

The pager adopts "AAA" battery. Replace the battery according to following procedure;


1) Release the locker from the battery cover.

2) Push battery cover out to arrow direction.(←)

3) Remove battery cover completely, and then replace the battery.

- 2) Pay attention to the polarity type of battery.





In the place where can not receive a signal, the icon proficers. Under this mode, a message cannot be received, but other functions operate normally.



Alarm to expedite message confirmation

In case that there is an unchecked message, the alarm makes sound six times together with "1 PAgE" on screen with a specific time interval, namely 3 minutes to remind. After the alarm makes sound six times, only "1 PAgE" remains and no alarm makes sound.



Battery replacement display

When a battery's life almost exhausts, the icon of battery replacement flicker on the screen and make alarm sound.

Night - time light

Use night - time light mode to check a message even at dark place.

Press either or or for two seconds. If you fail to press other buttons while the light turns on, the mode returns to the initial screen after a while and let the light turn off automatically.

Remark: Turn on the light on initial screen, and then use other mode. The light does not turn on in other screen.
