



Features

- O Power on:Press and hold the "MFB" button for 1 second, and the blue indicator light flashes 3 times. Power off: press and hold the "MFB" button for 3 second the red indicator light flashes once.
- Answering a call:Short press MFB button.
- Ending a call: Short press the "MFB" button-
- Rejecting a call: Press the "V-" button for 1 second.
- Redialing the last called number: Double press the MFB button when headset is in standby mode
- Voice dialing:With the headset in standby mode long press the "MFB" for 1 second and release (Your phone must support this function)
- Play / Pause: Short press the "MFB" button to play and pause when headset is in standby mode.
- Previous/Next Track:Press the "V-" 1 for second to previous track, press the "V+" 1 for second to next track.
- ✓ Volume control: Short press the "V+" or "V-" to control the volume

- Voice Prompt
- O When the headset is on there will be the automatic voice prompt:power on
- O When the headset is off, there will be the automatic voice prompt:power off
- O When being connected successfully there will be voice telling:connected
- When the battery is low, there will be voice telling: battery low When a call comes in, the headset will speak up the caller's phone number
- Pair to your Bluetooth Phone
- Pair the bluetooth headset for the first time, the distance between the Bluetooth headset and your Bluetooth phone would be better within 1 meter when pairing-
- With the headset power off, hold and press the "MFB" button for 3 seconds red light and blue light flash alternately, then the headset enter the searching mode, it lasts about 2minutes.
- When phone finds headset confirm by selecting Model from list.Enter pin code "0000" if needed.(The password is required for some phones.
- Repeat above steps if the pairing was unsuccessful. The blue light will flash if paired successfully.
- Power Alarm: There will be low power alarm when the voltage is lower than 3.3V

The headset will be power off when the voltage is lower than 3V.



Features

Connect two Bluetooth mobile phones at the same time

- O After paired the first mobile phone please turn off the Bluetooth function of the first mobile phone, then pair to the second Bluetooth mobile phone.
- Open the first mobile phone Bluetooth function,manual connection the first moble phone.

Note: While two mobile phones are connecting one Bluetooth headset some functions of the Bluetooth headset will be restricted



Charging the headset

Your headset uses a rechargeable battery, you must charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time.

- Plugging the charging cable in the USB charge port.
- —O The red indicator lamp remains solid when charging.
- —o The fully charging takes 3 hours.
- —o The red indicator lamp goes out and the blue indicator Lighting when charging completed.
