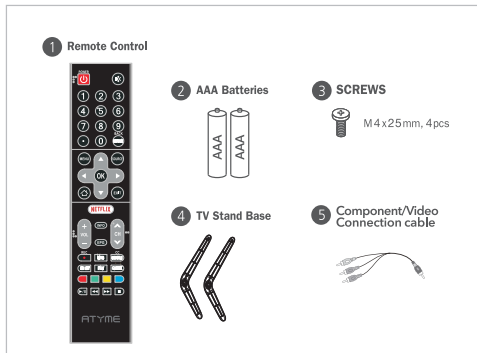

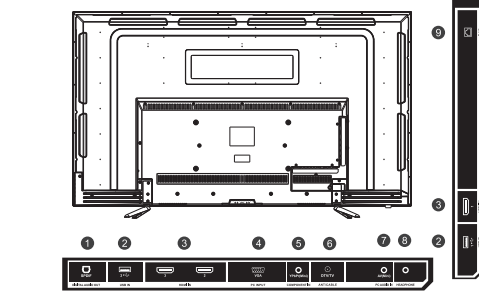


Setup TV Table Stand

- SPEAKER:** Digital TV sound output.
- USB:** Connect the USB device such as the flash disk to access the TV media function.
- HDMI:** (High-Definition Multimedia Interface) Provides an uncompressed digital connection.
- VGA:** Connect the PC to these jacks.
- MINI YPbPr:** Connect the YPbPr output jack of the DVD or VCR.
- DTV/TV:** Connect to receive the signal from your antenna or cable through a coaxial cable.
- MINI AV:** Connect an AV device that has composite video jacks, such as a VCR or DVD Player. Note: PC AUDIO IN and mini AV share one port, PC audio and YPbPr audio should connect from this port.
- HEADPHONE:** Connect a 3.5mm headset for personal audio.
- RJ45:** Connect the Internet. About Network connection, please refer in Quick Start Guide.

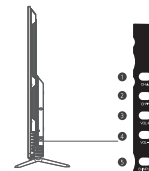

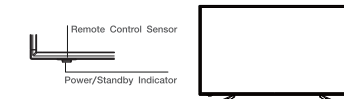
TV Buttons / Front Panel 5

Side Keypad Buttons
If you cannot locate your remote, you can use the side keypad buttons on your TV to operate many TV features.



- CH+:** Scans up through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the up arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.
- CH-:** Scans down through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the down arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.
- VOL+:** Increases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the right arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.
- VOL-:** Decreases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the left arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.
- INPUT:** When TV power off, long press this button to turn on. When TV is on, long press this button to turn off, short press this button to call up the input source menu, press the VOL+/- button to select the input source and press the power on/off button again to confirm the selection.

Front Panel
About remote control working distance and angle, please refer to Quick start guide.



Power/Standby Indicator : Blue and red dual-color LED.
It shows red when the TV is turned off and blue when turned on.
Remote Control Sensor : Remote control IR sensor, which receives infrared ray sent by remote control.
NOTE: If there is a protective film around the screen, remove the protective film before using the TV.

- The TV set shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing. No objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the TV set.
- Never insert objects of any kind into this TV through openings as they may touch dangerous voltage or other electrical parts that could result in fire or electric shock. Never spill liquid of any kind into the TV.

