

### **PLAYBACK**

- Press the Power/Mode Button to select Video or
- 2. Select the Shutter/OK Button to enter the Playback menu
- S. Use the Power/Mode Button to cycle through various options.
- 4. Press the Shutter/OK Button.

Power/Mode Button, press the "X" to exit.

### **SETTINGS**

Press the Shutter/OK Button to enter the settings menu, and then again to select a setting, Repeatedly press the Power/Mode or the Up/Down Button(s) to select the desired option. To go back to the previous screen or exit the settings menu, press the

### STORAGE/MICRO SD CARDS

This is compatible with 8GB, 16GB and 32GB capacity microSD, microSDHC, and microSDHX memory cards. You must use a microSD card with a Class 10 speed rating. We recommend using a brand name memory card for max reliability in high-vibration activities. To access your photos without the app remove the SD card from the camera and use an extracting cord, or insert it directly into a computer or compatible device.

### **CHARGE THE BATTERY**

- 1. Connect the camera to a computer or USB power
- 2. The Charging Status Light remains ON while the battery is charging. (charging time: 3-5 hours)
- 3. The Charging Status Light will turn OFF when the the battery is fully charged.

### **CAMERA APP**

Connecting to the Ez iCam App

This app lets you control your camera remotely using a smartphone or tablet. Features include full camera control, live preview, photo playback and sharing of select content and more.

- Download the **Ez iCam App** to your smartphone or tablet at the Google Play or Apple App Store.
- . Turn the Action Camera ON. Make sure the camera is in Camera Mode.
- Press the **Down Button** to turn on the Wi-Fi\* In your smartphone or tablet's Wi-Fi settings.
- 4. select "ActionCam W9 006390" from the list.
- Enter the password "1234567890".
- Once downloaded, open the Ez iCam App on your smartphone or tablet and let the fun begin.

\*Press and hold the **Down Button** for three seconds to turn OFF Wi-Fi.

Turn the Action Camera ON and repeatedly press the Power/Mode Button to cycle through the camera Playback, and Settings.











### RECORDING VIDEO

the Camera Light Indicator will flash while recording. Press the Shutter/OK Button to stop, a beep will sound and the lights will shut off. In the event your camera is low on battery, it will automatically save

### **PHOTO MODE**

Verify you're in Photo Mode (Note: the Photo icon will show on the screen). To take a photo, press the Shutter/Select Button, A camera shutter noise will

### **PHOTO BURST**

Verify you're in Photo Burst Mode (Note: the Photo Burst icon will show on the screen). In Photo Burst Mode, your camera takes 3 photos in 1.5 seconds.

### TIME LAPSE

Verify you're in Time Lapse Mode, and that Continuous Lapse is ON while in this mode (Note: the Time Lapse icon will show on the screen). You can select which interval suits the moment (2, 3, 5, 10, 20, 30, or 60 seconds). Press the Shutter/Select Button to start the time lapse.
