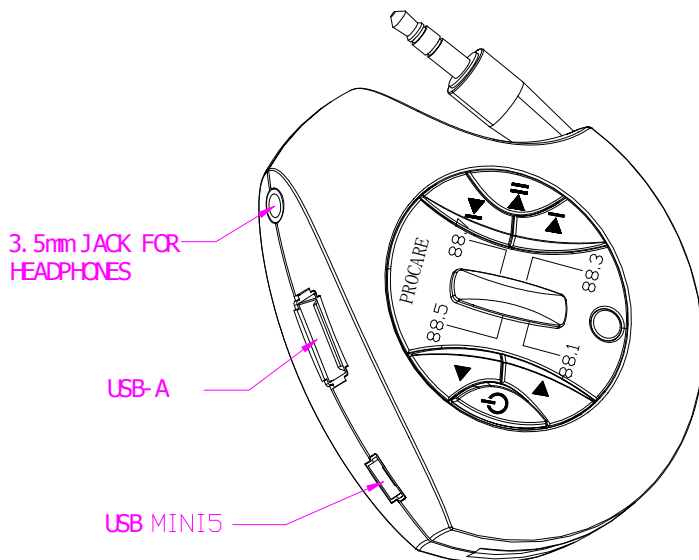
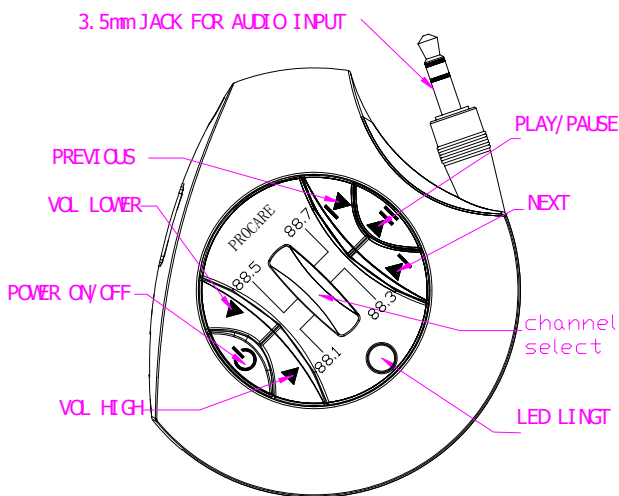

一 Accessory






- 1、 USB memory
- 2、 Car charge(DC 5V)
- 3、 USB cable —— connect computer (select)



二 Operation Instruction

- 1、 Connect product USB Mini5 connector to DC 5V converter;
- 2、 Connect product USB A terminal to USB memory
- 3、 Select frequency from 88.1 88.3 88.5 88.7 MHz
- 4、 Press power button. LED light flash for reading MP3 information on USB memory.
- 5、 Turn your car radio on and match the frequency of the product achieve desired music.

三 Button and connector

- 1、 USB Mini5 connector: Power input(connect DC 5V converter or computer USB A terminal through USB cable)
- 2、 USB A terminal: connect USB memory
- 3、 Headphone 3.5mm jack
- 4、 Connection wire: connect IPOD MP3 CD MD audio source
- 5、 LED light: flash for reading USB memory
- 6、 Frequency select:4 fixed frequency ranges 88.1 88.3 88.5 88.7 MHz
- 7、  Play/pause button: Press for play/pause function. Press and hold for about three seconds for far speed up function
- 8、  Next button: Press for skip one function
- 9、  Previous button: Press for previous one function
- 10、  Volume High button: Press for higher volume .Press and hold for three seconds volume progressive automatically.
- 11、  Volume Low: button: Press for lower volume. Press and hold for three seconds volume degressive automatically.