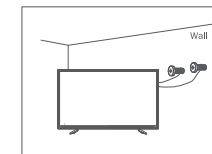

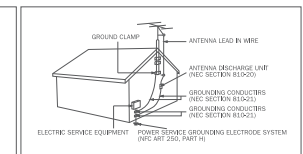

Remote Control Buttons

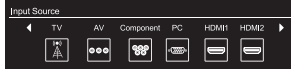
POWER (⏻): Turns the TV on or off.
MUTE (🔇): Mute or restore the sound
Number buttons: Choose the channel directly
Decimal Point: Input the decimal point.
Return(Back): Return to the previously-viewed channel.
MENU: Access the main menu
SOURCE: Select the input source mode.
Navigation buttons: (Up/Down/Left/Right) Navigate the menu.
OK: Confirm the selection.
HOME (🏠): Enter the home page.
EXIT: Exit the current screen.
NETFLIX: Access the Netflix interface.
VOL+ / VOL-: Increases or decreases the TV volume.
CH+ / CH-: Change to the previous or next program.
INFO: Show the detailed information.
EPG: This control button does not apply to this product.
REC (📺): This control button does not apply to this product.
MTS: Select desired sound output depending on the broadcasting channel.
CC: Setup the mode of closed caption.
SUBTITLE: Access the subtitle.
CH LIST: Access the channel list.
FAV: View your assigned favorite channels.
QUICK: Access the quick menu.
Color Buttons (RED / GREEN / YELLOW / BLUE): Execute the prompt function in specific mode.
PLAY / PAUSE (⏮): Pause or continue the playback.
STOP (⏹): Stop playback.
FAST BACKWARD / FAST FORWARD (⏮ / ⏭): Fast review of fast forward.

Basic Operations 7

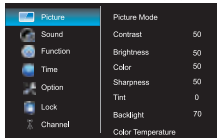
Turning On and Off
Connect the AC cord to power on the TV. At this time the TV will enter standby mode and power indicator will turn red.
Use Power Button () on the side panel of the TV or on the remote control to turn on the TV.
To turn off TV, you need to press Power Button over 3 second. If not, you see OSD for Input Source in TV Screen.

SOURCE SELECTION
1. Press the **SOURCE** button on the remote control, or Press Power button in TV side shortly.
2. Use the **▲** or **▼** button to select the options (TV/AV/Component/HDMI/USB) and select any of them using the **OK** button. (The screen will change to your desired source).



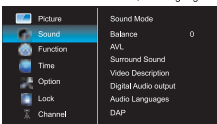
Note:
Before watching please make sure all necessary cables and devices are connected.
To exit the OSD menu
Press EXIT button. The menu will clear from the screen.
Press the MENU button repeatedly until the menus disappear.

Picture Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **PICTURE** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



Picture Mode: Choose among Sports, Normal, Mild, Save and User. The following five items (Contrast, Brightness, Color, Sharpness and Tint) can be adjusted only when the picture mode is set to "User" mode.
Contrast: Adjust the difference between light and dark areas of the picture.
Brightness: Adjust the lightness of the picture.
Color: Adjust the richness of the picture.
Sharpness: Adjust the edge of the picture.
Tint: (Only for some sources) Adjust the tint value of the color.
Backlight: Adjust the backlight value of the TV screen.
Color Temperature: Select the overall color tone of the picture. Choices are Cool, Standard and Warm.

Sound Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **SOUND** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



USB Media Play 11

USB Media Menu
Before operating Media menu, Plug in USB device, then press **SOURCE** button.
Press **▲** button to select USB Media Player in the Source menu, then press Enter button to enter.
Press **◀/▶** button to select the option you want to adjust in the main Media menu, then press Enter button to enter.

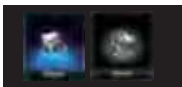


Photo Menu

Press the arrow buttons **◀/▶** to select the APP, then press "OK" button to enter.

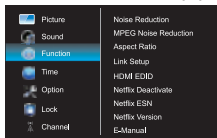


NETFLIX YOU can press "NETFLIX" button or press HOME button select the NETFLIX to enter.

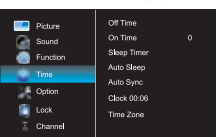
Sound Mode: Choose among Standard, Music, Movie, Sports and User. The value of 120Hz, 500Hz, 1.5KHz, 5KHz or 10KHz can be adjusted only when the sound mode is set to "User" mode.
Balance: Control the sound balance between the right and left speaker.
AVLT: Turn on to adjust the sound volume depending on the input signal.
Surround Sound: Help to create rich and wider sound from stereo sound sources.
Video Description: Turn on or turn off the video description function to help the blind or visually impaired viewers.
Digital Audio Output: Set the digital audio output mode to PCM or Auto.
Audio Languages: Set the primary or secondary digital audio language corresponding to the signal.
DAP: Digital Audio process. It can provide enhanced audio quality.
You can select DAP mode as: Standard/Music/Noise/News/Status/Game/User

Function Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **FUNCTION** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.

