hold the POWER BUTTON on the second speaker until the POWER/PAIRING LED turns on and the power on tone sounds.
- Press the Pair2 BUTTON on the first speaker (the speaker that is paired with your device). The POWER/PAIRING LED will start flashing and audio will pause on the first speaker. The first speaker will wait for a Pair2 connection for up to 2 minutes.
- Press and hold the Pair2 BUTTON on the second speaker until the POWER/PAIRING LED starts flashing on the second speaker.
- 5. Release the Pair2 BUTTON on the second speaker.
- 6. After a few seconds, the POWER/PAIRING LEDS will be solid, the Pair2 stereo tone will sound on



USING THE SPEAKERPHONE

When the speaker is paired to your device and a call is received, the incoming call tone will sound.

If there is audio playing though the speaker when a call is answered, the audio will pause and only your call will be audible. When you end the call, your audio will resume.

- To answer an incoming call press the PLAY/PAUSE/ PHONE BUTTON.
- To reject an incoming call press and hold the PLAY/ PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON.
- To end an active call press the PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON.
- To switch an active call from the speaker to your device press and hold the PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON.
- To switch an active call from your device to the speaker press and hold the PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON.

LISTENING TO AUDIO

- Press and hold the POWER BUTTON until the POWER/ PAIRING LED turns on and the power on tone sounds.
- 2. The speaker should automatically remember the last paired device. Depending upon your device, you may have to select "Big Blue Live 2.0" in your device's menu.
- 3. Press the VOLUME + BUTTON to increase audio volume.
- 4. Press the VOLUME BUTTON to decrease audio volume.
- 5. Press the PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON to pause audio. Press the PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON to play audio.
- 6. To turn the speaker off, press the POWER BUTTON. The power off tone will sound.

Note: If no buttons are pressed, the POWER/PAIRING LED will auto off after 5 seconds. Pressing the VOLUME or PLAY/PAUSE/PHONE BUTTON buttons will activate the POWER/PAIRING LED for 5 seconds.

TRAVEL LOCK

- 1. Slide the TRAVEL LOCK SWITCH to buttons on the speaker.
- 2. Slide the TRAVEL LOCK SWITCH to **o** to unlock the buttons on the speaker.

Note: Sliding the TRAVEL LOCK SWITCH to **b** will power off the speaker.

CHARGING THE SPEAKER

- Insert the MICRO USB CABLE'S micro USB connector into the MICRO USB PORT on the speaker.
- 2. Insert the MICRO USB CABLE'S USB connector into the USB port on the AC/DC ADAPTER.
- 3. Plug the AC/DC ADAPTER into an electrical wall outlet.
- 4. The CHARGING LED INDICATOR is RED while the speaker is charging. When the speaker is fully charged, the CHARGING LED INDICATOR is GREEN. For first time use, charge the speaker for at least 4.5 hours.
- 5. When the speaker's battery is low, the CHARGING LED INDICATOR will flash RED.

PAIRING YOUR DEVICE

- Prepare your device to pair using Bluetooth[®], making sure the device is within 33 feet of the speaker. Refer to your device's owners manual for details if necessary.
- Press and hold the POWER BUTTON until the POWER/ PAIRING LED turns on and the power on tone sounds.
- Press and hold the POWER BUTTON until the POWER/ PAIRING LED starts flashing to put the speaker in pairing mode.
- Select "Big Blue Live 2.0" on your device. If prompted, use 0000 as a PIN for the pairing code. The speaker will wait for a connection in pairing mode for up to 2 minutes.
- When "Big Blue Live 2.0" is selected, the POWER/ PAIRING LED will be solid blue and the pairing successful tone will sound to confirm pairing is complete.
 Notes:
- To cancel the pairing mode you may either press the POWER BUTTON, a tone will sound and the speaker will turn off, or wait the 2 minutes for the speaker to cancel

pairing automatically. The POWER/PAIRING LED will return to solid blue and the unit will remain on.

 The POWER/PAIRING LED will auto off 5 seconds after pairing. Pressing the VOLUME or PLAY/PAUSE/ PHONE BUTTON buttons will activate the POWER/ PAIRING LED for 5 seconds.

PAIRING YOUR DEVICE WITH NFC

- 1. Enable your device for NFC pairing. Refer to your device's owners manual for details if necessary.
- 2. Touch your device to the speaker's NFC SENSOR. Confirm the connection on your device.
