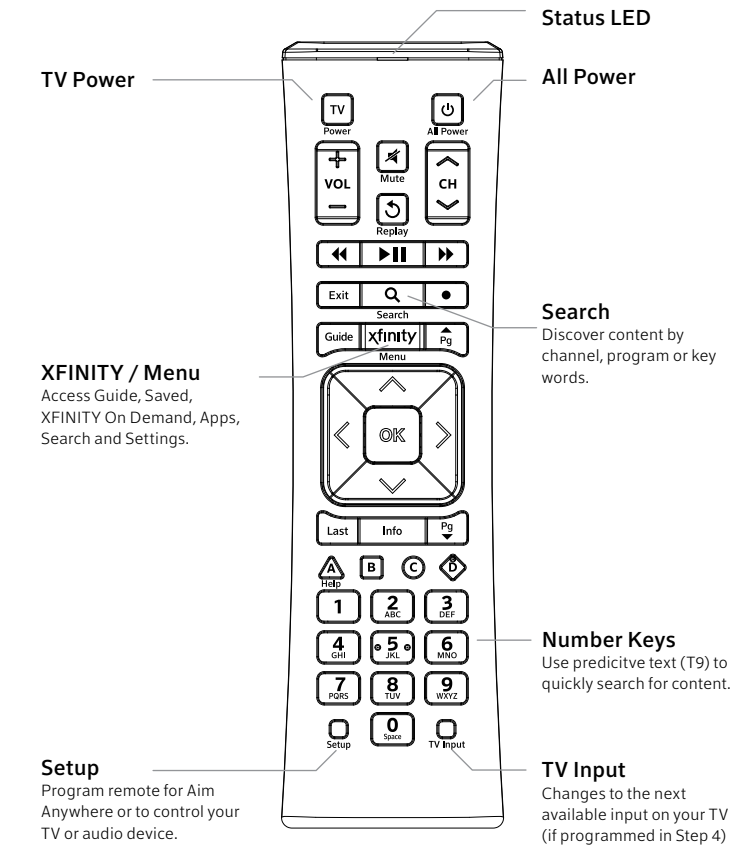

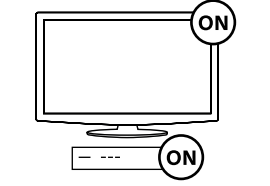
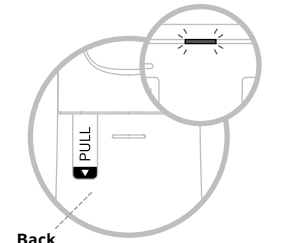


1 Meet Your Remote



2 Turn On Your Remote

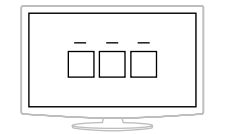
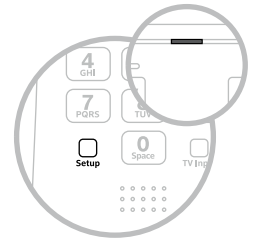
Your remote arrives with the AA batteries already installed, but not activated. Here is how to power it on for the first time.



- A** Pick up your remote and remove the **“Pull” tab** (on back) by **pulling away** from the remote. The Status LED will **blink green** four times as the remote powers up (about 5 seconds).
- B** Turn on your **TV**.
- C** Turn on your **set-top box**.

3 Pair Remote for “Aim Anywhere” Control

Control your set-top box without having to point at it, even when it is inside a cabinet or entertainment center.

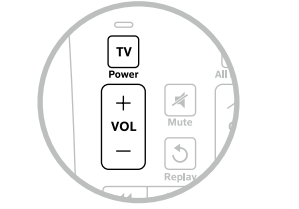
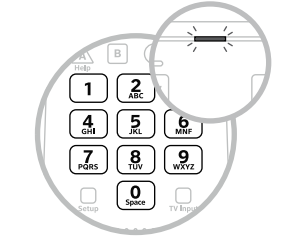
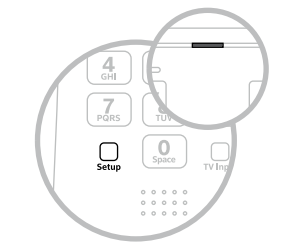


- A** Press and hold the **Setup** button (about 3 seconds) until the Status LED changes from **red to green**.
- B** Press the **XFINITY** button.
- C** Follow the on-screen instructions to enter the **3-digit code** that appears.

Once the code is correctly entered, your XFINITY Remote is paired with the device.

- Not working?** Make sure the battery tab from your remote is removed, your TV is on and you are entering the correct 3-digit code on your TV screen.
- Need to remove Aim Anywhere control?** Press and hold the **Setup** button on the remote until the status LED changes from **red to green**. Press **A** on the remote. If the status LED **blinks green twice**, you have successfully removed Aim Anywhere.

4 Control Your TV’s Power and Volume



- A** Using the list on the right, find the first **5-digit code** for your TV manufacturer.
- B** Press and hold the **Setup** button (about 3 seconds) until the Status LED changes from **red to green**.
- C** Enter in the **first 5-digit code** for your TV manufacturer. The Status LED should **blink green twice**.
- D** Verify that the code was accepted by using your remote to adjust **volume** and turn the TV **on and off**.