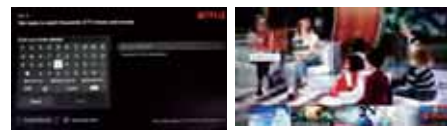


Noise Reduction: Eliminate noise in the picture. Choices are Off, Low, Middle, High and Auto.
MPEG Noise Reduction: Eliminate noise generated while converting or compressing MPEG signals. Choices are Off, Low, Middle and High. **Aspect Ratio:** Select the aspect ratio (display proportions) according to your video signal type or preference. Choices are 4:3, 16:9, Movie, Native and Panorama.
Note: The choices of aspect ratio differ by different regions or sources.
Link Setup: Command and control HDMI devices connected to the TV set.
1. Enable Link: Turn on or turn off HDMI Link function.
2. Auto Power On: Turn on to power on the TV set automatically when you turn on the HDMI device.
3. Auto Standby: Turn on to change the HDMI device to standby mode automatically when you turn off the TV set.
4. Device Select: Select the HDMI device from the device list.
HDMI EDDI: Switch the version of Extended Display Identification Data.
Netflix Deactive: Logout your your Netflix user account.
Netflix ESN: Check the Netflix ESN number.
Netflix Version: Check the Netflix SW version.
eManual: Electronic User Manual.
Vudu Deactivation: Logout your Vudu user account.
TTS: Setup the function of Text-to-Sound.
1. TTS: Turn on or turn off the TTS function. The following four items can be adjusted only when TTS is turned on.
2. Verbosity: Select the verbosity level.
3. Rate Support: Select the sound speed.

Time Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **TIME** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.

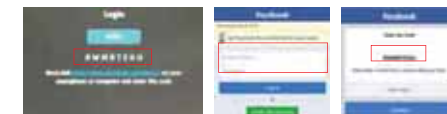

Third enter the 8 random code which marked in the first picture. Then you can success to use facebook.



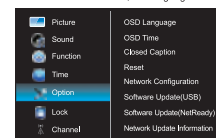

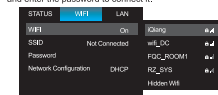
Off Time: Setup the repeat mode and timer to turn off the TV set.
On Time: Setup the repeat mode and timer to turn on the TV set.
Sleep Timer: Set to turn off the TV set automatically. Choices are off, 10, 20, 30, 40, 90, 120, 180 and 240 minutes.
Auto Sleep: Setup the timer to turn off the TV set automatically when there is no operation. Choices are Off, 4 hours, 6 hours and 8 hours.
Auto Sync: Turn on or turn off the function of Auto Sync.
Clock: Setup the TV clock (Day, Month, Year, Hour and Minute). It is available only when Auto Sync is turned off.
Time Zone: Select the time zone. It is available only when Auto Sync is turned on.

Option Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **OPTION** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



OSD Language: Select your desired OSD Language.
OSD Time: Select the time to keep the OSD display on the screen.
Closed Caption: Setup the function of Closed Caption.
1. CC Mode - Select the CC mode. The following three items can't be adjusted when the CC Mode is turned off.
2. Basic Selection - Select the basic CC type.
3. Advanced Selection - Select the advanced CC service type.
4. Closed Caption Option - Adjust the detailed CC settings such as font, color and so on.
Reset: Restore Menu options to the factory defaults, and restart the initial setup.
Note: User data on this TV will lose completely after operating this feature.
Network Configuration:
1. Status: Check the detailed information of network connection such as IP, MAC Address and so on.
2. WiFi: Setup to connect the TV set to the Wireless Network.
3. LAN: Setup to connect the TV set to the Wired Network.
Software Update (USB): Select to update software from USB.
Software Update (NetReady): Select to update software by network connection.
Network Update Information: Show network update information such as software version and so on.

How to connect to WiFi?
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **OPTION** in the main menu, choose the **Network Configuration**.
After pressing the **OK** button, select WiFi.
Select to WiFi setting and turn on the WiFi, select your WiFi network and enter the password, then select the Setting to connect the WiFi. If you want to connect a new WiFi network, please select to WiFi item and press the **OK** button from the remote, it will search some new WiFi network nearby the TV, select the WiFi network and enter the password to connect it.



