



Installing Additional Apps

1. From the Home screen, tap **Play Store** (🌐).
2. Browse the app by category or search for the app by keyword.



3. Select the desired app. Then tap **INSTALL** (for free apps) or the price (for "paid" apps).



Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the transaction or install the app.

- You can also install the desired app from **Web Store** (🌐).


Moving the App Shortcut

Tap and hold the app icon until it displays as movable mode. Then drag it to the desired position and release.



Viewing App Info

Tap and hold the app icon until the pop-up menu appears on the screen. Then select App info.




You can then view the detailed app information.




Removing the Installed App

1. Tap and hold the app icon until the pop-up menu appears on the screen. Then select Uninstall.



2. When a confirmation message appears, tap Uninstall to continue with the uninstalling the app.




Note

- You cannot uninstall all the preinstalled apps. The Uninstall option will not appear in the pop-out menu.

Pin an App to the Shelf


Tap and hold the app icon until the pop-up menu appears on the screen. Then select Pin to shelf.




When you pin an app to the shelf, the app will remain there until you remove it.

Tip

- To change the apps icons arrangement on the shelf, just drag them around.




- To unpin the app from the shelf, tap and hold the app icon until the pop-out menu appears. Then tap Unpin.




Creating the App Folder

Tap and hold an app icon. Then drag it over another icon and release it. A folder is automatically created.



Renaming the Folder

1. Tap a folder.
2. Enter the name using the on-screen keyboard. Then tap .




3. Tap the screen to close the folder screen.

Managing Files

Browsing the Files

1. From the Home screen, tap Files (📁).
2. On the left panel, browse the file or folder you want to view.




3. Tap the desired file to open it.

IMPORTANT!

- Make sure to tap  to unmount the memory card properly before removing it from your tablet.

Renaming the File

1. From the Home screen, tap Files (📁).
2. Select the file you want to rename. Then tap ⋮ > Rename.



3. Enter the new name using the on-screen keyboard. Then tap ↵.

Copying or Moving the File

1. From the Home screen, tap Files (📁).
2. Select the file(s) you want to copy or move. Then tap ⋮ > Copy or Cut.


✍ Note

- To select all files at once, tap ⋮ > Select all.

4. Select the destination location.
5. Tap ⋮ > Paste.

Editing Your Photos

1. From the Home screen, tap Files (📁).
2. Select the photo you want to edit.
3. Tap ✎. Then you can do the following:



Option	Description
Auto-fix (🔧)	Automatically adjusts the brightness and contrast levels.
Crop (📏)	Crops your photo to a different size.
Resize (📐)	Resizes your photo.
Brightness & Contrast (⚙️)	Adjusts the brightness and contrast levels manually.
Rotate left (↶)	Rotates the photo 90-degree counter-clockwise.
Rotate right (↷)	Rotates the photo 90-degree clockwise.
Undo (↶)	Cancels the last change.
Redo (↷)	Reverts the last undo.


- Tap ⋮ > EXIT to exit the editing mode.


Configuring the Wi-Fi Settings

Before surfing the web or using the related apps that require the Internet connection, you have to connect your tablet to a wireless network.

1. From the Home screen, tap Settings (⚙️).
2. In *Network*, tap **Wi-Fi** to enable the function. Then tap ▶ to view the available networks.



3. Tap a network to connect to. Then tap Connect.




✍️ Note

- If you select an unsecured network, the connection is automatically established.
- When connecting to a secured network, you will be prompted for the password. Enter the password, then tap Connect.


Adding a Bluetooth Device to Your Tablet

You can connect multiple devices to your tablet through Bluetooth including a mouse, keyboard, speaker, or headphone.

1. From the Home screen, tap Settings (⚙️).
2. In Bluetooth, tap Bluetooth to enable the function. Then tap ▶ to view other Bluetooth devices.



3. Tap a detected device listed under "Unpaired devices". Then follow the on-screen instructions to start pairing.



Once the device has been successfully paired, it will appear under "Paired devices".




Tip

- To unpair a Bluetooth device, select the paired device you want to unpair, and then tap Remove from list.




Changing the Screen Resolution

2. Tap ≡ > Device.




3. Tap Displays to enter the Displays screen. Then drag the Display Size slider to adjust the screen size.



Checking the System Update


Your tablet automatically checks for available updates when it is connected to a wireless network (Wi-Fi).

Once the update has been downloaded, go to Settings (⚙️) > ≡ > About Chrome OS > Restart to complete the updating process.



Note

- To manually check for available updates, go to Settings (⚙️) > ≡ > About Chrome OS > Check for updates. If your tablet finds an update, it will start to download automatically.

Troubleshooting

The table below describes the common troubleshooting tips that you may encounter when using your tablet.

Problem	Possible Solution(s)
Tablet freezes/operation is unstable.	√ Restart your tablet by turning it off and then turning it on again.
The touch screen doesn't work.	√ Make sure you don't wear any gloves. You can only use the touch screen while wearing special touch screen gloves.
Cannot use the browser, watch YouTube, or receive new emails.	√ Make sure the Wi-Fi network is configured properly and working. √ The wireless network signal that you selected is too weak. Try another network.
The screen is too dark.	√ Adjust the brightness level. Refer to the "Using the Quick Menu" section on page 16.
The battery doesn't charged.	√ Make sure the smaller end of the power adapter is properly connected to the USB port of your tablet. √ Make sure the power cord is properly connected to the electrical outlet.
The battery drains too fast.	√ Check the Wi-Fi connection. Your tablet uses more power when trying to connect in low-signal areas. √ Your tablet continues to play music or videos.
Cannot install new applications.	√ Insufficient storage available on your tablet. To check free space, go to Settings (⚙️) > ☰ > Device > Storage management. √ Some apps may be unavailable in your region.