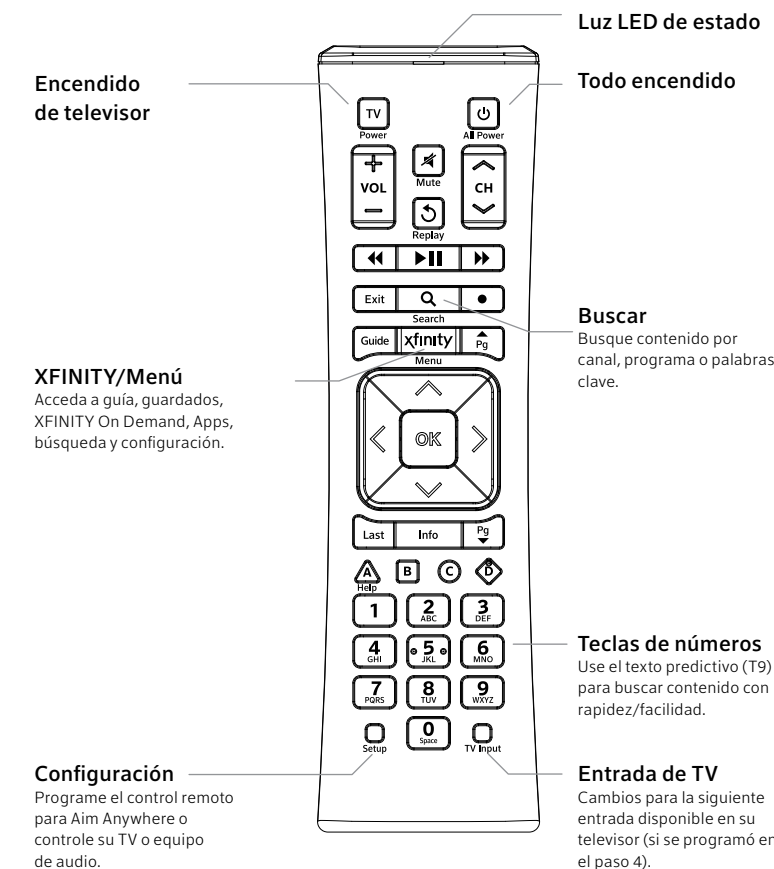

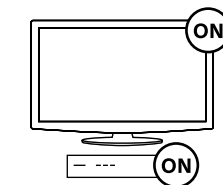
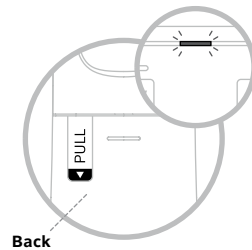


1 Conozca su control remoto



2 Encienda su control remoto

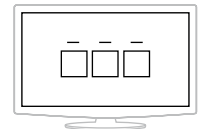
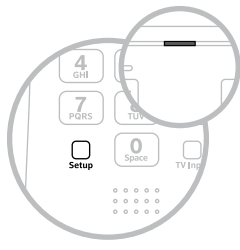
Su control remoto se le entrega con baterías AA ya instaladas, pero no activado. A continuación se muestra cómo debe encenderlo la primera vez.



- A** Tome su control remoto y quite la pestaña **"Pull"** (situada en la parte posterior) **separándola** del control remoto. La luz LED de estado **parpadeará en verde** cuatro veces mientras se enciende el control remoto (unos 5 segundos).
- B** Encienda su **televisor**.
- C** Encienda su **decodificador**.

3 Sincronice el control remoto para controlar "Aim Anywhere"

Controle su decodificador sin tener que apuntar hacia él, incluso si está dentro de un armario o en un centro de entretenimiento.



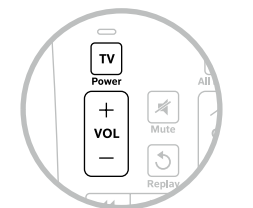
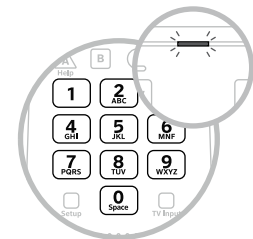
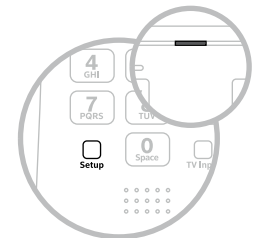
- A** Mantenga presionado el botón **Setup** unos 3 segundos, hasta que la luz LED de estado cambie **de rojo a verde**.
- B** Presione el botón **XFINITY**.
- C** Siga las instrucciones en pantalla para ingresar el código de **3 dígitos que** aparece.

Una vez que el código se haya ingresado correctamente, su control remoto de XFINITY queda sincronizado con el aparato.

¿No funciona? Asegúrese de que ha retirado la pestaña junto a las baterías de su control remoto, su TV está encendido y ha ingresado el código de 3 dígitos correctamente en la pantalla del televisor.

¿Necesita eliminar el control Aim Anywhere? Mantenga presionado el botón **Setup** del control remoto hasta que la luz LED de estado cambie **de rojo a verde**. Presione **A** en el control remoto. Si la luz LED de estado **parpadea dos veces en color verde**, eliminó satisfactoriamente el control Aim Anywhere.

4 Controle el encendido y el volumen del televisor



- A** Encuentre en la lista de la derecha el primer **código de 5 dígitos** correspondiente al fabricante de su televisor.
- B** Mantenga presionado el botón **Setup** unos 3 segundos, hasta que la luz LED de estado cambie **de rojo a verde**.
- C** Ingrese el **primer** código de 5 dígitos correspondiente al fabricante. La luz LED de estado debe **parpadear en color verde dos veces**.
- D** Verifique que el código ha sido aceptado usando su control remoto para ajustar el **volumen y encender y apagar** el televisor.