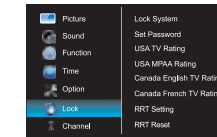
Troubleshooting 13

TV Problems
The TV can't be turned on.
• Make sure the AC cord is plugged in.
• Check the wall outlet, make sure the AC output works normally and standby.
No picture or sound but the TV is on and there is a "No Signal" sign on screen.
• Are you trying to use an input source with no device connected to it? For using other video/audio device, make sure the external device works normally first, then press SOURCE and choose the right input source.
• The signal type option may be set incorrectly.
• The channel may be blank, Try to search the channel again or change another channel.
The sound is fine, but the picture is poor.
• If you can only get black and white pictures from external device that you've connected to your TV, maybe it is due to the video cables is not connected well, or they are connected wrongly. Check the connection stability first, then check the correctness.
• For AV input, the yellow video cable connects to the yellow Video with yellow jack on component connection cable, For Component input, the three Y, Pb, Pr video cables (red, blue, and green) should be connected to the corresponding with component connection cable. This component connection cable should be plugged firmly into bottom side TV (3.5mm mini jack)
• Check the antenna connections, Make sure all of the cables are firmly connected to the TV jack on side of your TV.
• Try adjusting the color features to improve.
There is no sound, but the picture is fine.
• The sound might be muted, Try pressing the MUTE button to restore sound.

• For using AV or Component, remember to connect the device's left and right audio output correctly, the left channel cable is white and the right channel cable is red. Please match the cables and jacks according to their colors.
• The sound settings may not be set correctly.
• If your audio source has only one jack or is a (mono) audio source, make sure you have plugged the connection into the Audio In L jack (white) on the TV.
The buttons on the side panel don't work.
• Unplug the TV from the AC power for 10 minutes and then plug it back, Turn the TV on and try again.
The TV turns off unexpectedly.
• The electronic protection circuit may have been activated because of a power surge, Wait 30 seconds and then turn the TV on again, If this happens frequently, the voltage in your house may be abnormal. If the other electronic equipment in your home can't work normally, consult a qualified service personnel.
The Remote control doesn't work.
• Make sure there is a clear path.
• The remote may not be aimed directly at the TV.
• The batteries in the remote may be weak, dead, or installed incorrectly. Put new batteries in the remote.
No Picture for HDMI 2.0 input
• HDMI Cable should be meet HDMI 2.0 spec.
• We recommend to use HDMI cable with 27Gbps speed

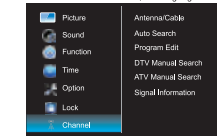

Lock Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **LOCK** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



Input the initial password (0000) or your own password to access this feature, then press **OK** button to enter the following features.
Lock System: Select On to enable the following eight items.
Set Password: Use to change the current Lock password.
USA TV Rating: Block or unblock programs according to USA TV Rating.
USA MPAA Rating: Block or unblock programs according to USA MPAA Rating.
Canada English TV Rating: Block or unblock programs according to Canada English TV Rating.
Canada French TV Rating: Block or unblock programs according to Canada French TV Rating.
RRT Setting: Adjust the settings of RRT (Region Rating Table).
RRT Reset: Reset the RRT settings to the defaults.
Note: If you change the password and forget it, you can use the super password 8899 to enter the lock system.

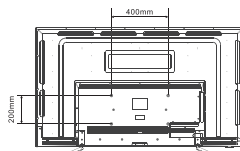
Channel Menu
Press MENU button to display the main menu.
Press **◀/▶** button to select **CHANNEL** in the main menu, it will highlight the first option.



Antenna/Cable: Select the tuner mode between Antenna and Cable.
Auto Search: Search for programs automatically. If you want to stop the auto search, press EXIT button. Then Select "Yes" to exit searching and "No" to continue searching.
Program Edit: Edit the programs. You can press RED button to delete programs, press BLUE button to skip programs, and add programs to the favorite list by pressing Yellow button.
DTV Manual Search: Search for the DTV programs manually. The search stops when a program is found and this program will be stored automatically. Press EXIT button to exit the searching. Before DTV manual search, you need to Select the desired UHF CH.
ATV Manual Search: Search for the ATV programs manually. When a program is found, press RED button to save it. Press EXIT button to exit the searching. Before ATV manual search, you need to select the desired Current Channel. If the signal is weak or distorted, you can select "Fine Tune" to adjust the frequency slightly until the image is clear.
Signal Information: Show the signal information of current DTV channel.
